RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR 2200 (2200m)
<p>LOOK OUT (J Riddell) - Underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barriers after the bit had become displaced being cleared to race.</p> <p>AMAZING AZ (C Lammas) - Tightened at the start when LOS ANGELES jumped outwards abruptly dictating ADONIS outwards, lay in under pressure in the final straight bumping with BELLA MARGARITA over the final stages.</p> <p>KAMANDA LINCOLN (S McKay) - Began awkwardly making contact with AMAZING AZ, raced ungenerously near the 1800 metres.</p> <p>HIGH SPIRITS (J Waddell) - Began awkwardly settling back, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had felt reluctant to hit out early getting further back than intended and had been unable to recover.</p> <p>BELLA MAGARITA (A Shin) - Raced in restricted room making contact with AMAZING AZ which shifted in under pressure over the final stages .</p>	
Race 2	MARDIGRAS EVENTS 1200 (1200m)
<p>GIFT OF POWER (C Johnson) - Slow to begin, relegated from 5th placing after causing interference final straight.</p> <p>BARCELO (C Lammas) - Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>Following the race a protest was lodged by the 6th place horse STRADIVARIUS alleging interference by the 5th placed horse GIFT OF POWER in the final straight. After viewing film footage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the protest relegating GIFT OF POWER to 6th placing.</p> <p>C Johnson (GIFT OF POWER) - Admitted a careless riding charge in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards crowding STRADAVARIUS near the 250 metres and was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing today, Saturday 6th October up to and including racing on Friday 19th October (8 national riding days).</p> <p>STRADAVARIUS (W Pinn) - Crowded 250 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>S SPRATT (VINNIE'S VOLLEY) - Issued with a warning regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 3	DAN D'ESPOSITO MEMORIAL (1200m)
<p>PINK GRAFFATI (L Innes) - Underwent a veterinary inspection at the start after kicking out and making contact with the parade ring rail being passed fit to run, made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, held up rounding the bend from the 500 metres and when attempting to obtain clear running shifted outwards to avoid the heels of MYRTLE when that runner was being steadied passing the 400 metres. When shifting outwards PINK GRAFFITI hampered VICKEZZMOET which was forced outwards in turn hampering LINCOLN RAIDER. When assessing this incident stewards took into account the interference occurring in front of PINK GRAFFITI rounding the final turn with L Innes being given the benefit of the doubt being advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>LINCOLN RAIDER (T Johnson) - Crowded leaving the barriers, hampered passing the 400 metres, lay in under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened.</p> <p>PEP TORQUE (L Hemi) - Slow away.</p>	

HUGO THE BOSS (S Spratt) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 1100 metres, then raced fiercely for some distance and shifted outwards to avoid heels before racing wide for the remainder, crowded passing the 200 metres.

BLONDLIGN (T Allan) - Raced wide in the early to middle stages then being ridden forward to reach the lead near the 700 metres.

MYRTLE (D Turner) - Raced wide throughout, hampered having to be steadied to avoid the heels of DEVINE LOVE passing the 400 metres, appeared to go off stride near the 200 metres then steadied near the 150 metres when placed in restricted room. Following the race rider reported that the mare had felt sore in the left fore leg. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DEVINE LOVE (J Waddell) - Hampered when forced over extra ground rounding the bend passing the 400 metres, When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in his opinion the mare would prefer some cut in the ground. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality other than small lacerations to both hind legs.

T HARRIS (COPPER MINE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards rounding the final turn passing the 400 metres when not sufficiently clear of DEVINE LOVE which was dictated outwards into the line of MYRTLE. T Harris was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the close of racing on Wednesday October 10th up to and including racing on Thursday October 18th (6 national riding days).

VICKEZZMOET (S Collet) - Hampered passing the 400 metres.

L INNES - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards passing the 200 metres crowding HUGO THE BOSS which was taken inwards placing MYRTLE in restricted room.

Race 4	STELLA ARTOIS 1400 (1400m)

RHINESTONE COWBOY (J Riddell) - Bucked during the preliminary dislodging its rider then being declared a late scratching at 2.11pm. J Riddell was attended to by St Johns personnel suffering minor abrasions.

MIGHTY CONNOR (L Hemi) - Underwent a veterinary inspection at the start after kicking out and making contact with parade ring rail being passed fit to run, slow away.

TIPPERARY MARY (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover, crowded 250 metres.

S MCKAY (LANGKAWI) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards near the 250 metres when not fully clear of OUT OF THE PARK which in turn shifted outwards crowding TIPPERARY MARY.

