Race 1	SPEIGHT'S HANDICAP 1200 M
TANIWHA (J Morris) – Slow to begin.	
TIMY TYLER (B Murray) – Rider reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out fully to the finish of race.	

<p>DOCKET (R Beeharry) – Late scratching at 12.45pm after refusing to enter the barriers. The connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial on two occasions to the satisfaction of Stewards. Trainer B Tapper advised the gelding would be sent for a spell and consideration would be given to its future racing prospects.</p>	
Race 2	SADDLERY WAREHOUSE INVERCARGILL MAIDEN 1200 M
<p>MAKS LEGEND (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly. Steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of TWILIGHT DANCER (S Muniandy) passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>TO SIR WITH LOVE (A Bohorun) – Over-raced passing the 1000 metres. Held up upon entering the home straight.</p> <p>CHOWDER (B Murray) – Shifted outwards on jumping making contact with TO SIR WITH LOVE. When spoken to regarding the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation.</p> <p>TWILIGHT DANCER (S Muniandy) – Shifted inwards near the 400 metres resulting in MAKS LEGEND having to steady. Rider S Muniandy was warned for the manner he shifted ground at this point.</p> <p>SUPERTRAMP (J Lowry) – Raced wide throughout. Brushed passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>JESSIE JANET (T Moseley) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>SNOWBELLE (Z Bholah) – Shifted inwards on jumping making firm contact with EAGER BEAVER which was dictated inwards hampering SWEET OAK.</p> <p>LITTLE FLICK (R Mudhoo) – Brushed passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>SWEET OAK (T Jonker) – Hampered between runners on jumping. Over-raced and got its head up near the 1000 metres. Steadied again near the 800 metres and got its head up when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>EAGER BEAVER (K Kwo) - Lay outwards and made the bend awkwardly near the 400 metres. Rider reported the mare to have raced greenly throughout.</p>	
Race 3	BAILLIE AND LEWIS PHARMACY HANDICAP 2130 M
<p>HE AIN'T HEAVY (A Bohorun) – Raced wide from the 900 metres.</p> <p>BEAUFIGHTER (J Morris) – Began awkwardly and got back as a result.</p> <p>SPIDER LILY (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages due to the lack of tempo. When spoken to regarding the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation.</p> <p>FRIDAY KNIGHT (R Beeharry) – When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer B Tapper advised the gelding had appreciated the prevailing track conditions along with the step-up in distance today and was also aided by a heady ride with weight relief.</p>	
Race 4	ILT FOUNDATION HANDICAP 2130 M
<p>KAURI COVE (T Moseley) – Lay outwards passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>MIDNITE KAOS (B Murray) – Raced keenly in the early stages. When spoken to regarding the performance rider reported the gelding was not suited to the indifferent tempo of today's race and had failed to run on when placed under full pressure.</p>	

TICKY TU (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the early stages. Held up on the heels of a tiring runner near the 500 metres.

BATTLE KAT (C Johnson) – When spoken to regarding the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation.

SKEEN (T Jonker) – Race wide from the 900 metres. Gave ground from the 500 metres.

HIGHER AUTHORITY (C Barnes) – Attempted a marginal run passing the 250 metres, becoming awkwardly placed between FRANCONI and KAURI COVE. Continued to try and improve to the outside of KAURI COVE which shifted outwards marginally passing the 200 metres. C Barnes was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed grazing to a hind fetlock which did not require Veterinary treatment.

LIL MISS SWISS (K Kwo) – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

Race 5	CATR FASHIONS IN THE FIELD SAT 15 DEC MAIDEN 2130 M

RIVIERA ROCK (J Lowry) – Over-raced in the early stages. When spoken to regarding the manner he rode, in particular passing the 70 metres rider J Lowry reported the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg with connections advised a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to RIVIERA ROCK racing next.

PRODUCER (T Jonker) – Slow to begin. Gave ground from the 500 metres. Rider reported the gelding had failed to handle the track conditions today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

SOUTHERN JAZZ (A Bohorun) – Rider was spoken to regarding the manner he eased the pace passing the finishing post on the first occasion. When spoken to regarding the seemingly improved performance trainer S Blair-Edie advised the gelding had appreciated the small field and a positive ride in front.

ZEDAAM (J Morris) – Late scratching at 12.24pm on Veterinary advice after being injured in the float en route to the course.

TIMES FLYING (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

Race 6	McCALLUMS GROUP MAIDEN 1600 M

ROCK MASTER (S Muniandy) – Began awkwardly and got its head up.

OUR BOY RITCHIE (B Murray) – Raced wide in the early stages.

PATROMIA (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Held up near the 400 metres, having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

PEGGY STEWART (J Morris) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.

RAISE A SAINT (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

Race 7	ASCOT PARK HOTEL HANDICAP 1400 M

FLICKA OF GOLD (Z Bholah) – Raced keenly and got its head up passing the 1200 metres. Placed in restricted room passing the 120 metres when AMOUR LA VIE shifted ground inwards.

THE BUMPER (B Murray) – shifted inwards shortly after the start forcing FLICKA OF GOLD and TEDDYTWINKLETOES inwards, resulting in TEDDYTWINKLETOES being buffeted and checked. Also hampered in this incident was TAPONISME.

Apprentice rider **B Murray** assisted by Mr D Walsh, admitted that he rode carelessly at this stage of the race. After viewing replays and hearing submissions on penalty the JCA imposed a suspension of Mr Murrays' licence to ride from the 26th November up to and including the 6th December (7 days)

TAPONISME (C Johnson) – Hampered shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early stages.

TEDDYTWINKLETOES (T Moseley) – Buffeted and checked shortly after the start when THE BUMPER shifted in.

Race 8	MARQUEE & PARTY HIRE 1400 M

TRIZAC (A Bohorun) – Reported by its rider to have made abnormal breathing noises during and after the running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer to give consideration to gear changes at next start.

BUSTER BOLT (C Campbell) – Raced ungenerously and wide in the early stages, then continued to race wide throughout.

ODYSSEUS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Raced keenly and got its head up in the early stages.

DANZI CREEK (J Lowry) – Held up near the 400 metres. Not afforded clear running passing the 100 metres when awkwardly placed on heels and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

Race 9	CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES SAT 15 DEC HANDICAP 1400 M

FULLTOTHEBRIM (K Selvan) – Slow to begin. Held up approaching the 500 metres and further hampered when awkwardly placed near the 300 metres.

HAYWOOD (J Lowry) –Performance questioned rider reported gelding to be indifferent in its action and had failed to respond when placed under pressure. Stewards will follow up with trainer A Hewitson in the coming days.

REGENT STREET (K Mudhoo) – Heavily restrained when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres and had to steady when VERIFY lay in under pressure, when giving ground.

VALETINA VITTORIA (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout.

VERIFY (S Muniandy) – Reported by its rider to have hung throughout. Stewards will follow up with trainer G Robinson in the coming days.

LEILA EVE (R Mudhoo) – Raced fiercely in the early stages.
