RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TOTAL MORTGAGES 1600
<p>TATTYBOGLER (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the lead in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>FANCY MORE (J Waddell) - Held up passing the 300 metres and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running, became unbalanced when making contact with EASY M'LADY near the 250 metres being relegated from 3RD placing following an inquiry.</p> <p>EASY M'LADY (C Lammas) - Unbalanced when bumped near the 250 metres being promoted from 4th following an inquiry.</p>	

Following the race a protest was lodged by the connections of the 4th placed horse EASY M'LADY alleging interference by the 3rd placed horse FANCY MORE near the 250 metres with the Judicial Committee upholding the protest relegating FANCY MORE to 4th placing.

Race 2	FOSTER CONSTRUCTION 1200

COPPER MINE - Connections opted to replace T Harris with O Bosson after being contacted by T Harris on race morning advising that he would be 0.5kg overweight.

TIME TO FLY (M Hills) - Slow to begin, firmly restrained to avoid heels approaching the 600 metres.

NO FINER PINS (C Johnson) - Began awkwardly, held up rounding the final turn from the 600 metres and early in the straight, shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 100 metres.

TERRACOTTA WARRIOR (L Allpress) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.

COMEBACK (R Elliot) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages, held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight making contact with MATUZALEM when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

MING'S EMPEROR (L Satherley) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race, bumped approaching the 400 metres.

C Johnson - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards rounding the final turn crowding ZAPPEUR which was racing tight to the outside of TIME TO FLY.

ZAPPEUR (S Collet) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 700 metres, crowded rounding the final bend approaching the 400 metres.

ALVINS DREAM (S Rusof) - Crowded rounding the final bend approaching the 400 metres by HIGHFALUTIN GAL which, when improving quickly, became awkwardly placed outside the heels of COMEBACK (R Elliot) which shifted outwards. R Elliot was advised to exercise care.

R Elliot - Issued with a warning after angling outwards near the 300 metres making contact with MATUZALEM.

MATUZALEM (S McKay) - Bumped near the 300 metres.

WHEAO (V Colgan) - Began very awkwardly losing ground.

RODOFLO (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BOBBY DEE (M Cameron) - Went off-stride losing ground near the 1100 metres with rider advising that the gelding had shied at the running rail, hampered as a result was DANELYN.

DANELYN (S McKay) - Hampered near the 1100 metres.

HAVOC (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover, hung outwards rounding the final turn.

JUSTA BOY BULLSEYE (A Calder) - Hampered entering the final straight when LADY SEQUOYAH lay in.

Race 4	DISTINCTION HAMILTON 1400

ABRAHAM'S (S Rusof) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final turn until near the 200 metres.

SIERRA VISTA (S Collett) - Slow to begin, was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

MY SKY (M Coleman) - Blundered badly leaving the barriers.

LIVVY LASS (S McKay) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

RHINESTONE COWBOY (J Waddell) - Slow to begin, raced three wide without cover.

OSTREIDAE (L Allpress) - Hampered soon after leaving the barriers. Failed to respond to its rider's urgings from near the 800 metres and after becoming tailed off was not persevered with in the final straight being retired from the race. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality. Co-trainer Mr G Parker was advised that the filly is required to trial satisfactorily prior to racing again.

PONT ALMA (J Bayliss) - Hampered soon after leaving the barriers, held up rounding the final turn and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

TAKEITLIKEAMAN (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

FIRE KATYUSHA (R Smyth) - Over raced outside the leader in the middle stages.

Race 5	BCD GROUP 2100

ADRIATIC PEARL (T Thornton) - Slow to begin.

CARICATURE (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly. A light pad which was part of the packing under the saddle became detached near the 1000 metres. D Johnson advised that she had repositioned her saddle at the start and felt she may not have repositioned the pad in line with her other gear. This omission made no discernible difference to her weight when weighing in after the race.

WOODEN EDGE (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly, had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

DELUXE EDITION (R Scott) - Raced wide without cover.

TWEEDLEDEE (S Collett) - Had to be steadied near the 1500 metres when WAIPAPI LAD (J Fawcett) shifted inwards when not fully clear. J Fawcett was advised to exercise greater care.

ZANYETTA (M Coleman) - Held up rounding the final turn and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

LUCKY DREAMER (L Satherley) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.

CHACHI ARCOLA (D Danis) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.

MR BIG (C Dell) - Over raced in the early to middle stages.

EL JODI (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SURREY (M Cameron) - Held up until near the 250 metres.

KORAKONUI (S Collett) - Held up until passing the 200 metres.

GEORGETHEFIFTH (R Jones) - Held up near the 250 metres.

Race 7	JAMES AND ANNIE SARTEN MEMORIAL STAKES (1400)

BIT LIPPY (C Lammas) - Slow to begin.

QUIZMASTER (S Collett) - Slow to begin, steadied when over racing near the 1000 metres.

DRATINI (L Allpress) - Over raced badly through the early and middle stages, firmly restrained when awkwardly placed near heels rounding the final bend approaching the 400 metres.

QJI EXPRESS (S Rusof) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages, held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting outwards across the heels of SWORD OF OSMAN near the 150 metres.

RIP EM UP (D Johnson) - Inconvenienced near the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that after getting back the filly had not been suited by the slow tempo of the race in the early to middle stages adding that the filly will in her opinion, be best suited over more distance and may appreciate some easing of the ground.

MADISON COUNTY (M Cameron) - Had to be steadied and shift outwards when improving onto the heels of ARROGANT near the 1000 metres inconveniencing RIP EM UP.

Race 8	WEALLEANS 1600

JUSTAMAIZ (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly, held up rounding the final turn making contact with MARCELLINA when shifting outwards to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.

MARCELLINA (M Cameron) - Bumped passing the 400 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in his opinion the mare would now be better suited over more distance and may appreciate some easing of the ground.

HINERANGI (O Bosson) - Commenced to over race passing the 1200 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the mare had peaked on its run in the straight and in his opinion would derive further improvement from the race.

ANIMATOR (C Dell) - Hung inwards badly in the final straight and was unable to be ridden fully out.
