RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 SUPPORT PHAR LAP RACEWAY MAIDEN 1200m

ASTRAL WEEKS (K Williams) - Slow to begin commenced to buck shortly after the start dislodging its rider. K Williams was examined by St John Paramedics and stood down from her remaining rides, with a medical clearance required prior to racing next. The connections were advised that ASTRAL WEEKS must barrier trial to Stewards' satisfaction prior to racing next.

MOET MISTRESS (J Lowry) – Slow to begin and then bucked losing considerable ground. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

SPACE CADET (J Morris) – Raced wide in the early stages.

PERFIDIA (G Jogoo) - Raced wide in the early stages.

GET RYTHM (L Callaway) – Raced wide throughout.

BLAIR FLIGHT (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout.

CLARA (A Calder) – Lay outwards throughout.

OCEAN OF CHAMPAGNE (S Rusof) – Awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

AIR MAX (J Lowry) – Hampered between runners at the start, lay inwards throughout the home straight.

UPSCALE (A Calder) – Hampered between runners at the start.

EL BEE JACK (B Murray) – Raced greenly in the early stages, raced fiercely for a short distance near the 1000 metres.

SEVERINE (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout, came together with FINAL SAVINGS and brushed over the concluding stages.

OPHELIA ROSE (T Moseley) – Heavily restrained for some distance passing the 1800 metres when making the bend awkwardly.

RECOMMENDED FLIGHT (K Kwo) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 900 metres having to be restrained off heels, lay inwards near the 300 metres having to be straightened and continued to lay inwards for some distance. The connections were advised that a racing manners warning would be placed against the filly's record.

FINAL SAVINGS (G Jogoo) – Came together with SEVERINE and brushed over the concluding stages.

Race 3	D'CASH MAIDEN DASH 1200m

SMART GARDEN (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly, held up in the early stages of the home straight.

HERMANO ROSE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly and became awkwardly placed on heels having to be restrained.

ZAGREB (A Calder) – Raced wide throughout.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (T Jonker) – Made contact with DARCI CAN (K Mudhoo) on a number of occasions in the early stages, restrained when awkwardly placed inside heels passing the 900 metres, raced wide throughout.

DARCI CAN (K Mudhoo) - Made contact with BLUEY'S CHANCE on a number of occasions in the early stages, raced wide throughout.

K Mudhoo (DARCI CAN) was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift ground when insufficiently clear.

LUNAR LADY (A Morgan) – Lay inwards passing the 300 metres when under pressure.

Race 4 MORE FM SPRINT 1200m

JAMIE was late scratched at 11.15 am on veterinary advice when found to be lame. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to the gelding racing next.

Trainer **M Tapper** (ZAYZAY) was warned for presenting with incorrect gear.

ULTRA CHIC (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin, raced wide from the 800 metres.

ACEKINGSUITED (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly.

SO NATURAL (B Morgenrood) – Crowded shortly after the start getting back as a result.

GRAND DUKE (T Jonker) – Got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 900 metres when being restrained.

SMOKE HOUSE BAY (S Rusof) – Held up near the 350 metres and had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

Race 5 LJ HOOKER GROUP IMPROVERS 1200m

SILVERMIST (K Mudhoo) – Bounded at the start and got back.

FLASH SUGGESTION (C Campbell) – Held up near the 350 metres and had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) – Lay inwards throughout the run home.

TAREE (S Collett) – When questioned regarding the performance of this favoured runner, the rider advised that the filly was unsuited to today's holding track conditions.

Race 6 DIANNE MCINTOSH CATERING HANDICAP 1200m

SUMMER MONSOON – Rider J Laking replaced S Rusof who was unable to make the contract weight. S Rusof was fined \$100.

Trainer **N Ridley** was warned for presenting HE KIN FLY without notified gear.

VOLCANO (S Jamie) – Slow to begin.

THE REAL DEAL (R Mudhoo) – Made the bend near the 900 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of the heels of HE KIN FLY which was taken inwards by CELTIC CROSS which stepped in momentarily, held up near the 300 metres. Awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres, raced in restricted room for some distance passing the 100 metres having to be steadied.

ON POINT (T Moseley) – Raced ungenerously when in restricted room passing the 900 metres. When questioned about performance the rider reported that the mare had peaked on her efforts over the concluding stages and in his opinion would take benefit from today's race.

NAKYAMA (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide throughout.

IRISH CALL (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout.

FLYTIME (K Mudhoo) – Lay outwards making the final bend having to be straightened, hampered 300 metres.

