GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1PRYDE'S EASIFEED RATING 72 (1800m)I'LLAV BUBBLES (W Cameron) - Lost its footing and blundered leaving the barriers. When questioned regarding
performance rider was of the opinion that the mare would be better suited by more rain affected footing.

LONGFORD (J Lowry) - Slow to begin, held up near the 400 metres having to shift inwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

OPIHI RANGER (K Cowan) - Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

SMILING ASSASSIN (C Campbell) - Raced ungenerously getting its head up when being restrained in the middle stages, held up near the 400 metres.

WIDE AWAKE (S Rusof) - Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

Race 2 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (800m)

FORGOT THE SULKY (T Comignaghi) - Declared a late scratching at 1.16 pm after getting down in its barrier stall becoming cast for a period then escaping riderless when freed. The connections were advised that the colt must barrier trial to Stewards' satisfaction prior to racing next. A subsequent veterinary inspection found the colt to have suffered superficial abrasions along with muscle soreness in its back with a veterinary certificate of fitness required prior to trailing or racing next. Rider T Comignaghi was examined by St John Paramedics and stood down for the remainder of the day with a hand injury.

HE'S GOT POWER (B Murray) - Slow to begin and after failing to hit out freely in the early stages was pulled up by its rider who reported that the colt had felt sore. A post race veterinary examination found HE'S GOT THE POWER to be sore in the right front foot along with muscle soreness in its back. The connections were advised that a vet clearance would be required prior to racing next.

GLOBAL STAR (T Moseley) - Crowded on jumping when KHITAN WARRIOR shifted outwards and BUTTON shifted inwards.

SANCTIFY (J Bayliss) - Raced wide throughout.

DIVA EXPRESS (L Callaway) - Lay outwards rounding the bend.

KHITAN WARRIOR (J Lowry) - On return to the birdcage the rider reported that the colt had felt shin sore. Trainer L Robinson advised that the colt will be gelded and given a brief let up.

Race 3 CANTERBURY LANDSCAPE SUPPLIES RATING 72 (1200m)

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) - Began awkwardly.

VENDIMA (T Moseley) - Slow to begin, raced ungenerously when being restrained in the middle stages.

ZAKYNTHOS (B Murray) - Slow to begin, steadied to avoid heels near the 700 metres.

HEE'S OUR SECRET (S Muniandy) - Raced wide without cover.

LAKE CHALICE (K Cowan) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse, advising that the mare had felt flat throughout.

Race 4 NZB READY TO RUN SALE RATING 65 (1200m)

LADY BYRON (B Murray) - Hampered leaving the barriers. B Murray was spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention.

JAMIE (C Campbell) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

ACEKINGSUITED (K Kwo) - Raced in restricted room in the early stages.

NON BLONDE (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

TAREE (K Cowan) - Raced wide throughout.

QUEEN JETSUN (T Jonker) - Raced wide throughout.

CONCLUSION (J Laking) - Held up rounding the final turn.

PARVINA (S Rusof) - Held up entering the final straight, again held up passing the 250 metres and did not obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.

WHY ME (J Morris) - Inconvenienced passing the 400 metres when QUEEN JETSUN lay out.

 COUPLAND'S BAKERIES MILE TRIAL (1400m)

 VOLCANO (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

BOOTS 'N' ALL (J Lowry) - Slow to begin.

SON OF MAHER (M Cameron) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after getting back in a race that was run at a slow tempo the gelding had then been unable to recover.

HE'S GOLD (G Saejorhor) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 6 ZACINTO STAKES (1600m)

SABRAGE (K Cowan) - Crowded on jumping, hampered getting its head up when having to be firmly restrained after improving onto the heels of IN A TWINKLING passing the 1400 metres.

THE CHOSEN ONE (M Cameron) - Crowded on jumping.

FIRE SHOW (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly and shifted outwards, held up near the 400 metres, crowded approaching the 300 metres.

IN A TWINKLING (S Rusof) - Jumped away awkwardly, steadied passing the 1400 metres, bumped near the 350 metres.

B Murray - Issued with a warning in that when correcting his mount which lay in under pressure near the 350 metres he then permitted it to shift outwards crowding FIRE SHOW onto IN A TWINKLING.

CASUAL WINKS (L Callaway) - Raced wide throughout.

MISS CURIOUS (B Murray) - Raced wide throughout, lay in under pressure 350 metres having to be corrected by its rider, checked passing the 200 metres.

G Jogoo (FIRE SHOW) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards passing the 200 metres when not sufficiently clear resulting in MISS CURIOUS and EMILY MARGARET being checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended G Jogoo's licence to ride at race meetings for 9 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 4 November up to and including racing on Friday 16 November.

EMILY MARGARET (K Mudhoo) - Checked approaching the 150 metres, connections viewed film footage with consideration as to a possible protest against the 4th placed horse FIRE SHOW before electing not to proceed.

Race 7 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO SPRING CLASSIC (2000m)

THE HEIRESS (M Cameron) - Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious to undergo a veterinary inspection being passed fit to race.

ZENTESSA (K Cowan) - Raced wide in the early stages, shifted outwards under pressure passing the 200 metres making contact with SWING NOTE.

BLUE LAGOON (J Bayliss) - Lay inwards throughout the run home and was unable to be ridden out as a result. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

SWING NOTE (S Rusof) - Bumped passing the 200 metres.

WHO DARES WINS (J Laking) - Rider reported he was very disappointed with the gelding's effort today. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 8 SONIA & GARRY THOMPSON RATING 65 (1600m)

BATTLE KAT (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

RED RIVER ROCK (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

BRIDGET TOWN (T Jonker) - Raced wide in the early stages, unbalanced when in restricted room near the 100 metres.

HANNAH MARENE (S Muniandy) - Raced wide throughout.

RUN FORREST RUN (K Cowan) - Steadied when improving onto the heels of COUP DREAMWOOD passing the 1100 metres.

IVAN KANE (G Jogoo) - Made contact with SO BRAZEN when taken out by SPLENDIOR near the 300 metres.

SO BRAZEN (A Morgan) - Bumped near the 300 metres.

A Morgan (SO BRAZEN) - Spoken to regarding her whip use and action prior to the 100 metres.
