| <b>FICTITIOUS</b> (J Parkes) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.   |   |

**MARJOLET** (T Johnson) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

**KOLEE** (Z Moki) -Held up for a distance rounding the home turn.

**ARTAXERXES** (J Fawcett) - Held up near the 250 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to improve.

**GAME OVER** (D Bradley) – Held up passing the 200 metres going to the finish without being fully tested.

**CHOUXPERB** (C Lammas) – When questioned into performance rider advised that this was the gelding’s first start over the distance and had raced keenly in the early stages. In his opinion CHOUXPERB would take natural improvement. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

Track upgraded to Good 3 retrospective to Race 1.

**RED CLOUD** (J Parkes) – Slow away.

**HIGH QUALITY** (S O’Malley) - Raced three wide without cover in the early stages then improved to sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres.

**OBRIGADO** (J Waddell) – Bumped with HANK MOODY when attempting to improve into a narrow run to the inside of that runner entering the home straight, then raced in restricted room for a short distance.

**HANK MOODY** (D Johnson) – Bumped entering home straight.

**LINCOLN MELODY** (T Johnson) – When questioned into performance rider was of the opinion that, although its best form has been on good tracks, the mare may prefer some easing in the track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

**VINNIE’S VOLLEY** (C Lammas) - Raced keenly throughout having to be restrained off heels in the early stages.

**AWATANE** (J Parkes) - Restrained off the heels of SALAMANCA as the pace eased near the 850 metres.

**D Turner** (ROCK MY SOUL) admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards when not the required distance clear of SALAMANCA, which was checked near the 850 metres, going back on to AWATANE, which was restrained. As a result of being restrained SALAMANCA then shifted out, off the heels of ROCK MY SOUL and jostled with VINNIE’S VOLLEY for a short distance. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his licence from the close of racing on Sunday, 18 November 2018 up to and including racing on Sunday, 25 November (5 days).

**VINNIE’S VOLLEY** (C Lammas) – Hampered near the 850 metres.

**Trainer K Gray** was issued with a warning under Rule 614(2) when presenting his mounts (PIRIAKA and HAPPY TAV) with incorrect saddle cloths.

**SHEZA BEACH BABE** (J Parkes) – Slow away. When questioned into performance rider advised the filly had raced greenly throughout. A subsequent veterinary inspection showed increased respiratory effort.

**HAPPY TAV** (M Singh) - Tightened at the start when FATTORE OTTO jumped inwards.

**Z Moki** (GOT THE CALL) - Issued with a warning under rule 638(1)(d) after angling her mount inwards at the start when not fully clear of FATTORE OTTO which shifted in and away, tightening HAPPY TAV then hampering THEWAYYOU MADEME and AJAY LINCOLN

**THEWAYYOU MADEME** (S McKay) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

**AFTER YOU** (D Turner) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**SOMEWHERE MAN** (D Bradley) – Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards across heels entering the home straight and when doing so lay outwards dictating HAPPY TAV outwards, briefly inconveniencing FATTORE OTTO and SHEZA BEACH BABE. Stewards took into account outwards movement from AFTER YOU when assessing interference.

**GOT THE CALL** (Z Moki) - Lost both front plates during the running.

**Race 5** | **PROFESSIONAL PLUMBING & GAS FITTING LTD (1200 Metres)**

**ALL IN MANA** (T Allan) – Raced up on to the heels of PEP TORQUE near the 850 metres and raced in restricted room for a short distance tightening VINCENT.

**VINCENT** (D Bradley) – Tightened 850 metres.

**DEJA ROO** (D Turner) – Raced keenly when being restrained approaching the 800 metres.

**JAKKALBOMB** (R Myers) - When questioned into performance rider advised the filly had raced greenly but had finished the race off well.

**Race 6** | **MANAWATU ITM BUILDING CENTRE 1400 (1400 Metres)**

**OZIL** (J Waddell) – Tightened at the start when ALL BLACK MAGIC began awkwardly, settling back.

**DREAM DANCER** (D Turner) - Awkwardly away, settling back.

**LINCOLN RAIDER** (T Johnson) – Lay out passing the 800 metres making the bend awkwardly, held up approaching the 400 metres then lay out early in the home straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of OZIL approaching the 200 metres.

**LONDON EXPRESS** (W Pinn) – Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. Trainer A Sharrock reported the filly would now head for a spell. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

**EMPRESS TZU HSI** (J Parkes) – Held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres. Lost the near hind plate during the running.

**GRIS DAME** (D Johnson) – When questioned into performance rider advised the mare had travelled well throughout but had been disappointing in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

**SUFFIGN** (T Allan) – Raced greenly throughout.

**Race 7** | **HUMPHRIES CONSTRUCTION 1550 (1550 Metres)**

**ROCK ON** (S McKay) – Slow away. Had to be steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of HEAVENS KEEP, which shifted in and away from HUNTA PENCE (W Pinn) near the 1100 metres. After questioning riders stewards were not satisfied that any one rider was wholly responsible, nevertheless W Pinn was advised to exercise greater

care when shifting ground.

**MASTER PAT** (D Hirini) – Tightened at the start settling back.

**JACKSSTAR** (C Lammas) – Slow away.

**WYNDPELLE** (J Waddell) - Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.

**HUNTA PENCE** (W Pinn) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Race 8**

**PAK DESIGN 1550 (1550 Metres)**

**SMOKEN' ACE** (M Singh) Tightened at the start settling back, then raced keenly in the early stages.

**BRAKBAR** (T Johnson) – Slow away.

**HELENAOFTROY** (D Turner) – Over-raced early when racing three wide without cover.

**MISS DOHERTY** (D Johnson) – Held up rounding the turn.

**ROSCHANA** (W Pinn) – Held up for a short distance entering the home straight then raced in restricted room over the final stages.

**CONSTANT BARRAGE** (S O'Malley) – Lay in under pressure early in the home straight having to be straightened.

**Race 9**

**BUNNINGS 1550 (1550 Metres)**

**LARIMA** (R Myers) – Connections advised the mare was in season but were happy to run. Came together and brushed with ARIDITY near the 50 metres when both runners shifted ground under pressure.

**ADONIS** (M Singh) – Slow away.

**ETERNAL** (J Waddell) – Awkwardly away, settling back. Rider advised the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Connections advised the mare would now go out for a spell. A post-race veterinary inspection clear.

**GOBUYIT** (J Fawcett) - Raced three wide on the pace throughout.

**OFF WITH HER HEAD** (Z Moki) – Held up approaching the 200 metres going to the line not fully tested.

**SKYPHYTA** (J Parkes) – Slow away. Briefly held up passing the 400 metres then unable to gain clear running in the home straight.

**LINCOLN'S SECRET** (T Johnson) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

**DANCE FOR MONEY** (C Lammas) - When questioned into performance rider advised that after racing very wide throughout the mare had little left at the finish.

**SPONDULIX** (W Pinn) - Held up for a short distance passing the 200 metres prior to being angled inwards to improve.

**ARIDITY** (D Bradley) – Brushed 50 metres.
