REMEDY (L Allpress) – When questioned regarding performance the rider reported that the filly was less than genuine in its efforts today.

NAUGHTY NANA (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly getting back.

LETZPARTYON (R Beeharry) – Hampered between runners as the start was effected.

ALTAMENTE (T Moseley) – Shifted in abruptly on jumping, made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly getting its head up.

HEARTOHEART (J Morris) – Slow to begin and lost contact with the field. The rider reported in her opinion the filly may have struck itself on jumping. A post race veterinary inspection revealed soreness in the right hind leg, with the connections advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

EXCLAIM (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout, lay in passing the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

FROSTED (C Johnson) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels nearing the 50 metres.

Race 4 RURAL LIVESTOCK MAIDEN (1400m)

HIGHLY XCITED (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, raced keenly for a distance in the early stages when being restrained, held up for some distance passing the 700 metres.

CEE SHARP (A Morgan) – Shifted outwards abruptly on jumping and raced most ungenerously in the early stages, lay outwards badly passing the 800 metres proving difficult to ride, shifted outwards on entering the home straight to be very wide on the track. The connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

TOO PRECIOUS (S Collett) – Got its head up shortly after jumping getting back, raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

IWONDERWAI (J Morris) – Bumped shortly after the start.

WANDERIN OVER (K Kwo) – Raced wide in the early stages, held up when awkwardly placed between runners passing the 600 metres.

UBETIAM (E Wright) – Raced wide throughout, restrained passing the 1200 metres, lay inwards passing the 600 metres having to be straightened.

OPHELIA ROSE (L Callaway) - Over raced in the middle stages, steadied passing the 200 metres

PLUSHENKO (C Johnson) – Held up in the early stages of the run home.

WINEHOUSE (L Allpress) – Lay outwards near the 200 metres having to be straightened, rider reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

STIRLING LADY (C Campbell) – Held up passing the 150 metres.

Race 5 TELTRAC COMMUNICATIONS MAIDEN (1400m)

HERMANO ROSE (R Hannam) – Slow to begin.

MUSEE D'ORSAY (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

PERFIDIA (C Johnson) – Bumped on jumping, raced keenly passing the 800 metres, held up for a short distance turning for home.

LIVELY INTEREST (G Saejorhor) – Made firm contact with PERFIDIA on jumping becoming momentarily unbalanced, shifted inwards passing the 200 metres. The rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

WE BE JAMMIN (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout.

TE MOKOPUNA (L Callaway) – Improved wide from the 700 metres.

SKYE ROSE (S Collett) – Lay inwards passing the 400 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels, hampered 200 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of LIVELY INTEREST which shifted inwards.

HIGHLY UNLIKELY (K Chowdhoory) – Shifted outwards passing the 200 metres.

SPACE CADET (C Campbell) – Lay out throughout the final straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Dead (4).

Race 6 MICK & MELBA MURFITT MEMORIAL RATING 72 (1400m)

FLASH SUGGESTION (C Campbell) – Bounded as the start was effected and lost ground, held up passing the 400 metres.

WHACKOMACO (C Johnson) – Raced fiercely for a distance in the early stages.

PRINCESS ATHENA (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly for a distance in the early stages. The rider reported that the mare felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

INANNA (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

XCUSES XCUSES (R Hannam) – Severely restrained and checked passing the 50 metres when SAVASON (K Chowdhoory) shifted inwards.

K Chowdhoory admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards passing the 50 metres when insufficiently clear of XCUSES XCUSES which had to be checked. After hearing evidence the Judicial Committee suspended K Chowdhoory's licence to ride at race meetings for 5 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 10 November up to and including 16 November.

Race 7 CANTERBURY EQUINE CLINIC RATING 65 (2200m)

TICKY TU (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly unbalancing the rider.

SHOCKTILLYOUDROP (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly and blundered when on heels shortly after the start. Underwent a veterinary inspection and deemed to be a bleeder after returning to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils. The connections were advised that the mare would be stood down for the mandatory 3 months from all trials and race meetings, with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

PATRICIA ROSE (K Kwo) – Slow to begin and got back, restrained passing the 1800 metres.

WAGNER (S Collett) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.

SITARIST (C Campbell) – Held up for racing room passing the 300 metres, shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 100 metres.

ANGELINE (C Johnson) - Lost the off fore plate during the running.

J Laking (PICKUP) admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

Race 8 C S STEVENS MEMORIAL BANKS PENINSULA CUP (2200m)

THE HEIRESS (L Allpress) – Slow to begin.

KINGS PAL (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly.

LARRIKIN (L Callaway) – Bounded as the start was effected.

LOCALLY SAUCED (C Johnson) – Raced keenly for some distance passing the 1600 metres.

SOUTHERN SAV (K Chowdhoory) – Raced wide from the 1600 metres.

MAJOR TOM (S Collett) – Inclined to lay in over the final stages and had to be straightened.

Race 9 COUNTRY FEASTS RATING 65 (1400m)

MADAM SWISS (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

ZAYZAY (K Kwo) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Rider lost his whip passing the 300 metres.

GRAND DUKE (Z Moki) – Raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

DEVIL'S STAIRCASE (K Mudhoo) – Steadied when in restricted room passing the 400 metres when MISS SCANDINAVIA (J Laking) shifted outwards. **J Laking** was warned for shifting ground.

Race 10 FAMOUS GROUSE HOTEL RATING 65 (1400m)

QUAINTRELLE (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin, shifted inwards passing the 400 metres and had to be straightened, bumped with PINSHARP passing the 300 metres.

ELANA ROSE (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, raced keenly passing the 900 metres, made contact with EASTERN WARRIOR passing the 400 metres.

MAJOR ISH CHOUX (C Johnson) – Got its head up on jumping, raced fiercely in the early stages clipping a heel passing the 1100 metres and blundering as a result, held up passing the 300 metres until the 200 metres.

BILBAO (K Asano) – Raced awkwardly shortly after the start when restrained, held up passing the 300 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

DAMANAKA (J Lowry) – Raced wide in the early stages.

PINSHARP (S Collett) – Raced wide from the 800 metres, bumped with QUAINTRELLE passing the 300 metres.

WHITNEY (K Mudhoo) – Awkwardly placed passing the 400 metres

PICK ME UP IN RIO (L Callaway) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly had lay out rounding the final turn and when placed under pressure had failed to respond, and in his opinion would be better suited to a track with more moisture. Stewards will follow up with the trainer in subsequent days.
