Waverley 4 October 2018 – OZIL – Trainer M Breslin reported that he had been happy with OZIL and that he had improved with the run and would continue with his current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 POWER FARMING TARANAKI 2100

 KATIEM MARIE (Z Moki) – Began awkwardly. Held up for a short distance entering the home straight and again over the final stages. Become awkwardly placed inside the heels of RED RASCAL near the 1000 metres.

VANNOSS (R Hannam) – Jumped outwards at the start tightening HUMBLE PIE.

HUMBLE PIE (R Myers) – Tightened at start. Raced greenly under pressure in the home straight.

RED RASCAL (S McKay) – Restrained off heels near the 1800 metres going back on to KIRKLAND which was hampered.

KIRKLAND (J Parkes) – Hampered near the 1800 metres then restrained off heels again near the 1700 metres. When questioned J Parkes advised his instructions were to ride the gelding back but was of the opinion the lack of pace in the early and middle stages of the race did not suit his mount on this occasion.

WOTAMISSION (C Dell) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

LOVETOKEEPHIM (W Pinn) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned into the run of LOVETOKEEHIM which finished well back W Pinn advised the gelding had little left after racing wide throughout.

GALWAY LIL (C O'Beirne) – Awkwardly away.			

KOLEE (Z Moki) - Race three wide without cover throughout.

HERENGAWE (L Allpress) – Wide throughout.

SURREY (R Elliot) – Held up rounding the turn then checked near the 350 metres when ADONIS (M Singh) was angled out when not clear. Also affected were CALL ME IRISH and RUFFY RAHTWO which were tightened. M Singh admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 18/10 to 24/10/18 inclusive (5 days).

CALL ME IRISH (W Pinn) – Hampered then held up entering the home straight having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running inside the 200 metres.

RUFFY RAHTWO (A Shin) - Tightened near the 350 metres.

Race 3 LA NUOVA APPARELMASTER 1600

GLORY DAYS - (W Pinn) - Slow away.

RENE (L Allpress) – Slow away.

KIRKENES (B Grylls) – Awkwardly away.

NUNCHUCKS – Awkwardly away settling back.

CHOICE ATTITUDE (R Elliot) – Hung throughout running wide on the track rounding the turn near the 800 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare had failed to make the bend running wide on the track. Connections were advised a warning has been placed against the geldings racing manners.

RAZORS EDGE (T Johnson) – Held up from the 400 metres having to be angled inwards across heels to gain clear running near the 200 metres.

Race 4 CORSON MAIZE 1200

MARS BARS (W Pinn) – Tightened at the start settling back and then hampered when looking to improve near the 900 metres after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KING'S CROSS which lay inwards.

MISS LIZZIE (C Dell) – Jumped inwards at the start bumping and tightening MARS BAR which settled back then raced erratically throughout.

MIDDAGURD (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly contacting WINDSOR. Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Shifted inwards when being restrained after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS LIZZIE approaching the 200 metres.

LIQUID INSPIRATION (S McKay) – Lay out having to be restrained passing the 600 metres. Held up from the 400 metres until early in the home straight then again near the 200 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to improve, then tightened over the final stages when MARS BARS (W Pinn) shifted in simultaneously as ROCK N AFFAIR (T Allan) shifted out. Connections of LIQUID INSPIRATION viewed footage of the final stages with a view to lodging an objection against the 1st and 2nd place getters but elected not to proceed. Both W Pinn and T Allan were advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

ROCK 'N' AFFAIR (T Allan) – Held up approaching the 400 metres angling outwards to improve near the 200 metres.

CLASSY LANE (D Bradley) – Lost the near fore plate during the running.

Race 5 HAWERA WELDING 1400

EMPRESS TZU HSI (L Allpress) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SUPER GIRL (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

WAFER (J Parkes) – Raced wide throughout without cover.

FULLY CHARGED (T Johnson) – Tightened at the start settling back when ARIDITY began awkwardly. Held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres. Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

ARIDITY (S Rusof) – Shifted inwards passing the 100 metres contacting HEINEKEN ROCKS.

Race 6 SOUTH TARANAKI CLUB EGMONT CUP

STROLLING VAGABOND (R Elliot) – Slow away. Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres.

