RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HARRISONS ENERGY SOLUTIONS PREMIER (1200 Metres)

TOTAL EXCESS (J Waddell) - Removed from the barriers and late scratched by the veterinary surgeon after becoming fractious in its stall. Connections were advised the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing next.

MISS VALENCIA (B Grylls) - Which was in the stall adjacent to TOTAL EXCESS was removed, checked by the veterinary surgeon and cleared to start. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

PRINCESS AMELIE (J Parkes) –Blundered at the start.

CLEAVER (C Lammas) - Jumped outwards at the start dictating MORE WONDER. Raced three wide without cover

MORE WONDER (L Allpress) - Dictated start. Briefly inconvenienced 200 metres.

MOLTO VELOCE (S Collett) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

WHAT A SMASHER (R Myers) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 200 metres briefly inconveniencing MORE WONDER.

Race 2 HARRISONS CARPET PREMIER (1200 Metres)

PADDY BOURKE (T Johnson) - Began awkwardly settling back.

KING COUGAR (S O'Malley) - Blundered at the start tightening MAGICELLA, which settled back.

TELLYAWHAT (W Pinn) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SLEEK SECRET (A Goindasamy) - Held up near the 600 metres and again approaching the 400 metres before being angled outwards across heels making contact with PERFECT HARMONEE when attempting a marginal run between that runner and MANHATTAN STREET. Gained clear running near the 150 metres.

PERFECT HARMONEE (C O'Beirne) – Held up for a distance near the 500 metres. Contacted then raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

MAGICELLA (R Myers) – Tightened at start settling back. Jumped a darker patch of grass near the 50 metres.

Race 3 BCD TRAVEL RUGBY & RACING TOUR TO JAPAN RWC, WITH DES COPPINS PREMIER (2400 Metres)

SYLVESTER (J Waddell) – Slow away.

MONARCH CHIMES (D Bradley) - Tightened at the start settling back.

DUPLICITY (J Parkes) - Tightened at the start and got back.

ITELLYOUONETHING (T Johnson) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

BIZZWINKLE (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

Race 4 HANLEY FORMULA WELLESLEY STAKES (1000 Metres)

EXUBERANT (J Waddell) – Lay outwards making the crossing on to the course proper. Bumped with LAST SIGHT passing the 400 metres.

MEDIA (R Hannam) - Raced keenly in the early stages and when being restrained off the heels of BEAUTY DIVA approaching the 600 metres, shifted out briefly inconveniencing SAI FAH.

LAST SIGHT (C Lammas) – Bumped 400 metres.

THE TAILORS NIECE (J Parkes) - Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres prior to being angled outwards in

order to improve.

APPELLANT (S Collett) - Raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 200 metres then lay out under pressure over the final stages.

FIRST ROCK (B Grylls) – When questioned into performance rider advised the filly had travelled well during the running but had been disappointing in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

BEAUTY DIVA (L Satherley) – Raced greenly in the early stages. Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

SAI FAH (R Myers) – Raced three wide without throughout.

Race 5 EL CHEAPO CARS PREMIER (2200 Metres)

KAMANDA LINCOLN (S Collett) - Slow away.

EM KAY POPS (L Satherley) – Awkwardly away settling back.

ZEDAC (M Singh) - Slow away.

ZED LEPPELIN (B Grylls) - Shifted out and away from ALL IN STITCHES near the 350 metres, contacting and dictating CLASS ABOVE, hampering KATIEM MARIE.

CLASS ABOVE (S O'Malley) – Contacted and dictated 350 metres.

KATIE MARIE (Z Moki) - Hampered 350 metres. Briefly held up near the 150 metres.

NO TIP (D Hirini) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LEADING ROLE (L Hemi) - Shifted out under pressure approaching the 100 metres.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (S Collett) – Briefly held up near the 200 metres. Bumped with VENCEDORA near the 50 metres.

VENCEDORA (L Allpress) – Bumped near 50 metres.

R Hannam (VANNOSS) - Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) with regard to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 HIREMASTER PREMIER (1400 Metres)

LINCOLN RAIDER (T Johnson) - Slow away

RUSTY IN MELBOURNE (D Bradley) - Slow away.

Race 7 SAVVY COUP DO IT FOR MICHAEL PREMIER (1400 Metres)

ROCK BAND (Z Moki) – Slow away.

BROTHER ONE (B Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GET SCHRODER (J Parkes) - Checked shortly after the start.

BRING TO THE BLOCK (L Hemi) - Checked shortly after the start.

A Goindasamy (MANHATTAN FLAME) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not clear of BRING TO THE BLOCK and GET SCHROEDER, which were checked. After submissions A Goindasamy had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 31 October up to and including racing on Wednesday 7 November (6 days).

MANHATTAN FLAME (A Goindasamy) – Briefly held up near the 150 metres.

W Pinn (RUBY LOVE) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount to shift out under hard riding inside the final 100 metres, tightening BELLE FASCINO. Stewards took into account the inward movement of LADY KARTEL when assessing the interference.

BELLE FASCINO (S Collett) – Tightened inside the final 100 metres.

ROCK ISLAND LINE (R Hannam) - Denied a run near the 250 metres so was angled outwards to improve.

Track downgraded to Dead (6) following Race 7 after persistent rain.

Race 8 GEE & HICKTON THOMPSON HANDICAP (1600 Metres)

RED SIERRA (C O'Beirne) - Tightened at the start settling back.

RAW IMPULSE (J Parkes) – Slow away.

DANGER DEE (L Satherley) - Raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained early.

RAYAS (B Grylls) – Tightened shortly after the start then restrained near the 1400 metres when FAWN (C Lammas) shifted inwards. C Lammas was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres.

ART DECO (W Pinn) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

VINEVALE (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

WYNDSPELLE (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly. When questioned into performance rider advised the tempo and rain-affected track conditions had not been beneficial to the horse on this occasion.

Race 9 HARRISONS CURTAINS & BLINDS PREMIER (1600 Metres)

CUTTING UP ROUGH (A Goindasamy) – Slow away.

CHOICE ATTITUDE (R Hannam) – Blundered at the start. Gave ground approaching the home turn and finished well back. R Hannam reported the gelding pulled up in a normal post-race condition and he could offer no excuse.

KAIPAWE (S Collett) – Slow away.

GLIMPSE (C Lammas) - When questioned into performance rider advised that he considered something may have been amiss. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have fibrillated and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

CALL ME IRISH (M Singh) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary inspection, the gelding was confirmed to have bled. CALL ME IRISH is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.

D Hirini (LADY GUINNESS) -Reminded of her obligations regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres when marginally outside the guidelines.

T Taiaroa (BALHAM) – Was shown footage of her ride in the presence of her employer and reminded of her obligation to ride her mount out fully to the finish after relaxing her ride over the final stages.
