RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TARANAKI PINE DASH 990M
BIGSIE and NO FINER PINS underwent veterinary inspections prior to the start after coming together in the enclosure and were cleared to start.	
DEJA ROO (D Turner) – Reared as the start was effected losing ground. Held up approaching the 400 metres gaining clear running inside the final 100 metres.	
ELECTRODE (J Parkes) – Made the bend awkwardly running wider on the track. When questioned into performance rider	

could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed an active heel abscess.

S O'MALLEY (Dana's Prophecy) – Admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount DANA'S PROPHECY to shift inwards dictating PEP TORQUE into the line of VINCENT which was checked. After hearing submissions apprentice jockey S O'Malley had his licence to ride in races suspended from the close of racing on 4/10/18 up to and including 12/10/18. (6 days)

VINCENT (L Allpress) – Hung throughout. Tightened and checked near the 200m when **DANA'S PROPHECY** shifted inwards dictating **PEP TORQUE**.

PEP TORQUE (L Hemi) – Dictated and crowded near the 200 metres.

ARIDITY (T Johnson) – Lay in early in the home straight having to be straightened.

TOBY (R Elliot) – Held up from the 600 metres before being angled outwards across heels approaching the 200 metres to improve.

SWEEPSTAKE (R Myers) – Awkwardly away settling back. Contacted FLORENCE JEAN when angling for a run near the 200 metres.

SANTA MONICA (D Dannis) – Awkwardly away. Momentarily held up entering the home straight before being angled inwards to gain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

FLORENCE JEAN (L Allpress) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after making contact with the rail in the enclosure. Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced in restricted room near the 75 metres when TELLYAWHAT shifted inwards. L Allpress was spoken to advisedly with regard to the use of her elbow when attempting to maintain her line of running and to do so in a manner that does not leave anything open to query. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare had raced keenly early but could offer no other tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

TELLYAWHAT (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres. Shifted inwards under pressure over the final stages tightening FLORENCE JEAN. Stewards took into account simultaneous outward movement from SWEEPSTAKE when assessing the interference. Nevertheless W Pinn was advised to exercise greater care.

SALAMANCA (T Taiaroa) – Raced three wide on the pace without cover.

Race 3	HAROLD TUSON MEMORIAL 1300

SMOKEN' ACE – Began awkwardly bumping GLADSTONE BELLE. Raced wide without cover throughout.

BRAHMARAHMA (J Parkes) – Tightened at the start settling back.

TORO ROSSO – Tightened at the start. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate more rain affected going.

FIELD OF FIRE (W Pinn) – Held up having to be restrained near the 500 metres and again briefly entering the home straight. When questioned into performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A veterinary inspection was clear.

SKY HI RAHTWO (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

MILLY MOO (A Goindasamy) – Raced three wide without cover throughout, lay in under pressure in the home straight.

SAINTED PEARL (M Singh) – Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres.

WYNTHORPE (L Hemi) – Held up for a distance rounding the turn.

Race 4	SEATON PARK 1400

ROCK ISLAND LINE (R Elliot) – Slow away.

JUST FOR KICKS (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover for some distance.

TINKALICIOUS (R Myers) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off heels near the 800 metres. Hung rounding the home turn. Held up in the home straight and approaching the 100 metres had to be angled outwards across heels to improve wider on the track.

SEA STAR (L Allpress) – Rider reported the gelding hung throughout.

PACQUIAO (D Turner) – Held up for some distance rounding the turn.

RACE 5	POWERWORX GREYS OPEN HANDICAP 1400M

OUR KING SWAY (D Dannis) – Blundered at start settling back.

KING'S SECRET (C Johnson) – Tightened at start.

BRING TO THE BLOCK (D Turner) – Awkwardly away. Held up rounding the turn before improving into a marginal run to the inside of RUFFY RAHTWO.

WRANGLER (R Myers) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MONRECOUR (R Elliot) – Attempted a narrow run approaching the 100 metres simultaneously as BRING TO THE BLOCK improved into a marginal run to the inside of RUFFY RAHTWO which was jostled briefly.

Race 6	DENIS WHEELER EARTHMOVING 1800

TIME BOMB (L Allpress) – Awkwardly away. Gave ground quickly approaching the 800 metres and was not persevered with when out of contention. When questioned rider reported the gelding had hung throughout and proved a difficult ride. Connections advised that TIME BOMB would be spelled. Subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a sharp tooth and a small laceration to the inside of the cheek.

RECOLLECT (J Parkes) – Jumped inwards at the start contacting TIME BOMB.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (S McKay) – Tightened near the 1600 metres when HIGH QUALITY shifted inwards going back on to RECOLLECT and hampering CHEESE MAKER. S O'Malley was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).

BATCHELOR BABE (W Pinn) – Over raced in the middle stages.

S O'MALLEY (High Quality) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7	FASTTRACK INSURANCE 3210 M

HAMILTONIAN (S McKay) – Slow away.

TRISHA LEA (C O'Beirne) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Gave ground quickly rounding the home turn. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality however the trainer subsequently reported the mare may have got its tongue over the bit.

WAZUZU (R Myers) – Lay inwards near the 150 metres making contact with WHERE ARE YOU which was improving to its inside.

GRINNER (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

Race 8	PREAKNESS, BELMONT & CUBA WITH WHEELS 2000 M

EN SUITE (T Taiaroa) – Tightened at start settling back.

KIRKENES (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in front in the early and middle stages finishing well back. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had raced keenly throughout and had little left. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

ZAC BROWN – Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

LAMBRUSCO (A Goindasamy) – Lay in under pressure over the final stages. A Goindasamy was issued with a warning under Rule 638(2) for a celebratory gesture prior to the finish line.

EM KAY POPS (D Turner) – Held up entering the home straight gaining clear running inside the final 100 metres.

LECTO DIVINIA (A Shin) – Rider reported that the saddle had slipped in the home straight and that he was unable to ride his mount out fully to the line.

HE'S RIC (T Johnson) – Lay out over the final stages.

RED RASCAL (C O'Beirne) – Shifted inwards under pressure over the final stages.
