GENERAL:

Due to a miscommunication the TAB had listed the track condition as Dead (5) until shortly before Race 1.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 STELLA ARTOIS STAYERS (2100metres)

CHARRED (C Dell) - Began awkwardly unbalancing the rider.

INITIATIVE (D Danis) - Slow away.

TRENDING (T Allan) - Raced ungenerously for a short distance approaching the 1700 metres making the bend awkwardly. When questioned into the reason he noticeably restrained his mount short of the finish, T Allan advised the gelding had a tendency to hang during the running and he had anticipated inward movement from CHARRED over

the final stages so took corrective action.

STEVIE'S SURPRISE (L Hemi) -Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off heels near the 1600 metres.

HYPATIA (R Myers) - Ran up onto the heels of WITCH HAZEL and had to be restrained approaching the 1600 metres.

MAMBA (S Rusof) - Held up from the 500 metres gaining clear running approaching the 350 metres.

AKELA BELLE (T Johnson) - Held up entering the home straight having to be angled across heels to improve approaching the 100 metres.

Race 2

HB RACING SUPPORTING FAWC MILE (1600 metres)

GO GO GOAL (J Riddell) - Awkwardly away.

HAVOC (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages making the bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly running wide on the track, briefly held up near the 300 metres and made contact with JAGUARY when attempting a narrow run to the inside.

J RIDDELL (GO GO GOAL) admitted a breach of [Rule 638(1)(d)] in that he angled his mount out near the 650 metres when not clear of FALAKROS which was hampered for a short distance and dictated outwards. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from 29th November up to and including 8th December (8 national days).

FALAKROS (T Johnson) - Hampered and dictated wide approaching the 650 metres.

MY CLARITY (D Turner) -Lay in approaching the 200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BABICHE having to be restrained.

D MANSOUR (BABICHE) - Dropped his whip approaching the 200 metres.

Race 3

HAWKE'S BAY CRANE HIRE 1300 (1300 metres)

GRANITE RIDGE (M Singh) - Inconvenienced when MARIA DIOR began awkwardly settling back.

PEP TORQUE (L Hemi) -Restrained off heels of ESTEFANIA near the 900 metres, held up for a distance from the 500 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight, briefly hampered approaching the 200 metres.

PINCANTO (D Danis) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TOODALOO (D Turner) – Briefly held up near the 200 metres having to be angled outwards to improve.

Race 4

TRINITY HILL 3YO (1300 metres)

SPRING BOUQUET (D Mansour) -Was late scratched after dislodging and injuring the rider on the way to the start. Rider D Mansour was transferred to hospital for further observation.

Due to the immediate unavailability of a replacement ambulance, horses and riders were returned to the enclosure and the remainder of the program put back one race.

VITA SICILIA (S Collett) - Jumped inwards at the start making contact with YOSSARIAN settling back.

LOUBOUTIN (J Parkes) - Slow away.

YOSSARIAN (R Myers) – Raced ungenerously getting its head in the air near the 900 metres, raced greenly under pressure in the home straight, briefly inconveniencing THE MIDNIGHT SHIFT near the 200 metres.

END OF STORY (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

THE MDINIGHT SHIFT (C Dell) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

Race 5 LIVAMOL 1200 (1200 metres)

DARCI'S DAY (L Hemi) Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after it dislodged its rider in the enclosure making contact with a plastic rail and was cleared to start. Rider L Hemi was examined by paramedics and cleared to ride.

LORD BUFFALO (J Fawcett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TOUGH KID (J Riddell) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

HOCICO BLANCO (S Rusof) - Raced greenly under pressure in the home straight.

Race 6 FASTTRACK INSURANCE/NZI 1200 (1200 metres)

DIVINE POWER (J Parkes) - Slow away.

PADDY BOURKE (T Johnson) - Tightened at the start when AWESOME AL jumped inwards settling back.

I AM GRACIE (J Fawcett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout, lay out under pressure in the home straight.

RUBY BLOOM (E McCall) -Ran up onto heels passing the 200 metres having to be angled outwards to improve near the 100 metres.

Race 7 VERTIGO CATERING MILE (1600 metres)

MATAURI (J Bayliss) - Connections reported the mare had come into season and were happy to run.

CYCLOPS (J Parkes) - Made contact with the hind quarters of COOL HAND DUKE shortly after the start, held up passing the 500 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.

TROUP ROAD (T Allan) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

COOL HAND DUKE (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

AZAREEL (B Grylls) - Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight

Race 8 TWILIGHT RACES @ HASTINGS 12/12 MILE (1600 metres)

MAKEITRAIN (S Collett) - Tightened at the start settling back when FRANKLIN began awkwardly dictating NOT ALLOWED and TERRA FIRMA outwards.

MISS LABASA (J Parkes) - Raced greenly throughout.

REAL BEACH (S Rusof) – Raced three wide throughout.

FRANKLIN (J Riddell) - Held up approaching the 200 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running near the 150 metres.
