Racing Tauranga - Saturday 3 November 2018 Race 6 - Chesters Plumbing & Bathroom 1300

GIOVANNI CANALETTO (S Collett) - Rider S Collett was questioned regarding her riding tactics advising that her instructions had been to ride the gelding, which was having its first start for some 2 ½ years, quietly in the early stages with the intention to ride for luck if necessary. S Collett further advised that after beginning fairly the gelding had been hampered shortly after the start and had raced a little ungenerously in the early to middle stages making contact with the running rail near the 700 metres and laying in early in the final straight but once fully balanced had worked home well. Whilst noting the explanation of S Collett she was advised that her lack of vigour between the 400 metres and 250 metres had been of concern when in the Stewards view she should have made more effort to track YOUR WAY into the race.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1Chevalier Produce 1600

NOBLE STAR (L Innes) - Underwent a veterinary inspection after arriving at the barriers being declared a late scratching at 12.04pm acting on veterinary advice as when trotted up was 1/5 lame in the left foreleg. Trainer J Bell was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to racing next.

DANELYN (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

THOMAS AQUINAS (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly then briefly crowded. Held up rounding the final turn and continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 250 metres.

WHEAO (V Colgan) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.

RUSALKA (T Thornton) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages getting its head up.

MIGHTY CONNOR (L Hemi) - Raced wide without cover.

I WALK ALONE (W Pinn) - Raced wide throughout. Rider reported that the gelding had hung throughout the race.

MASTER PAINTON (O Bosson) - Held up passing the 400 metres and when attempting to obtain clear running near the 250 metres was forced wider by THE GLINT.

V Colgan (WHEAO) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of OUT OF THE PARK which was checked near the 300 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended V Colgan's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 13 November until the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 20 November, 6 national riding days.

OUT OF THE PARK (M Coleman) - Checked when crowded near the 300 metres then being further hampered when held up approaching the 200 metres when MIGHTY CONNOR shifted away from MASTER PAINTON which had been forced outwards by THE GLINT (S McKay). Continued to be held up until inside the final 100 metres.

S McKay (THE GLINT) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards near the 250 metres forcing MASTER PAINTON wider.

TAKEITLIKEAMAN (M Cameron) - Held up when entering the final straight and when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres made contact with THE GLINT.

THE GLINT (S McKay) - Bumped near the 300 metres.

Race 2 Carlton Events 1200

BEVAN STREET (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Unbalanced when bumped near the 300 metres.

PRINCESS KERERU (C Lammas) - Crowded for room between BEVAN STREET and HOWBOWDAT which lay in going into the bend near the 1050 metres. Held up entering the final straight and when attempting to obtain clear running made contact with the hind quarters of BEVAN STREET. C Lammas was advised to exercise care. Continued to be held up and raced in restricted room until near the 100 metres.

I SEE RED (W Pinn) - Crowded for room between BEVAN STREET and HOWBOWDAT which lay in going into the bend near the 1050 metres.

PROJECT (C Dell) - Raced three wide without cover.

MIGHTY ME (S Spratt) - Unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

AKOYA (S Collett) - Raced in restricted room near the 250 metres when HOWBOWDAT lay in. Crowded near the 150 metres when BISOU BISOU (M Coleman) shifted inwards under pressure. M Coleman was advised to exercise care.

DE NIRO (S McKay) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary examination was confirmed to have bled and as this is now the second occasion on which gelding has bled it is ineligible for future racing in New Zealand.

RICH BILLIE MARSH (L Allpress) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril which upon veterinary inspection was found to have been from a small abrasion.

Race 3 NZ Chinese Jockey Club 1200

Trainer **R Yuill** - Issued with a warning after MORRIE OCK was presented to race without gear that had been notified (blinkers).

RASPBERRY BERET (B Grylls) - Began awkwardly.

WALKIN' BY (M Coleman) - Slow to begin.

WINGS (T Thornton) - Slow to begin. Firmly restrained to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres.

MORRIE OCK (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.

FULLINBLOOM (O Bosson) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

SPINDLE (S Spratt) - Crowded when leaving the barriers and then steadied. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

PINK GRAFFITI (V Colgan) - Crowded passing the 1000 metres to the inside of LOCK IT IN which lay in and away from AIR CENTRE with WINGS then having to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of PINK GRAFFITI. Held up near the 300 metres.

AUTUMN WILD (J Bayliss) - Steadied near the 150 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of EMERALD AMOUR (S McKay) which shifted outwards slightly under pressure. S McKay was advised to exercise care.

LOCK IT IN (D Danis) - Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 4 Auckland Co-op Taxis 2200

BANROCK (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CARICATURE (D Mansour) - Began awkwardly then was steadied.

BLACKMAGICWOMAN (W Pinn) - When being steadied made contact with the running rail passing the 1800 metres becoming unbalanced.

KYRIE ELEISON (C Lammas) - Steadied when disappointed for a run attempting a marginal gap to the inside of ROUGH CUT which lay in near the 300 metres.

