An adjourned inquiry into a charge of excessive use of the whip which had been admitted by rider **J Parkes** (IRISH FLAME) was held prior to Race 1. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended J Parkes' licence for 8 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 17 November up to and including Thursday 29 November.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ROMANO'S PIZZAS PREMIER (1200m)

Trainer **M McCann** (SHE'S GALLANT) was fined \$100 after admitting a charge in that he had failed to gain permission to add a tongue tie by the required time.

SHARP 'N' SILVER (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.

RETORT (J Bayliss) - Crowded on jumping losing ground.

NELLIE BLY (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly and shifted outwards, ducked outwards when appearing to shy approaching the 100 metres.

FRANGLAIS (G Saejorhor) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards.

SEVERINE (S Spratt) - Over raced when being restrained shortly after the start then having to be steadied away from the heels of SACRED QUARTZ (O Bosson) which shifted inwards when not fully clear. O Bosson was advised to exercise greater care.

SACRED QUARTZ (O Bosson) - Raced wide throughout.

QUATTRO KATIE (J Laking) - Had to be steadied shortly after the start when awkwardly placed on heels.

BLAIR FLIGHT (T Moseley) - Over raced in the early to middle stages, raced wide throughout.

DARCI CAN (R Myers) - Held up for a short distance early in the final straight.

ABRAHAMS (S Collett) - Placed in restricted room approaching the 400 metres when DU'BLUES lay in rounding the final turn, checked near the 350 metres when THE SWISS MAESTRO shifted outwards. Rider reported that her saddle had shifted backwards leaving the barriers disadvantaging her during the race.

J Waddell (THE SWISS MAESTRO) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount outwards near the 350 metres when not sufficiently clear of ABRAHAMS which was checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended J Waddell's licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 17 November up to and including Wednesday 28 November.

EXCLAIM (C Campbell) - Held up throughout the run home.

C Campbell (EXCLAIN) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards near the 250 metres hampering FINAL SAVINGS and MR INSANITY.

FINAL SAVINGS (M Coleman) - Hampered near the 250 metres.

MR INSANITY (J Lowry) - Hampered near the 250 metres.

O Bosson (SACRED QUARTZ) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 FARMERS MILL PREMIER (2000m)

KAHARAU (S Collett) - Raced wide in the early stages.

LOCHAN ORA (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide from the 1300 metres.

DUFFERS CREEK (Z Moki) - Held up in the early stages of the run home until near the 100 metres.

Race 3 BIDFOOD BUTCHERY PREMIER (1600m)

MONDORANI (O Bosson) - Declared a late scratching behind the barriers at 1.39 pm on veterinary advice as it was lame in the near front leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

PRODUCER (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

CEE SHARP (D Turner) - Began awkwardly skying its head and shifting outwards.

PLUSHENKO (J Waddell) - Crowded on jumping.

FREIGHT TRAIN JANE (J Laking) - Began awkwardly.

PAMIR (R Mudhoo) - Over raced in the middle stages.

LITTLE BOSSING (S Spratt) - Raced wide throughout.

HERMANO ROSE (B Murray) - Hung outwards throughout and was not persevered with in the final straight when well beaten.

TATUM (M Cameron) - Held up rounding the final turn and did not obtain clear running until near the 200 metres before again being held up near the 100 metres.

LUNAR LADY (D Johnson) - Held up near the 350 metres.

T Jonker (PRODUCER) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 4 NZB READY TO RUN SALE PREMIER (1400m)

OCEAN OF CHAMPAGNE (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly crowding UPSCALE.

UPSCALE (M Cameron) - Crowded at the start.

SABRAGE (J Bayliss) - Began awkwardly making contact with AQUATTACK, had a tendency to over race in the early to middle stages then racing ungenerously when being restrained near the 800 metres hampering MORE WONDER.

AQUATTACK (B Murray) - Bumped at the start, steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres.

R Myers (STRATTON) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards near the 1000 metres with TAREE shifting inwards away from that runner placing AQUATTACK in restricted room having to be steadied.

HIGHLY UNLIKELY (D Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover.

MORE WONDER (J Parkes) - Hampered near the 800 metres.

