**GENERAL:**

D Johnson and S Rusof did not attend the meeting due to injuries suffered in a race fall at Ruakaka the previous day.

**RACE COMMENTS:**

**Race 1 THE RECRUITMENT NETWORK PREMIER (1400m)**

**SO NATURAL** (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin, raced very wide throughout.

**HANNAH MARENE** (S Collett) - Blundered on jumping.

**CARSON RIVER** (K Chowdhoo) - Bounded at the start, briefly steadied when inconvenienced near the 75 metres.

**LETSBRINGITON** (R Myers) - Slow to begin.

**SPLENDIOR** (C Campbell) - Shifted in shortly after the start making firm contact with LADY BYRON, had difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle stages of the run home.

**LADY BYRON** (B Murray) - Bumped at the start losing ground.

**HOT FUSS** (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**ESBEEDEE** (M Cameron) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**ANZAC COUP** (L Allpress) - Was not persevered with from the 250 metres when well beaten. When questioned the rider advised that the mare had been fractious in the barriers with the pacifiers being displaced which appeared to have affected the mare's vision, adding that it also felt a little indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**R Mudhoo** (HOT FUSS) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not fully clear inconveniencing CARSON RIVER near the 75 metres.

**B Morgenrood** (JAMIE) - Fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

**Race 2 NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PREMIER (1800m)**

**VANTAA** (J Laking) - Slow to begin.

**RESIDENTIAL** (C Campbell) - Dipped shortly after the start.

**WIDE AWAKE** (M Cameron) - Crowded shortly after the start and lost ground when inside runners were taken out by SANASAR which was laying out at this point.

**KILOWATT** (B Murray) - Raced wide without cover throughout, inconvenienced near the 600 metres by BLUE LAGOON which was taken out by AHYUM which had been taken out by WIDE AWAKE (M Cameron). M Cameron was advised to exercise greater care.

**SAVASAVA** (W Pinn) - When questioned regarding his riding tactics, apprentice W Pinn advised he had been instructed to ride the gelding more positively but that he may have erred in his judgement in regard to the distance he had led by. When questioned as to why he had raced as wide as he had he stated that after riding in the first race he considered the ground closer to the running rail to be inferior as it was showing signs of wear after two days racing.

**Race 3** | **CASHMERE ESTATE - LIVE WITHOUT COMPROMISE PREMIER (2500m)**

**SMILING ASSASSIN** (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly then got its head up on a number of occasions in the early stages when over racing.

**SOUTHERN SAV** (M Cameron) - Steadied away from the heels of TAXIHOME which shifted in passing the 2300 metres.

**OLIGARCH** (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the entire had felt indifferent in its action and may have been feeling the firm nature of the footing. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**Race 4** | **VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS PREMIER (1400m)**

**FIVE KINGS** (R Beeharry) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**ZAWHIP** (L Allpress) - Over raced in the early stages, bumped near the 200 metres when TOMM JONES shifted in abruptly. The rider reported she had been unable to ride the mare out fully due to its tendency to lay in throughout the final straight.

**TIMY TYLER** (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**TOMM JONES** (R Myers) - Raced wide without cover throughout, shifted in abruptly passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened, shifted in again passing the 100 metres having to be straightened.

**Race 5** | **BARNESWOOD FARM WELCOME STAKES (1000m)**

**MISS FEDERER** (M Cameron) - Proved difficult to load in the barriers with trainer A Carston spoken to regarding the filly's barrier manners.

**SPUR ROAD** (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

**SANCTIFY** (S Spratt) - Raced greenly throughout the run home with the rider being unable to ride the filly to any advantage.

**ALL ABOUT MAGIC** (R Myers) - Lay in passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

**Race 6** | **LAMING RACING PREMIER (1200m)**

**OUR TEDDY BOY** (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

**VENDIMA** (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

**MR TYPHON** (K Chowdhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**BARABAS** (C Campbell) - Clipped a heel of MIROSLAVA and blundered near the 1000 metres, over raced in the middle stages, had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres.

**MIROSLAVA** (J Morris) - Raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

**XCUSES XCUSES** (J Bayliss) - Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

**MAGIC NOTE** (S Collett) - Held up until near the 200 metres.

**CONCLUSION** (J Laking) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that although the gelding would prefer rain affected footing he was also of the opinion that it had failed to back up from its first day run.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>GAVELHOUSE.COM 47<sup>TH</sup> NEW ZEALAND 1000 GUINEAS (1600m)</b>

**VALALIE** (M Cameron) - Underwent a veterinary inspection and cleared to race after being removed from its gate after becoming very fractious and sitting down in its starting stall. Raced three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

**MELT** (S Spratt) - Over raced badly in the early stages and was forced inwards by MEDIA SENSATION (M Coleman) passing the 1000 metres having to be checked to avoid the heels of WEKAFORCE. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after parading in a very fresh condition the filly had not helped its chances by over racing and then had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the filly to have a prolonged rate of recovery.