DIESEL (J Riddell) - Lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 5John Deere Agrowquip 1600STARRYBEEL (D Johnson) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.

GAZZARA (L Allpress) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers. Raced three wide without cover.

FISCAL FANTASY (W Pinn) - Slow to begin. Ran wide rounding the final turn.

MY DAKOTA (L Innes) - Began awkwardly then crowded and hampered. Checked near the 50 metres.

FANCY MORE (O Bosson) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers. Held up rounding the final turn having to be firmly restrained off heels near the 450 metres. Checked when held up near the 300 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

V Colgan (SUMMER WIND) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards approaching the 1300 metres briefly crowding RHINESTONE COWBOY before relieving the pressure. RHINESTONE COWBOY then raced ungenerously when being restrained shifting inwards away from SUMMER WIND into the line of ANICETA which had to be checked to avoid that runner's heels. Also having to be steadied when placed in restricted room was AZABEAT.

ANICETA (S Collett) - Crowded and checked 1300 metres then raced ungenerously for a distance.

AZABEAT (C Lammas) - Steadied when placed in restricted room 1300 metres.

KING KANE (N Bakar) - Steadied and shifted outwards to avoid the heels of FELIX FAURE rounding the bend near the 450 metres making contact with SUMMER WIND.

SUMMER WIND (V Colgan) - Bumped rounding the bend near the 450 metres.

L Allpress (GAZZARA) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of MY DAKOTA which was checked near the 50 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Allpress' license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 10 November until the conclusion of racing on Friday 16 November, 5 national riding days.

DECADES (D Danis) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area, being confirmed to have bled following a veterinary inspection and is now subject to the mandatory two month stand down from training and three month stand down from racing or trialing with a veterinary clearance then required prior to racing or trialing next.

DE KONING (L Satherley) - Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 6OMF Stakes (2000 metres)LIZZIE L'AMOUR (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.

FIRE JET (N Bakar) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LOVELIGHT (A Calder) - Slow to begin.

EXCELLERATION (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DANGER DEE (W Pinn) - Crowded at start.

MISSION HILL (O Bosson) - Crowded at start.

D Danis (SOMETHINGVAIN) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SUGAR RUSH which had improved to the inside of that runner having to be steadied approaching the 1200 metres.

SUGAR RUSH (L Hemi) - Steadied to avoid the heels of SOMETHINGVAIN approaching the 1200 metres.

BEAUTY WAY (V Colgan) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1200 metres.

MONRECOUR (R Elliot) - Raced three wide without cover.

TWO THIRTY (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SAVE THE DATE (L Innes) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.

EXCELLERATION (S Collett) - Held up rounding the final turn continuing to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

Race 8 Carbine Club Trophy (1600 metres)

C Lammas - Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after failing to make the weight for SMART DRAGON.

SMART DRAGON (T Thornton replaced C Lammas) - Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight. Required veterinary attention after being galloped on.

PEACOCK (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.

OUR KING SWAY (D Danis) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

DEALS IN HEELS (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover.

ROCKABYEBABY (S Collett) - Began awkwardly. Held up rounding the final turn and did not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres. Badly hampered when forced inwards just short of the finish striking a heel shortly after the finish almost dislodging its rider.

J Riddell (DEALS IN HEELS) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards over the concluding stages forcing ROCKABYEBABY inwards with that runner striking a heel of ALL ROADS shortly after passing the finish almost dislodging its rider. ROCKABYEBABY shifted inwards when rider S Collett was attempting to regain her seat crowding SEVENTEEN SEVENTY which struck a heel of SMART DRAGON and blundered badly. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended J Riddell's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 11 November up to and including racing on Wednesday 28 November, 12 national riding days.

T Yanagida (PEACOCK) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9Ellerslie Jewellers & Engravers 1400SCUTAR (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly.

SELVAMANI (A Calder) - Began awkwardly. Held up rounding the final turn from the 600 metres until near the 400 metres.

MY GALATINE (W Pinn) - Raced wide without cover throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

OUR WONDERLAND (R Elliot) - Steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of RIP EM UP near the 350 metres.

FAZIOLI (L Innes) - Held up early in the final straight then being inconvenienced when improving into a tight run passing the 300 metres when CANTSTOPTHEFEELING shifted outwards slightly under pressure.

STANDING OVATION (S Spratt) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running having to shift outwards making contact with QUEEN OF DIAMONDS near the 150 metres.

QUEEN OF DIAMONDS (M Cameron) - Bumped 150 metres.

Race 10 Simply Squeezed 2400

RECOLLECT (C Lammas) - Knuckled when leaving the barriers. Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 2000 metres.

DELEGATE (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly.

SMEDLEY (A Jones) - Crowded when REDCAYENNE lay in near the 500 metres.

VAINGLORY (S Collett) - Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of PRINCE JABEEL which lay in near the 250 metres.

AMAZING AZ (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had felt flat and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure near the 600 metres and was unable to offer any tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
