Race 1	FLEMINGS ELECTRICAL MILE (1600 Metres)				
OUR SONNY BOY (J Parkes) - Awkwardly away settling back. When questioned into performance rider advised the					
gelding may appreciate more rain-affected going.					
STEVIE'S SURPRISE (T Allan) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages making the bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly dictating AQUA HOUSE wide on the track.					

AQUA HOUSE (R Hannam) – Dictated wide near 1400 metres then raced three wide without cover for the remainder.

PRINCE TURBO (J Waddell) - Contacted ITALIAN LOVER when improving to that runner's outside near the 700 metres.

ITALIAN LOVER (L Allpress) – Bumped 700 metres. Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

Track upgraded to Good 3 retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 STEVENSON & TAYLOR MILE (1600 Metres)

MAKOURA LODGE (L Allpress) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the request of the rider and was cleared to start.

ROCK IDOL (S Rusof) - Was removed from barrier and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after charging its starting gate and was late scratched.

J Parkes (SARDEEN) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in respect to the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres.

RIGEL (R Hannam) – Hung throughout.

Race 3 HATUMA LIME 1200 (1200 Metres)

DIVINE POWER (S McKay) – Late scratched after becoming fractious and flipping over in the barriers prior to the start. Rider S McKay was uninjured. Connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing next.

AMASTAR (D Johnson) - Was removed from the barrier adjacent to DIVINE POWER and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection as a precaution prior to being cleared to start.

ICEBOMB (S Rusof) – Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres and again passing the 300 metres before being angled outwards to improve near the 150 metres.

WINDSOR (J Parkes) – Hung throughout.

VINNIE'S VOLLEY (J Waddell) – Was attended to by the veterinary surgeon in the tie-up stalls post-race after showing signs of stress and a slow recovery.

Race 4

PENNY & TONY EBBETT 1200 (1200 Metres)

MY CALENDAR GIRL (R Hannam) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after contacting a rail in the enclosure and was cleared to start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LADY IN LACE (C O'Beirne) - Slow away, settling back.

SILHOUETTE BEAUTY (H Durrant) - Began awkwardly before being tightened and blundering at the start settling back.

GLASGOW GIRL (S McKay) – Slow away then tailed the field throughout. When questioned rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear. Connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing next.

Race 5 LUCY DE LAUTOUR 2100 (2100 Metres)

THE ROLLING STONE (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.

DAL QUATTRO (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly bumping SILENT SAM and settling back.

SILENT SAM (T Johnson) – Bumped start.

POROTENE MHIA (J Fawcett) - Slow away. Made the first bend awkwardly racing wide on the track before being allowed to improve to sit three wide on the pace for the remainder.

TRENDING (R Hannam) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay out rounding final turn.

VIOLET BREEZE (B Grylls) - Tightened rounding the final bend when DAL QUATTRO became awkwardly placed on the heels of TRENDING, which lay out rounding the home turn.

Race 6 BROOKE EDGECOMBE 3YO (1350 Metres)

DOUBLE ACT (M Singh) – Began awkwardly.

MAIDSTONE PARK (T Johnson) – Slow away.

TWEET (S Rusof) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 7 KIRSTY LAWRENCE 1350 (1350 Metres)

MY CLARITY (Z Moki) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after making contact with a post leaving the enclosure and was cleared to start.

LINCOLN'S COMMAND (J Parkes) – Slow away, was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear. Connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing next.

ANZHELIKA (T Allan) - Blundered at the start, shifting in and tightening SHEZA BEACH BABE and TEAPOT, which settled back.

TEAPOT (B Grylls) – Tightened at start, settled back.

SHEZA BEACH BABE (L Allpress) – Tightened at start, settling ack.

HANDSOME BLUE (S McKay) - Awkwardly away, settling back.

MARTINELLI (L Hemi) -Lay out in the home straight.

VELOCE (T Johnson) - Raced three wide on the pace throughout.

ETERNAL (J Waddell) - Briefly held up near the 275 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to improve.

Race 8 SIMON WILSON MILE (1600 Metres)

REGAL STEPS – Late scratching at 3.25pm due to change in track conditions.

CHOUXPERB (B Grylls) - Slow away. Had to be restrained off heels approaching the 1000 metres and when doing so shifted outwards contacting HE'S A FREAK. CHOUXPERB continued to race keenly for a distance. Briefly inconvenienced near the 350 metres when SERENITY lay inwards.

JOHNNY LINCOLN (R Hannam) - Slow away.

GALWAY LIL (C O'Beirne) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HE'S A FREAK (S Rusof) – Contacted 1000 metres. When questioned into performance rider said the gelding was feeling the firmer going and may be better suited to a more rain affected track. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

SERENITY (S McKay) - Lay inwards under pressure early in the home straight having to be straightened.