NITRO TED (T Johnson) – Slow away.

LADIES FIRST (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

C O'Beirne (SAMPSON) – Raced three wide on the pace in the back straight so was taken forward near the 900 metres. C O'Beirne was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing her mount to shift inwards near the 900 metres when not sufficient clear of GOBSTOPPER which was hampered.

GOBSTOPPER (J Parkes) – Hampered 900 metres then gave ground rounding the home turn. When questioned J Parkes advised that after being taken on in the back straight the gelding had little left rounding the turn.

ITELLYOUONETHING (M Singh) – Held up behind the tiring GOBSTOPPER approaching the 600 metres.

Race 7

MCCURDY TRYCJS 1400

KING COUGAR (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly dictating HARTLEY outwards on to BROTHER ONE which was tightened settling back. Lay out near the 350 metres.

BREAK MY STRIDE (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly.

HARTLEY (R Myers) – Dictated outwards at start.

BROTHER ONE (T Newman) – Tightened at the start.

PERFECT HARMONEE (L Allpress) – Shifted out abruptly at the start tightening RAM SAM SAM which settled back.

BISOU BISOU (D Hirini) – Slow away. Held up briefly near the 350 metres having to be angled across heels to improve wide on the track

RAM SAM SAM (C O'Beirne) – Held up for a short distance early in the home straight. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area consistent with having made contact with the starting gates.

MONRECOUR (R Elliot) – Held up near the home turn.

BALHAM (T Taiaroa) and **RAM SAM SAM** were tightened near the 350 metres when MONRECOUR improved to their inside simultaneously as KING COUGAR lay outwards making the bend. After questioning riders and viewing video footage no blame could be fully attributed to any one rider, nevertheless R Elliot was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Race 8 RICH HILL STUD TARANAKI BREEDERS STAKES

DESTINY ONE (Z Moki) – Reared as the start was effected settling back.

RAYAS (B Grylls) – Slow away.

ROSEWOOD (L Allpress) – Slow away and trailed the field throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider L Allpress reported that the mare had been unable to keep up on the better going.

RUBY ARMANI (D Bradley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Had blood in the right nostril on returning to the enclosure consistent with having hit the front of its gate.

DARSCAPE PRINCESS (J Parkes) – Lay out shortly after the start dictating RUBY ARMANI and YEARN wider on the track. Lay out passing the 100 metres then shifted out and away from ART DECO and in doing so tightened YEARN which was checked near the finish.

ART DECO (W Pinn) – Shifted out and away from HENI over the final stages.

YEARN (S Rusof) – Tightened and checked near the finish when there was outward movement from DARSCAPE PRINCESS which lay out and away from ART DECO. After questioning rider S Yusof Stewards took into account simultaneous inward movement from EXCELLERATION and LIVIN ON A PRAYER when assessing interference.

HENI (R Myers) – Dictated outwards over the final 100 metres having to be restrained when NICOLETTA shifted ground. J Riddell subsequently admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards when not clear. After submissions J Riddell had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 17/10/18 to 2/11/18 inclusive and fined \$500. (12 days)

Race 9 WALKER BROS TRANSPORT 1400

TIPPING POINT (R Myers) – Began awkwardly settling back. Tightened and contacted PRINCESS RAAJ near the 300 metres.

SMOKEN' ACE (A Shin) – Jumped outwards at the start making contact with KOTAHI.

KOTAHI (J Parkes) – Contacted at the start.

KOKO BELLE (B Grylls) – Briefly inconvenienced by the tiring SMOKEN ACE near the 500 metres.

GLADSTONE BELLE (C O'Beirne) – Hampered near the 350 metres when THE RIPPA improved to the outside of VIVA LILLI which hung outwards.

THATZ LOUIE (C Dell) – Shifted inwards before being straightened when struck with the whip near the 300 metres tightening TIPPING POINT which contacted PRINCESS RAAJ. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PRINCESS RAAJ (R Elliot) - Contacted near 300 metres.

VIVA LILLI (L Allpress) – Rider reported the mare had hung throughout placing her at a disadvantage. Raced wide throughout.
