Race 1	NZ FARMERS LIVESTOCK – CHRIS HAY 2200
TRISHA LEA (M Singh) - Raced keenly when in front throughout	
R Myers (WAZUZU) - Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres	
Race 2	POWERWORX 1200
DEUCE COUPE (C Johnson) – Awkwardly away settling back	
MIDDAGURD (S MacNab) - Began awkwardly shifting in contacting BUSHFIRE shortly after the start.	
PLAY THE FIELD (J Nason) - Raced wide without cover throughout	
MIDNIGHT DELIGHT (D Hirini) - Briefly held up near the 300 metres	

KOTAHI (T Johnson) – When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may have held its breath	
Race 3	CHINA NATIONAL 1650
TICKET CLIPPER (D Turner) - Slow away	
NITRO TED (T Johnson) - Slow away	
EVA JENSINE (Z Moki) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages	
THE HEIRESS (L Allpress) - Held up for a short distance from near the 600 metres	
KEEP IT SAVVY (C Johnson) – Had to be restrained off the heels of DARK PRINCESS and VERACIOUS approaching the 1,400 metres when DIRECT CAPITAL (T Allan) was eased sharply causing DARK PRINCESS to be restrained and go back on to KEEP IT SAVVY. Rider T Allan was shown footage of his ride and reminded of his obligations under Rule 638 (4) with regard to the manner in which he restrained his mount. When questioned into the performance of KEEP IT SAVVY rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.	
VERACIOUS (C O’Beirne) – Restrained off heels approaching 1,400 metres	
DARK PRINCESS (R Myers) – Restrained off heels approaching 1,400 metres	
Race 4	FOMS 1400
GLORY DAYS (R Myers) – Slow away	
SEA STAR (L Allpress) - Raced keenly throughout	
FOGARTY FEGEN (D Bradley) –Became awkwardly placed having to be steadied near the 300 metres	
COOL MOON (M Singh) – Raced keenly throughout. Lay out in the home straight having to be straightened	
Race 5	DERRY@GRANGEWILLIAM 1400
DOLCETTO (S O’Malley) – Slow away. When questioned in to the run of DOLCETTO Apprentice S O’Malley advised that the gelding was never comfortable in the Heavy 11 and was disadvantaged after missing the jump away. Rider S O’Malley was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
DARCI MAC (C Johnson) – Slow away. Raced keenly throughout.	
SAMPSON (C O’Beirne) – Inconvenienced near the 100 metres when DUFFERS CREEK (T Taiaroa) was angled inwards simultaneously as RINGO shifted in and away from DUFFERS CREEK. This resulted in LADIES FIRST having to be restrained. Rider T Taiaroa was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.	
LADIES FIRST (L Allpress) - Inconvenienced having to be restrained near the 100 metres.	
NYMPH MONTE (R Myers) – Held up from near the 100 metres and went to the line without being fully tested.	
Race 6	SUMMIT HAULAGE 1400
THAT’S FUNNY (C Johnson) – Slow away	
WOTAMMISSION (C-M Waddell) – Raced keenly in the middle stages	
LOCHARBURN (Z Moki) - When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate more distance.	
DO YA (M Singh) - When questioned rider had no excuse.	
Race 7	MITAVITE 2200
HURRY CANE (M Singh) – Slow away. Held up for a short distance entering the home straight and again near the 200 metres having to shift outwards across heels to gain clear running.	

MASTER PATRICK (D Bradley) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 800 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. D Bradley advised the gelding felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormality.

LAMBRUSCO (R Myers) – Had to be steadied on the turn when CARNABY shifted out simultaneously as I SUGGEST and HE'S UNFORGETTABLE shifted inwards marginally going back on to MR COOL BOY which was inconvenienced when improving on to that runner's heels.

DIEHARD (L Allpress) – Rider reported the gelding felt sore on pulling up. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed superficial abrasions to the right fore fetlock.