DEVIL'S STAIRCASE (S Spratt) - Held up rounding the final turn

AIR MAX (J Lowry) - Lay in under pressure entering the final straight passing the 400 metres becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of CAMPO having to be corrected, held up near the 250 metres having to steady and shift inwards across the heels of CAMPO to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

CAMPO (C Campbell) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight. Apprentice C Campbell was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish when circumstances permit.

Race 5 VALACHI DOWNS CANTERBURY BREEDERS STAKES (1400m)

BRING TO THE BLOCK (D Turner) - Jumped away awkwardly after being fractious in the barriers. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare is better suited to rain affected conditions.

UNFAZED (J Laking) - Over raced in the early to middle stages.

BENEFICIAL (T Moseley) - Raced wide in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses other than the mare feeling a little indifferent in its action possibly due to feeling the firm footing. A post-race veterinary inspection found the mare to be lame in front, with trainer R Beckett advising that the mare would be freshened and its preparation reassessed.

LAKE CHALICE (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover, had to be steadied near the 250 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of RESPIN.

BELLA COURT (S Collett) - Held up early in the final straight then having to be steadied near the 300 metres.

THE PRECIOUS ONE (J Parkes) - Lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 6 HALLS REFRIGERATED TRANSPORT PREMIER (1400m)

HE'S GOLD (G Saejorhor) - Raced wide without cover.

Race 7 LINDAUER STEWARDS STAKES HANDICAP (1200m)

WILLIAM WALLACE (R Myers) - Got a leg over a gate when leaving the enclosure and after undergoing a veterinary inspection was declared a late scratching at 4.00 pm when showing signs of lameness in the right hind leg.

JOHNNY JONES (M Coleman) - Jumped away awkwardly.

CASAQUINMAN (D Turner) - Slow to begin, bumped near the 200 metres and then lay in making contact with PIPPI REA passing the 150 metres.

MR TYPHON (J Morris) - Over raced in the early stages.

PASSING SHOT (S Spratt) - Raced wide throughout.

SENSEI (D Johnson) - Became awkwardly placed on the heels of ENZO'S LAD near the 1000 metres when over racing and shifted outwards inconveniencing PIPPI REA.

PRINCE OZ (T Moseley) - Held up until approaching the 200 metres.

PIPPI REA (J Bayliss) - Inconvenienced near the 1000 metres, lay out making contact with CASAQUINMAN near the 200 metres then bumped when CASAQUINMAN lay in passing the 150 metres.

FERRANDO (M Cameron) - Rider reported that the horse had felt short in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 AMICUS INSURANCE BROKERS PREMIER (2000m)

LONGFORD - Declared a late scratching at 3.41 pm after being injured when being transported to the course and upon veterinary inspection displayed lameness in the right hind leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to racing next.

SHEZATOUCHA (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

FIRE LILY (J Parkes) - Raced wide in the early stages.

SACRED DELIGHT (J Bayliss) - Rider dropped his whip passing the 150 metres.

I'LLAV BUBBLES (S Collett) - Rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 9 14th COUPLAND'S BAKERIES MILE (1600m)

KOLONEL KEV (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after the start.

LIVIN' ON A PRAYER (C Lammas) - Got its head up and raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1100 metres, made contact with FLYING SARDINE when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 500 metres.

EXCELLERATION (S Collett) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 300 metres.

WHO DARES WINS (J Laking) - Over raced near the 1100 metres getting its head up.

SON OF MAHER (J Waddell) - Over raced near the 1100 metres.

FLYING SARDINE (B Murray) - Raced three wide without cover, bumped near the 500 metres.

SHADOWS CAST (J Parkes) - A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to be suffering from cardiac arrhythmia. The connections were advised that the appropriate veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

Race 10 PERFECT PACKAGING PREMIER (2500m)

ADDITUP (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly jumping in the air at the start.

HEAD OFFICE (Z Moki) - Raced wide throughout, steadied near the 1600 metres when improving onto the heels of SHOW MACCOOL (T Jonker) which shifted outwards. T Jonker was advised to exercise greater care.

TICKY TU (C Campbell) - Hung outwards near the 800 metres contacting the hind quarters of KAURI COVE which was unbalanced.

KAURI COVE (L Callaway) - Unbalanced when hindquarters contacted near the 800 metres.

ANGELINE (M Cameron) - Lost the left hind plate during the running.
