Race 1	WANGANUI MOTORS 2200m			
CHARLI ROSE (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.				
MISS THE MESS (T Johnson) – Got its head in the air when racing greenly in the home straight on the first occasion when wide. Continued to race greenly throughout.				
Race 2	TOTAL LOG HAULAGE/R&L FREIGHT 2200m			
THE LAST SAMURAI (L Allpress) - Was tightened at the start and got back.				

AI (L'AIIPress) - Was tig

PASTORAL (T Johnson) – Shifted out at the start bumping **DAL QUATTRO**.

THE ROLLING STONE (C O'Beirne) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages, had to be shifted outwards to avoid heels approaching the 1,600 metres.

BLUE RATA ANNA (L Satherley) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

POST GRADUATE (D Bradley) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Caught wide early so taken forward in the back straight to lead.

DIAMOND BELT (M Singh) - Had to be steadied for some distance approaching the home turn when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring **FACETIME.** As a result **BLACK ANASTA** had to take evasive action, running wide on the track. Shifted out abruptly approaching the 100 metres.

JOSEY WALES (R Elliot) - Galloped up on to and clipped the heels of the rapidly tiring **PASTORAL** near the 400 metres. Angled outwards to improve passing the 200 metres.

C JOHNSON (Our Matriarch) - Was advised of his obligations to ride his mount out fully to the finish after relaxing his ride over the final stages.

Race 3 PGG WRIGHTSON/TOM ANDREWS CONTRACTING 1650m

RELY ON ME (D Bradley) – Slow away. Ran up on to the heels of **MAIDSTONE PARK** having to be restrained approaching the 1,200 metres.

KIWI PRINCESS (M Singh) – Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres. Raced greenly in the home straight.

VERBIER (R Myers) – When questioned into the performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 4 CR GRACE/TONY WILSON LIVESTOCK 1400m

PETITE EN JEU (D Turner) - Raced keenly in the early stages

PERFECT HARMONEE (M Singh) – Raced keenly in the early stages so was allowed to roll forward to lead near the 1,000 metres.

Race 5 STEELFORM ROOFING GROUP – WAVERLEY CUP 2200m

BALHAM (R Myers) - Shifted out abruptly at the start tightening **GLORY DAYS** and **NYMPH MONTE** which both settled back.

GLORY DAYS (L Allpress) – Tightened start. Raced ungenerously for a short distance near the 1,700 metres.

NYMPH MONTE (W Pinn) – Tightened start. When questioned into the performance, rider advised the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a slow post-race recovery.

Race 6 WANGANUI INSURANCE/SUMMIT ELECTRICAL 1200m

CASCADE DE LA VIE (R Elliot) - Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

MIDNIGHT POETRY (C O'Beirne) - Raced keenly in the early stages when in front.

NOT SO SURE (L Hemi) – Hung outwards badly rounding the turn running to the outside fence approaching the 600 metres falling and dislodging rider L Hemi. Also inconveniencing **MONKEY TOWN** approaching the 600 metres. Connections were advised the mare must trial to the satisfaction to the Stewards prior to starting next. Rider was examined by St John paramedics and cleared. **NOT SO SURE** underwent a veterinary inspection and was also cleared of any injury.

MONKEY TOWN (T Johnson) - Inconvenienced 600 metres.

Race 7 WAVERLEY HARVESTING/BIG BLADE 1400m

SAINTED PEARL (M Singh) – Hampered over the final stages when there was simultaneous movement from **ROCKONEVE** (R Myers) which shifted in and **MIDNIGHT STORY** (L Satherley) which shifted out. Both riders Myers and Satherley were shown footage and advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.
