Race 1	MASSEY FERGUSON AND FENDT AT JJ LTD R72 2100
<p>LIN (C Campbell) – Raced keenly and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>C Campbell (LIN) was reminded of his obligations in regard to riding his mounts out fully to the finish.</p>	
Race 2	COMCAT PLANT STRENGTHENING MAIDEN 2100
<p>TICKY TU (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>ICEBERG ROCK (B Morgenrood) – Hampered at the start, lay outwards passing the 1400 metres and continued to lay out throughout. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. The connections were advised that the gelding must trial to Stewards’ satisfaction prior to racing again.</p> <p>MAHANA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>BABY MENAKA (C Campbell) – Held up early in the run home having to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels, shifted inwards near the 250 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>ROCKWITHME (B Grylls) – Lay out under pressure passing the 250 metres and had to be straightened.</p>	
Race 3	ROBYN AND GARY CHAMBERLAIN SUPPORT DAFFODIL DAY R65 2100
<p>HOU LA LA (J Morris) – Began awkwardly, commenced to over race rounding the first turn having to be steadied, continued to get its head up and raced ungenerously through the middle stages.</p> <p>ADDITUP (Z Moki) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>LADY EM (C Johnson) – Unable to obtain clear running early in home straight ,shifted inwards passing the 150 metres</p> <p>HATRICK BOYS (B Grylls) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>SKEEN (L Callaway) – Had to be eased momentarily passing the 200 metres, briefly steadied when weakening to avoid the heels of LADY EM (C Johnson) which shifted inwards near the 150 metres. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>METASEQUOIA(T Comignaghi) Lay outwards throughout the home straight having to be straightened.</p>	
Race 4	ASHBURTON RACING CLUB COMMITTEE MAIDEN 3YO 1250
<p>SABRAGE (L Allpress) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection after having blood present in its mouth and was cleared to race. Jumped away awkwardly, commenced to over race passing the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance, the rider was unable to offer any excuse, with a post race veterinary inspection finding the filly to have a poor rate of recovery.</p> <p>NORMA JEAN (T Moseley) – Steadied momentarily passing the 1100 metres. when awkwardly placed on the inside of the heels of OCEAN OF CHAMPAGNE which was taken inwards by CAMPO (T Comignaghi).</p> <p>T Comignaghi was advised to exercise greater care.</p>	

OCEAN OF CHAMPAGNE (J Laking) – Held up passing the 500 metres.

STRATTON (C Johnson) - Held up passing the 500 metres.

SUFFRAGETTE (K Williams) – Had to be steadied when improving onto heels rounding the bend near the 400 metres and then had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

EXCLAIM (C Campbell) – Raced greenly and shifted ground inwards throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

DIORISSIMO (C Campbell) – Bounded at the start unbalancing the rider and losing ground, lay outwards and had to be straightened passing the 200 metres.

FORGED (K Mudhoo) – Underwent a post race veterinary inspection which showed the gelding to have a slow recovery rate.

K Mudhoo (FORGED) admitted a charge of failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at national race meetings for 2 weeks effective from the conclusion of racing on 30 August up to and including 16 September inclusive.

BRONNY'S LAD (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.Lost contact with body of the field despite the efforts of rider.

JEPEZZ GEORGE (J Lowry) – Slow to begin, steadied passing the 400 metres when in restricted room contacting a heel and blundering.

CLARA (B Grylls) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.Held up early in home straight obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

GATES TO RIO (C Campbell) – Raced three wide without cover.

FAUX PAS (T Moseley) – Made the bend awkwardly having to steady when laying outwards.

CARDRONA (J Laking) – Lay outwards early in the home straight and had to be steadied inwards off the heels of **CELTIC WONDER** passing the 400 metres, unbalanced when crowded near the 250 metres when racing to the outside of **SICHUAN DRAGON** which was taken out by **LET HER RIP RILEY** (BB Hong) which when attempting to improve to the outside of **KNEAZLE** when there was insufficient room to do so was taken out further by **KNEAZLE** (C Johnson) which lay out when placed under pressure continuing to shift outwards for a distance. Both **B Hong** (**LET HER RIP RILEY**) and **C Johnson** (**KNEAZLE**) were issued with warnings.

YIPPIEYIOH (R Mudhoo) - Steadied passing the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

SICHUAN DRAGON (S Muniandy) – Crowded 250 metres.

MADAM SWISS (C Johnson) – Slow to begin.

VICE MARSHALL(J Fawcett) -.Wide early stages.

ST REGIS (B Grylls) – Raced keenly in the early stages.Lay out throughout the home straight having to be straightened.

MY SOPRANO (T Moseley) – Raced wide throughout, steadied momentarily passing the 400 metres when awkwardly placed to the outside of SILVERMIST (K Mudhoo) which shifted outwards. K Mudhoo was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

BB Hong (TUFF GIRL) admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at national race meetings for 8 days effective 31 August to 14 September inclusive.

Race 8 | **PLACEMAKERS ASHBURTON MAIDEN 1600**

BANNOCK (E Wright) – Had to be restrained and checked when ADVENTURESS (J Morris) shifted inwards passing the 1200 metres when not clear, continued to over race when the tempo of the race eased.

J Morris (ADVENTURESS) admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of BANNOCK and steadying passing the 1200 metres resulting in BANNOCK being checked. The Judicial Committee suspended her licence to ride at national race meetings for 5 days effective from the conclusion of racing on 30 August up to and including 9 September. J Morris was further spoken to in regard to continuing to ease the tempo of the race for a distance following this incident.

ALBUT ME (K Mudhoo) – Over raced and had to steady due to the lack of tempo passing the 1100 metres.

PER FORM (L Allpress) – Over raced and had to steady due to the lack of tempo passing the 1100 metres, becoming awkwardly placed on heels shifting outwards and making firm contact with HEAD OFFICE.

HEAD OFFICE (T Moseley) – Over raced and had to steady due to the lack of tempo passing the 1100 metres, firmly contacted from the inside and shifted wider on the track as a result.

Race 9 | **SUPPORT US ON DAFFODIL DAY MID-CANTERBURY R65 1600**

GREY GHOST (J Anderson) – Slow to begin.

PAT IN BRACKETS (Z Moki) – Hampered leaving the barriers.

CROYDE (C Johnson) – Raced wide in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance, the rider could offer no tangible excuse and was disappointed with the run. Stewards will follow up with trainer in coming days.

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (J Morris) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding improved performance rider J Morris reported that the gelding had received a favourable run and was suited to racing in the clear adding she had been happy with its recent run but it had got further back than desired.

MADAME LIBRE (L Allpress) – Steadied when awkwardly placed between runners near the 250 metres.

ABRAXOS (T Moseley) – Lay inwards near the 200 metres. The rider was advised to exercise greater care.

VILLERET (G Saejorhor) – Steadied 200 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of ABRAXOS which shifted inwards.