CELTIC CROSS (A Calder) – Shifted inwards passing the 300 metres and straightened immediately hampering FLYTIME which had to steady resulting in THE REAL DEAL becoming awkwardly placed on heels and having to steady and shift outwards to crowd the running of OPIHI RANGER which had to be steadied. Continued to shift inwards near the 100 metres causing HE KIN FLY to steady. A Calder (CELTIC CROSS) was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. When questioned about the improved performance trainer A Carson attributed this to the mare appreciating a more senior rider.

OPIHI RANGER (G Jogoo) Steadied for some distance when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres, further steadied when on heels inside the 100 metres.

VICE MARSHALL (Z Moki) – Raced keenly when leading.

HE KIN FLY (S Collett) – Placed in restricted room approaching the 100 metres having to steady. Payment of dividends was delayed while the connections viewed video replays before deciding not to proceed with a protest.

Race 7 GREY WAY MILE 1600m

PAT IN BRACKETS – Rider C Barnes replaced J Lowry due to a communication error.

BATTLE KAT (L Callaway) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection before being cleared to race.

PAT IN BRACKETS (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

Race 8

STELLACANTO (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

SPLENDIOR (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly. Held up for a short distance passing the 300 metres.

BRIDGET TOWN (Z Moki) – Held up early in the final straight until near the 180 metres.

EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES HANDICAP 1600m

RESPLENDENT GLORY (A Calder) – Proved difficult to load delaying the start. The connections were advised that a barrier manners warning would be placed on the gelding's record. Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1100

metres, placed in restricted room momentarily passing the 150 metres when awkwardly placed to the outside of KINGS PAL which shifted outwards, buffeted between KINGS PAL and SWING NOTE over the concluding stages and raced in restricted room.

LOCHAN ORA (G Saejorhor) – Slow to begin.

NESTA (L Callaway) – Got its head up when making the bend near the 900 metres.

KINGS PAL (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the early stages, lay outwards in the home straight.

EL BEE DARCI (S Collett) – Steadied passing the 1500 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of NESTA which shifted inwards. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care. Was not persevered with over the concluding stages and underwent a post race veterinary inspection which revealed a slow rate of recovery. Trainer R McKay suggested that the gelding did not handle the prevailing track conditions.

SWING NOTE (J Laking) – When questioned regarding the performance of this favoured runner, rider J Laking reported that the mare had failed to handle the prevailing track conditions.

Race 9 QUIZ NIGHT AT THE ASCOT MAIDEN 1600m

PRODUCER (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

WANDERIN OVER (T Moseley) – Raced wide in the early stages.

ALBUT ME (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the middle stages, lay inwards in the final straight, made contact with ZURAFAA near the 100 metres and then brushed over the concluding stages.

MUSEE D'ORSAY (R Mudhoo) – Held up by a tiring runner passing the 600 metres.

ZEDAAM (C Barnes) – Gave ground from the 600 metres.

ZURAFAA (L Callaway) – Lay inwards in the final straight, made contact with ALBUT ME near the 100 metres and brushed over the concluding stages.

THE SAINTLY ONE (K Kwo) – Lay inwards in the final straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 10 LION BEVERAGES STAYERS 2100m

THE QUIET MAN (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin.

SHOW MACCOOL (T Moseley) – Raced wide in the early stages.

SHOCKTILLYOUDROP (A Calder) – Raced wide in the early stages.

DOWRY DUTY (S Collett) – Improved wide from the 1300 metres

METASEQUOIA (G Jogoo) – Lay outwards passing the 200 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage and dictating ADDITUP wider on the track.

Race 11 RACE IMAGES MAIDEN 2100m

WENTWORTH (L Callaway) – Made the first bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly shifting outwards.

MAHANA (S Collett) – Blundered passing the 1700 metres making the first bend awkwardly.

ENTIRELY (C Campbell) – Raced ungenerously near the 1700 metres shifting ground outwards forcing MAHANA over extra ground.

TICKY TU (K Mudhoo) – Shifted in and made contact with the running rail at the 1700 metres and then shifted out abruptly forcing PAINTED ANGEL and WENTWORTH wider, raced in restricted room passing the 250 metres shifting ground outwards to obtain clear running making contact with HEAD OFFICE which was dictated wider as a result. K Mudhoo was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

BAL HARBOUR (T Moseley) – Made the first bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly, raced wide from the 1000 metres.

SEKATIA (G Jogoo) – Over raced and had to be steadied when awkwardly positioned inside the heels of TICKY TU shortly after the crossing near the 1650 metres.