Race 5	SACRED FALLS HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS (1400m)

THOMAS AQUINAS (M Coleman) - Crowded leaving the barriers when REEVEDERCI began awkwardly.

REEVEDERCI (L Innes) - Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly but nonetheless had been disappointing.

STAR PERFORMANCE (S Rusof) - Slow away.

CYBER ATTACK (V Colgan) - Raced three wide without cover, bumped near the 300 metres when PRINCESS AMELIE shifted outwards. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been caught wide and may appreciate some easing of the ground.

CUTADEEL (J Riddell) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

BOBBY DAZZLER (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the colt was feeling the effects of recent racing and would be spelled, underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 6 | **TUMU ITM MILE (1600m)**

LEADING ROLE (D Turner) - Slow away.

SPONDULIX (W Pinn) - Slow away.

LE SABLIER (M Coleman) - Slow away.

TURFSHAKER (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

FISCAL FANTASY (L Innes) - Held up near the 250 metres shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

THE MITIGATOR (D Johnson) - Rider dropped her whip near the 30 metres.

VAN DIAMOND (J Waddell) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in his opinion the gelding may appreciate more rain affected going.

Race 7 | **HASTINGS-HEART OF THE HAWKE'S BAY MILE (1600m)**

YORKSHIRE DALES (S Rusof) - Slow away, got its head up when being steadied shortly after the start.

DUPLICITY (C O'Beirne) - Slow away.

HARTLEY (R Myers) - Raced wide throughout.

DARK PRINCESS (C Johnson) - Held up rounding the final turn and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until the 150 metres.

FLAMINGO (J Parkes) - Held up for a distance near the 400 metres.

BEAUTY WAY (M Coleman) - Held up near the 350 metres shifting outwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres making contact with THE KIPLING GIRL.

THE KIPLING GIRL (S Collett) - Bumped passing the 300 metres.

SACRED RHYTHM (S McKay) - When weakening was steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of DARK PRINCESS passing the 200 metres. C Johnson was advised to exercise more care.

Race 8 | **LIVAMOL CLASSIC (2040m)**

TOMELILLA (J Riddell) - Underwent a veterinary inspection at the start and was cleared to run.

SAINT EMILION (L Innes) - Blundered leaving the barriers, raced three wide without cover rounding the first bend when improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1300 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had stumbled at the start but had been disappointing. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SCOTT BASE (V Colgan) - Slow away, placed in restricted room near the 1700 metres to the inside of SAVVY COUP which lay in when being restrained.

FIVE TO MIDNIGHT (J Parkes) - Jumped away awkwardly.

LIZZIE L'AMOUR (M Cameron) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.

DANZDANZDANCE (D Johnson) - Held up near the 250 metres having to steady and shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

Race 9	RED BADGE SPRING SPRINT (1400m)

BOOTS 'N' ALL (J Lowry) - Slow away.

S SPRATT (MAGNUM) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards near the 200 metres when not sufficiently clear crowding AMARULA onto DEALS IN HEELS with both those runners being checked. S Spratt was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the close of racing on Saturday October 13th up to and including racing Friday 26th October (10 national riding days).

AMARULA (S McKay) - Crowded and checked near the 200 metres.

DEALS IN HEELS (R Myers) - Crowded and checked near the 200 metres.

UGO FOSCOLO (D Johnson) - Gave ground quickly passing the 300 metres and was not persevered with. Rider was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

NOT USUAL HEART (R Elliot) - Hampered by the weakening UGO FOSCOLO near the 250 metres.

S SRATT (Magnum) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 10	BOSTOCK NEW EZALAND SPRING CARNIVAL FINALE (1400m)

STACCATO (R Elliot) - Underwent a veterinary inspection after being kicked at the start and was passed fit to run.

KAIPAWE (T Johnson) - Awkwardly away settling back, crowded passing the 100 metres.

BRAAVOS (W Pinn) - Raced wide without cover.

ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL (L Hemi) - Raced wide throughout.

CUTTING UP ROUGH (S Rusof) - Had to be steadied off heels going into the 800 metre turn hampering IRISH FLAME.

IRISH FLAME (O Bosson) - Hampered having to shift inwards to avoid the heels of CUTTING UP ROUGH going into the turn near the 800 metres, steadied passing the 100 metres when crowded to the inside of DANGER DEE which was taken in by HINERANGI.

M Cameron - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards forcing DANGER DEE inwards crowding IRISH FLAME onto KAIPAWE passing the 100 metres.

DANGER DEE (D Johnson) - Crowded passing the 100 metres.

RUBY LOVE (R Myers) - Steadied near the 75 metres when SOROC (S Spratt) lay in before being corrected by its rider. S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care.
