Race 1	WATERFORCE/FARMERS TRANSPORT HANDICAP (2100 Metres)			
NITRO TED (C Johnson) – Slow away.				

IGRAINE (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

HARD TO BE HUMBLE (R Myers) – When questioned into performance rider advised the mare may appreciate more rain-affected going. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Track upgraded to Slow (7) retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 CR GRACE LTD/MARSH INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP (2100 Metres)

MARTY O'CEIRIN (R Elliot) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the request of stewards and was cleared to start.

MASTER PATRICK (D Bradley) – Slow away. Rider reported the gelding would appreciate more rain-affected going.

DES DE JEU (T Johnson) - Restrained off heels near the 1000 metres. T Johnson was spoken to regarding the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres.

EM KAY POPS (D Turner) - Began awkwardly settling back.

GRINNER (A Shin) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

CORNERSTONE (L Allpress) – When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate some further give in the ground. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 3 PILET CONTRACTING/PIONEER SEEDS HANDICAP (1200 Metres)

MANHATTAN STREET (R Elliot) - Underwent a pre-racing veterinary inspection and was cleared to start after making contact with the fence in the enclosure.

RAM SAM SAM (T Johnson) – Slow away. When questioned rider advised the gelding had been outpaced on the improved track conditions.

HEAVENS KEEP (A Shin) - Lay inwards early in the home straight having to be straightened.

Race 4 CP WOOL/CARRFIELDS LIVESTOCK HANDICAP (1300 Metres)

BROTHER ONE (C-M Waddell) – Began awkwardly.

ROCK ISLAND LINE (J Lowry) - Jumped inwards at the start contacting TINKALICIOUS which settled back.

TINKALICIOUS (R Myers) – Contacted start, settled back.

JUST YOU (R Elliot) – Slow away. Held up near the 500 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight.

BEAUDEN (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages when wide without cover.

CHOICE ATTITUDE (S McKay) – Contacted and hampered approaching the 800 metres when BEAUDEN shifted in. Rider C Johnson was issued with a warning under rule 638(1)(d) and advised to exercise more care. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate a longer distance and some easing in the track.

THE BANDITO (T Johnson) – Held up passing the 500 metres having to be angled inwards near the 300 metres to gain clear running.

MARS BARS (J Parkes) – Held up approaching the 400 metres before being angled outwards across heels to improve passing the 200 metres.

MISS LIZZIE (D Bradley) - Lay inwards over the final stages briefly inconveniencing SEA STAR.

SEA STAR (L Allpress) – Briefly inconvenienced final stages.

Race 5 AGRICOM/H&T AGRONOMICS HANDICAP (1500 Metres)

ARTAXERXES (T Taiaroa) – Awkwardly away, inconvenienced 1000 metres. Raced wide without cover throughout.

ZEDABEL LESS (C-M Waddell) – Tightened at the start settling back when runners either side shifted ground. Ran up on to heels having to be restrained near the 800 metres.

LEADING ROLE (D Turner) – Began awkwardly getting back, was obliged to improve very wide rounding the home turn.

MADAM MAKFI (D Hirini) - Ran up on to the heels of DANCING AURIOLE passing the 1000 metres having to be restrained and when doing so shifted outwards inconveniencing and dictating GLIMPSE on to ARTAXERXES which had to be steadied.

GLIMPSE (J Parkes) – Inconvenienced and dictated out passing the 1000 metres.

KEEP IT SAVVY (R Elliot) - When questioned into performance rider advised the mare may appreciate some easing in the track conditions.

Race 6 NUFARM/FPA NZ HANDICAP (1500 Metres)

CHEESE MAKER (Z Moki) - Slow away. Steadied 600 metres

ANIMATOR (T Johnson) – Awkwardly away. Lay in under pressure in the home straight. Rider reported that he had been unable to fully ride his mount out due to its tendency to lay inwards.

HAND IT TO JONESY (C O'Beirne) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Briefly inconvenienced near the 200 metres when LUBAYA (C Johnson) improved to its inside.

LUBAYA (C Johnson) - Raced in restricted room early in the home straight and when angled out near the 200 metres hampered HAND IT TO JONESY. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.

THE HEIRESS (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages

KAMANDA LINCOLN (R Elliot) - Steadied and went back on to CHEESE MAKER passing the 600 metres. Raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres.

C-M Waddell (BATCHELOR BABE) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion after allowing her mount to shift inwards under hard riding over the final stages inconveniencing BATABULLET.

DURHAM (R Myers) - Raced in restricted room over the final stages when ANIMATOR lay inwards.

CAPE DU JEU (A Shin) - When questioned into performance rider reported the mare may appreciate some easing in the ground. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 7 BOEHRINGER INGELHEIM 1550 (1550 Metres)

RED SIERRA (C O'Beirne) – Slow away. Rider C O'Beirne was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) with regards to her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

SHE'S POPPY (S McKay) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DEZ (L Allpress) - Lay inwards throughout.

AUTHENTIC PADDY (R Elliot) - Held up early in the home straight.

ROSEWOOD (R Myers) - When questioned into performance rider advised the mare would appreciate some easing of the track.

NEW YORK MINUTE (J Waddell) - When questioned into performance rider advised the mare did not appreciate today's improved track conditions.

UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT (T Johnson) – When questioned into performance rider advised the mare did not appreciate today's improved track conditions.

J Parkes (ART DECO) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) with regards to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 JOHN TURKINGTON LTD/MANAWATU TOYOTA HANDICAP (1400 Metres)

DEUCE COUPE (M Singh) and **SPONDULIX** (S McKay) were briefly placed in the incorrect barriers prior to being corrected by the starter.

KIRKENES (J Waddell) - Lay inwards early in the home straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of DEUCE COUPE near the 200 metres having to be restrained.

BELLISSIMO (D Turner) - Held up approaching the 200 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to improve.

SON OF SURF (D Hirini) – Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding raced keenly in the back straight and had little left at the finish.

KOKO BELLE (R Myers) - Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare should take natural improvement from the run.

ABBEY ROAD (Z Moki) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SKY HI RAHTWO (L Allpress) - When questioned into performance rider reported the mare may prefer more rainaffected going.
