SUPPLEMENTARY:**Banks Peninsular Racing Club - Sunday 4 November 2018****Race 10 Famous Grouse Hotel 1600**

PICK ME UP IN RIO - Trainer K James advised Stewards that in the days following this race the filly underwent a further veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality, adding that it is his intention to give her one more start before sending her for a spell.

Otago Racing Club - Tuesday 6 November 2018**R8 - OTAGO FARM MACHINERY RATING 65 (1400m)**

Trainer J Burns reported to the Stewards that after the disappointing performance of PLUTONIUM a subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to be suffering from a virus which has been treated accordingly. Mr Burns further advised that after a brief let up the gelding will carry on with its current campaign.

Trainer J Richards advised that after the disappointing performance of DEVIL MAY CARE, the gelding has now been retired as a racing proposition.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO PREMIER (1600m)
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S Rusof (CHIC) - Fined \$200 under the minor infringement schedule after being unable to make the weight.

CHIC - L Allpress replaced S Rusof who was unable to make the weight.

IRISH CALL (K Cowan) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Underwent a veterinary inspection including an endoscopy after returning to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils, being confirmed to have bled and now subject to a two month stand down from being in training and three month stand down from trialling or racing, with a veterinary clearance then required prior to racing or trialling next.

SANASAR (Z Moki) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding outside runners and then got its head up in the early stages when being restrained to take a position, over raced passing the 800 metres and was obliged to race wide for the remainder of the race, inconvenienced near the 300 metres when SHADOW KING lay in with some outwards movement from AHYUM contributing.

GALWAY GARRY (B Murray) - Jumped away awkwardly before being further inconvenienced when RESIDENTIAL was taken out by SANASAR, over raced in the early stages.

RESIDENTIAL (D Johnson) - Bumped and taken wider on the track shortly after the start by inside runner.

CHIC (L Allpress) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned regarding her riding tactics, rider L Allpress advised that she had not received any specific riding instructions but given the mare's outside barrier draw and the fact that she viewed the inside part of the track to be superior she had elected to restrain to the rear in the early stages.

SHADOW KING (R Myers) - Lay in for the majority of the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

AHYUM (J Bayliss) - Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres when RESIDENTIAL shifted outwards away from FORGED (R Mudhoo) which shifted out under pressure, with some inward movement from SHADOW KING (R Myers) contributing. Both R Mudhoo and R Myers were advised to exercise greater care.

The track was upgraded to Slow (9) retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2	GARRARDS HORSE AND HOUND PREMIER (2000m)
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SOUTHERN SAV (K Chowdhoo) - Very slow to begin.

LOCHAN ORA (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

WIDE AWAKE (O Bosson) - Held up for the majority of the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

BLUE LAGOON (D Johnson) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

Race 3	FASTTRACK INSURANCE ADDED STAKES PREMIER (1400m)
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BROTHER WILL (D Johnson) - Slow to begin, began to over race passing the 1000 metres.

HIGHLY UNLIKELY (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded at the start, raced wide without cover throughout, shifted ground under pressure in the final straight.

PLATINUM RAIDER (M Cameron) - Shifted inwards abruptly at the start crowding inside runners.

ARISTOTLE (L Allpress) - Crowded, buffeted and unbalanced shortly after the start.

ROTHACKER (J Laking) - Crowded, buffeted and unbalanced shortly after the start.

REDFORD (R Beeharry) - Buffeted between runners shortly after the start clipping a heel and blundering losing ground, improved wide rounding the final bend.

SPACE CADET (C Campbell) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

K Chowdhoo (HIGHLY UNLIKELY) -Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres and reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish when circumstances permit.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Slow (8).

Race 4	ONE GOOD HORSE AT AVONHEAD TAVERN PREMIER (1100m)
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DOCKET (R Beeharry) - Proved very reluctant to load with trainer B Tapper being advised that a further warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners. Shifted outwards at the start making contact with BARABAS.

ISHINKTAATLEDO (C Campbell) - Restrained to the rear on jumping. Lost a front plate during the running.

OTTAVIO (J Parkes) - Blundered at the start.

BARABAS (J Waddell) - Bumped start. Held up passing the 400 metres having to shift ground outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

ATTIMO (L Allpress) - Pulled the right front plate during the running. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a minor laceration to the left hind leg.

