SOUTHERN JAZZ (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

LORD HERCULES (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin. Had to be steadied passing the 650 metres when awkwardly placed on

heels.

JIMINY CRICKET (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Got its head up on a number of occasions in the early stages when racing keenly and being restrained off heels.

IWO JIMA (C Johnson) – Raced wide early.

SEKATIA (R Beeharry) – Wide from the 1000 metres. Lay inwards in the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage.

DAD'S BROTHER (K Mudhoo) – Crowded and steadied passing the 900 metres. Shortly afterwards when being restrained was placed in restricted room contacting the rail and becoming unbalanced.

SCANDALOUS (J Laking) – Was inclined to lay in throughout the run home and had to be straightened passing the 125 metres.

C Johnson (IWO JIMA) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of DAD'S BROTHER who was crowded and checked passing the 900 metres. After hearing evidence and viewing the films the JCA imposed a suspension from the end of racing on Saturday 10 November up to and including Friday 16 November (5 national days).

Race 2 CROMBIE LOCKWOOD RATING 82 1200 1200m

KOXINGA (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly. Awkwardly placed on the heels of KING PIN near the 200 metres and had to be steadied. Inconvenienced concluding stages.

FIVE KINGS (S Muniandy) – Crowded and placed in restricted room passing the 125 metres when racing tightly between THE CZAR (B Murray) who shifted in marginally and KOXINGA who was taken outwards by KIWI IDA (C Johnson). Both B Murray and C Johnson were advised to exercise care.

KING PIN (K Kwo) – Placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres for a short distance.

KIWI IDA (C Johnson) – Held up briefly for clear running passing the 200 metres, shifted ground outwards passing the 150 metres continuing to shift outwards inconveniencing KOXINGA over the final stages.

Race 3 WINGATUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 1200 1200m

The start of this event was delayed due to several runners, in particular MANHATTAN FIRE proving difficult to load.

MANHATTAN FIRE (C Johnson) – Slow to load, then raced keenly in the early stages. When spoken to regarding the performance rider C Johnson reported the gelding raced keenly in the early stages and when placed under pressure failed to respond.

FAUX PAS (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly and got back.

ZAGREB (B Murray) – Crowded shortly after the start and lost ground.

XANTHIA (K Mudhoo) – Wide early. Lay inwards early in the home straight and had to be straightened.

DECEPTIO VISUS (J Laking) – Wide from the 800 metres.

THE SELECTION (T Moseley) – When spoken to regarding the disappointing performance rider T Moseley could offer no tangible excuses.

Race 4 NO LIMITS INTERIORS RATING 72 1200 1200m

The start of this event was delay when DOCKET was unable to be loaded and was a late scratching at 1.36 pm. The connections were advised that DOCKET must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards before racing again.

TAPONISME (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

OUR TEDDY BOY (B Murray) – Began awkwardly losing ground as a result. Held up early in the run home having to shift

ground outwards near the 200 metres to find clear racing room. Lay inwards over the concluding stages having to be straightened.

PROMISING (K Kwo) – Shift in abruptly after the start making contact with the running rail. Brushed the rail again passing the 900 metres.

MACY (S Muniandy) – Wide early. Keen for a distance passing the 800 metres.

ON POINT (T Moseley) – Over raced when racing into the first bend making the bend awkwardly.

ALWAYS ON CALL (C Barnes) – Raced fiercely for a distance passing the 900 metres having to be restrained.

ZABAY (C Campbell) – Hampered passing the 900 metres. Wide for the majority of the race.

Race 5 SOUTHERN WIDE REAL ESTATE MAIDEN 1400 1400m

Race 5 was rescheduled to 2.15 pm at the request of the TAB.

I AM A ROCK (T Moseley) – Proved difficult to load. Bounded as the start was effected. Placed in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

THE PUBLICAN (K Selvan) – Stood in the stalls losing approximately 15 lengths at the start. The connections were advised the gelding would need to barrier trial to Stewards' satisfaction before racing again.

AULYN STAR (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

FOUR KEEPERS (L Callaway) – Keen early stages.