**M Coleman** (MEDIA SENSATION) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he forced MELT inwards passing the 1000 metres causing MELT to be checked off the heels of WEKAFORCE near the 900 metres going back onto MOHAKA which was steadied and checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Coleman's licence to ride at race meetings for 9 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 24 November up to and including Friday 7 December.

**EMILY MARGARET** (L Allpress) - Had to be restrained for a distance when over racing passing the 1000 metres.

**MOHAKA** (J Bayliss) - Steadied and checked passing the 900 metres.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>AVON CITY FORD WUHAN JOCKEY CLUB TROPHY PREMIER (1600m)</b>

**AKOYA PEARL** (J Bayliss) - Blundered badly leaving the barriers dislodging its rider. Rider J Bayliss was attended to by St John Paramedics and found to be uninjured.

**GALWAY GARRY** (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

**THOUGHT THAT** (C Campbell) - Raced three wide without cover.

**PINUP COUP** (C Johnson) - Held up rounding the final bend until near the 300 metres.

**SAVASON** (K Chowdhury) - Hampered near the 450 metres when ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN which was improving to the outside of TAVIGARDE was taken out slightly by that runner then laying out away from TAVIGARDE and becoming unbalanced when making contact with SAVASON. A post-race veterinary inspection found the gelding to be lame suffering a tendon injury in the left foreleg with a veterinary certificate of fitness now required prior to racing again.

The connections of 2<sup>nd</sup> placed SAVASON lodged a protest against 1<sup>st</sup> placed ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN alleging interference near the 450 metres. After hearing evidence and submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

**NESTA** (L Callaway) - Held up when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of FORGED which was laying out passing the 250 metres.

**FORGED** (R Mudhoo) - Lay out throughout the final straight.

**PINSRAAD** (R Myers) - Held up passing the 300 metres until near the 200 metres.

**Race 9** | **CHRISTCHURCH CASINO 155<sup>TH</sup> NEW ZEALAND CUP (3200m)**

The start was officially delayed 3 minutes on TAB request as a result of the protest in the previous race.

**SYLVESTER** (Z Moki) - Crowded and buffeted shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground getting back as a result.

**ITELLYOONETHING** (W Pinn) - Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

**BEE TEE JUNIOR** (M Coleman) - Raced in restricted room to the inside of ITELLOONETHING near the 2200 metres then having to be checked when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of DEE AND GEE.

**MENTAL TELEPATHY** (M Cameron) - Raced wide throughout and was inclined to over-race, lay in throughout the run home.

**GORBACHEV** (T Allan) - Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

**D Bradley** (FELAAR) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 9 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 18 November up to and including 1 December.

**S Spratt** (BIZZWINKLE) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

**MAJOR TOM** (S Collett) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after over racing in the early stages under its top weight the gelding had failed to see out the two mile distance of today's race. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have a poor rate of recovery.

**Race 10** | **FRANTIC BLOODSTOCK PREMIER (2000m)**

**KATIEM MARIE** (L Allpress) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground when STRAD lay out.

**CASUAL WINKS** (S Collett) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**AMOUR LA VIE** (T Moseley) - Hampered shortly after the start when forced across heels.

**COUP DREAMWOOD** (K Chowdhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**GOLDEN BAY** (J Lowry) - Held up rounding the final turn until near the 350 metres.

**PICKUP** (C Campbell) - Rider dropped his whip near the 50 metres.

**CASUAL WINKS** (S Collett) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised had felt indifferent in its action with a post-race veterinary inspection failing to reveal any abnormality.

**Race 11** | **SPEIGHT'S PREMIER (1400m)**

**CLARA** (J Bayliss) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering WELCOME, raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1000 metres and continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages, was not persevered with over the final 250 metres when well beaten. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have a poor recovery rate.

**WELCOME** (M Coleman) - Hampered at the start.

**ZAKYNTHOS** (L Allpress) - Blundered leaving the barriers and shifted outwards hampering KHORABELLA, held up near the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

**KHORABELLA** (S Collett) - Hampered shortly after the start, held up near the 300 metres before obtaining clear running near the 150 metres, held up again over the concluding stages.

**GLOSS** (C Johnson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**OPIHI RANGER** (K Mudhoo) - Steadied to avoid the heels of CLARA near the 450 metres.

**CARDRONA** (S Spratt) - Briefly held up near the 350 metres.