Race 5	YESBERG INSURANCE SERVICES PEGASUS STAKES HANDICAP (1000m)
<p>CASAQUINMAN (D Turner) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>LIVIN' ON A PRAYER (C Lammas) - Inconvenienced near the 250 metres when MORSE CODE (A Morgan) shifted outwards under pressure. A Morgan was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>SELFIE (J Bayliss) - Had to be steadied just short of the finish when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of PASSING SHOT after being taken in by MORSE CODE (A Morgan)</p> <p>A Morgan - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> <p>A Morgan (MORSE CODE) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride at race meetings for 13 national days effective from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 10 November up to and including racing on Thursday 29 November.</p>	
Race 6	MILLENNIUM HOTELS & RESORTS PREMIER (1200m)
<p>CARSON RIVER (J Waddell) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>PARVINA (S Rusof) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had travelled comfortably enough but failed to respond once placed under pressure and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities. Connections advised that the mare was now likely to be sent for a spell.</p> <p>TORRE DEL GRECO (R Myers) - Lay out passing the 100 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>OUR FOREMAN (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had over raced in the early stages but otherwise could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.</p>	
Race 7	AL BASTI EQUIWORLD 46TH NEW ZEALAND 2000 GUINEAS (1600m)
<p>MORE WONDER (S Spratt) - Very slow to begin (4L), checked when crowded near the 1200 metres, raced keenly in the middle stages, shifted outwards near the 600 metres to avoid the heels of the weakening MR UNIVERSE and then shifted outwards further forcing PUBLICIST outwards hampering LAPHROAIG.</p> <p>S Spratt - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards near the 600 metres.</p> <p>LAPHROAIG (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Hampered near the 600 metres.</p> <p>THE CHOSEN ONE (J Riddell) - Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the colt had never travelled well and had disappointed. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality but the colt did receive veterinary treatment for a small cut to the right knee.</p> <p>MADISON COUNTY (M Cameron) - Held up rounding the final turn before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.</p> <p>BIT LIPPY (C Lammas) - Had to be steadied near the 1200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of MADISON COUNTY, steadied to avoid the heels of MR UNIVERSE near the 700 metres when that runner was placed in restricted room to the outside of MADISON COUNTY (M Cameron).</p>	

DAWN PATROL (J Waddell) - Had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of BIT LIPPY near the 1200 metres and shifted inwards abruptly resulting in IN A TWINKLING then striking a heel of DAWN PATROL and blundering, with PUBLICIST then having to take evasive action and shifting inwards crowding MORE WONDER which was checked.

IN A TWINKLING (S Rusof) - Struck a heel and blundered near the 1200 metres.

PUBLICIST (J Laking) - Hampered when having to shift inwards abruptly to avoid the heels of IN A TWINKLING near the 1200 metres. The colt required veterinary attention post-race for a laceration to the left hind leg, with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next. Trainer J Richards indicated that the colt would now be spelled and consideration would be given to having it gelded prior to its next preparation.

MR UNIVERSE (D Johnson) - Gave ground from the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight, with the rider advising that the colt had been making abnormal breathing noises. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

SWORD OF OSMAN (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had been unable to quicken in today's track conditions.

Race 8	GOLD CLUB PREMIER (1600m)
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LORD SNOW (J Laking) - The start was delayed after the gelding refused to load and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 4.24pm. The connections were advised that the gelding must barrier trial to Stewards' satisfaction prior to racing next.

QUAINTRELLE (K Chowdhoo) - Very slow to begin.

CASUAL WINKS (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

STRAD (K Cowan) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

MONZA CIRCUITO (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide from the 800 metres, shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres forcing JIN LU wider, made contact again with JIN LU passing the 75 metres when both runners shifted ground.

JIN LU (O Bosson) - Forced wider near the 200 metres when MONZA CIRCUITO shifted outwards abruptly, came together again with MONZA CIRCUITO passing the 75 metres when both runners shifted ground. Following the race a protest was lodged by the connections of the 2nd placed horse **JIN LU** alleging interference by the 1st placed horse **MONZA CIRCUITO** in the final straight. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

ALBUT ME (D Johnson) - The rider reported that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 9	REDWOOD METROPOLITAN TROPHY HANDICAP (2500m)
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LARRIKIN (L Callaway) - Slow to begin, crowded 2300 metres having to be steadied.

D Johnson (FELAAR) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards crowding LARRIKIN which had to be steadied near the 2300 metres.

FELAAR (D Johnson) - Bounded at the start and got back.

TIPPING POINT (R Myers) - Crowded at the start and lost ground when runners either side shifted ground.

SHANTAV (K Cowan) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

DEE AND GEE (C Lammas) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of DUELLICIOUS (S Spratt) near the 2300 metres. S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 10	BLUE STAR TAXIS PREMIER (1400m)
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UNFAZED (O Bosson) - Commenced to over race when being restrained shortly after the start, had to be further restrained to avoid the heels of FLASH SUGGESTION (J Morris) which shifted inwards near the 1200 metres when not fully clear, UNFAZED continued to over race through the middle stages.

J Morris - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards near the 1200 metres when not fully clear of UNFAZED.

TAVIGARDE (C Lammas) - Raced three wide without cover.

WORDOFMOUTH (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover.

AKOYA PEARL (S Collett) - Placed in restricted room when weakening near the 300 metres when FLASH SUGGESTION lay out.

J Parkes - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres. On J Parkes' request due to having to catch a flight, the Judicial Committee agreed to adjourn the hearing until Wednesday 14 November 2018.