ADVENTURESS (R Beeharry) – Lay outwards early in the home straight.

Race 6 SPEIGHTS OPEN 1400 1400m

GALLANT BOY (C Campbell) – Slow through the early stages.

TIMY TYLER (R Mudhoo) – Raced keenly passing the 1000 metres and had to be restrained off the heels of IRISH EXCUSE.

TOMM JONES (R Beeharry) – Lay inwards for the majority of the run home and could not be ridden to any advantage.

COURTE ZARINDI (T Moseley) – Finished in last placing with Stewards ordering a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities. Rider T Moseley could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 7 SOUTHERN MOTOR GROUP RATING 65 1200 1200m

CABERNET (J Lowry) – Shifted out on jumping making firm contact with FLY TO THE SKY. When spoken to regarding the performance rider J Lowry advised the mare had become very worked up prior to the race and he believed this was detrimental to its chances.

FLY TO THE SKY (T Moseley) – Contacted by CABERNET on jumping.

WHERE ANGELS WALK (C Johnson) - Wide throughout.

SUPATWISTA (R Beeharry) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight, shifted outwards over the concluding stages.

BOYSLIGHTUP (B Murray) – Held up early in the run home shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres. Held up again passing the 200 metres having to again change ground inwards to find clear racing room. Steadied in the shadows of the post when BELLE HOPE (J Laking) shifted inwards. J Laking was advised to exercise greater care. Stewards questioned rider B Murray over his ride particularly over the final 500 metres. He advised that it was his intention to ride for luck as he would have to improve six wide on the turn on the home turn and he was reluctant to do so. However in hindsight he agreed with the Stewards that he erred in his judgement.

BELLE HOPE (J Laking) – Shifted inwards in the shadows of the post to find clear racing room.

CARDRONA (C Campbell) – Had to steady passing the 50 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of SUPATWISTA which was shifting outwards under pressure.

R Beeharry (SUPATWISTA) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards over the concluding stages crowding CARDRONA passing the 50 metres.

Race 8 OTAGO FARM MACHINERY RATING 65 1400 1400m

DEVIL MAY CARE (J Laking) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider J Laking advised the gelding had never travelled at any point of the race and was very disappointing.

SO NATURAL (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 500 metres resulting in the trailing FULLTOTHEBRIM having to be restrained at this point. Shifted out passing the 200 metres making firm contact with YES YOU DID. Lay outwards over the concluding stages shifting wider on the track.

PLUTONIUM (T Moseley) – Buffeted between runners as the start was made. Obliged to race wide throughout.

YES YOU DID (J Lowry) – Crowded and checked passing the 1200 metres losing some ground. Lay inwards in the run home, heavily contacted by inside runner passing the 200 metres being forced wider on the track.

BET YA WOOD (B Murray) – Raced ungenerously early stages. Lay out rounding the bend from the 900 metres to the 600 metres.

Z Bholah (ROC LEONE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards checking YES YOU DID passing the 1200 metres. After hearing evidence and viewing the films the JCA imposed a suspension from 9 November up to and including 14 November (4 days).

OPIHI RANGER (K Mudhoo) – Held up through the run home until having to shift outwards at the 125 metres to find clear racing room.

DIORISSIMO (C Campbell) – Held up early in the run home having to shift outwards passing the 200 metres. Lost both front plates during the running.

R Beeharry (SO NATURAL) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards making firm contact with YES YOU DID who was unbalanced and shifted wider on the track passing the 200 metres. After hearing evidence and viewing the films the JCA imposed a suspension from end of racing 10 November up to and including 16 November (5 days).

Race 9 K B CONTRACTORS R72 1600 1600m

SPIDER LILY (J Morris) – Slow to begin.

KEEP ON COMING (J Laking) – Slow to begin.

RED MAJOR (J Lowry) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.

FIRE LILY (T Moseley) – Wide for a short distance passing the 1000 metres.

FLICKA OF GOLD (Z Bholah) – Was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

ABSOLUTE GOLD (C Campbell) – When spoken to regarding the disappointing performance of favoured runner rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.
