The connections of FIRE SHOW have advised that subsequent veterinary checks have revealed no abnormalities with the gelding continuing with its current campaign.

Race 1	KEVIN COYLE MEMORIAL (1800m)
FRANCONI (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin. Improved wide from the 700 metres.	
SKEEN (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide through the early stages.	
DOWRY DUTY (T Jonker) - Weakened over the concluding stages.	
MRS GEE EYE (K Kwo) - Lay out in the home straight and had to be straightened on a number of occasions with rider reporting the mare had raced greenly throughout.	
SIR ED (C Campbell) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported the gelding had been less than genuine in its efforts today.	

Race 2	AON INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP (1800m)
<p>GOLD'N'GURU (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>BANURY LAD (K Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early to middle stages. Raced wide from the 700 metres.</p> <p>THE QUIET MAN (A Bohorun) - Lay in over the final 100 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>WHAT'S UP ALF (B Murray) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding had traveled well during the running however when placed under pressure in the final straight had failed to respond to his urging s. Mr Murray could offer no other tangible explanation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 3	GORE TOWN & COUNTRY RESTAURANT (1200m)
<p>MCLAUGHLIN (K Kwo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SOUTHERN JAZZ (L Callaway) - Badly hampered at the start losing ground, when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>IRISH GURU (K Williams) - Bounded as the start was effected.</p> <p>SMOKE 'N PUMPKIN (J Morris) - Began awkwardly. Weakened from the 450 metres.</p> <p>REDFORD (T Moseley) - Inconvenienced by a tiring runner near the 450 metres. Lay in throughout the final straight with the rider using the whip in the left hand.</p> <p>XANTHA (S Muniandy) - Weakened from the 300 metres.</p> <p>BLUEY'S CHANCE (T Jonker) - When spoken to regarding the performance rider advised the gelding had hung for the majority of the event and had been disappointing.</p>	
Race 4	HOKONUI CONTRACTING/MERIAL ANCARE HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>BLACK LIZZIE (R Mudhoo) - Refused to load into the barriers and was declared a Late Scratching at 2.35pm. Connections were advised the mare must trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.</p> <p>TAPONISME (C Johnson) - Began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>KNUTQUACKER (K Williams) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ROC LEONE (B Murray) - Raced wide in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>BELLE HOPE (C Campbell) - Improved wide from the 600 metres.</p> <p>AJAY TEE (G Jogoo) - Shifted ground outwards near the 175 metres making firm contact with FREE AND EASY which was unbalanced and forced to race wider on the track.</p> <p>FREE AND EASY (J Morris) - Raced keenly in the early stages and wide throughout. Unbalanced and forced to race wider on the track near the 175 metres when contacted by inside runner.</p> <p>Following the running of this event the connections of FREE AND EASY lodged a Protest pursuant to Rule 642(1) into 2nd placing being awarded to AJAY TEE alleging interference near the 175 metres had been prejudicial to the chances of FREE AND EASY finishing second. After viewing replays and hearing evidence from connections and the riders involved the JCA upheld the Protest and relegated AJAY TEE to 3rd placing, with FREE AND EASY promoted to 2nd placing.</p> <p>Apprentice rider G Jogoo (AJAY TEE) with the assistance of senior rider C Johnson admitted a subsequent breach of Careless Riding, in that he allowed his mount to shift ground outwards under hard riding near the 175 metres resulting in FREE AND EASY being contacted and forced over extra ground. After viewing replays and hearing submissions on penalty the JCA imposed a suspension of Mr Jogoo's riding licence from the 1st October up to and including the 11th October (7 riding days.)</p>	
Race 5	CROYDEN CONTRACTING HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>TANIWHA (J Morris) - Slow through the early stages.</p> <p>EPIC DREAMER (A Bohorun) - Over-raced in the early stages and was obliged to race wide without cover from the 800</p>	

metres. Lay in throughout the run home. Rider reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MOTORBOAT MIKE (D Bothamley) - Raced wide from the 600 metres.

Race 6 | **DAVIS SHEARING (1335m)**

RED ROSETTE (K Williams) - Restrained to the rear of the field on jumping. Obligated to race wide round the final bend.

BREAKDANCE (C Campbell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LITTLE BOSSING (K Kwo) - Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres and had to shift ground outwards round the final bend to find clear racing room.

ALI MAGEE (R Mudhoo) - Hampered by a tiring runner near the 100 metres and had to shift ground outwards passing the 75 metres.

Race 7 | **LIVESTOCK SUPPLIES HANDICAP (1335m)**

JUMEIRAH (C Barnes) - Reared and shifted out abruptly at the start hampering LIL MISS SWISS which lost ground.

LIL MISS SWISS (K Kwo) - Hampered by inside runner on jumping and lost ground.

NESTA (L Callaway) - Raced wide in the early stages and over-raced through the middle stages. Inconvenienced by inside runner near the 200 metres.

WESTERLY (T Moseley) - Lay inwards rounding the final bend with the rider swapping the whip to the left hand.

THE BUMPER (C Campbell) - Shifted out abruptly passing the 200 metres inconveniencing outside runners and had to be straightened.

WILD JACK (A Bohorun) - Inconvenienced by inside runner near the 200 metres.
