Race 4 TRYDAN ELECTRICAL 1200 (1200 Metres)

SHEZA BEACH BABE (J Parkes) – Trainer F Auret advised Stewards that in the days following this race the filly was showing signs of having jarred up and has subsequently been sent for a spell.

TANTALISING (D Johnson) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Racing Tauranga - 17 November 2018

Race 6 WALKER & HALL HANDICAP 1400

EMBELLISH (O Bosson) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that EMBELLISH would now be retired from racing.

Waverley Racing Club - 18 November 2018

Race 5 STEELFORM ROOFING GROUP – WAVERLEY CUP 2200m

NYMPH MONTE (W Pinn) – Trainer G Nicholson advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 C & C AUTOS MDN 1800M

CAMEO (L Allpress) – Jumped outwards at the start contacting and tightening GREAT NORTH ROAD and CAPELLANI which both settled back. Raced keenly in the middle stages. Held up approaching the 100 metres having to be angled outwards across heels, then raced in restricted room over the final stages.

GREAT NORTH ROAD (H Parkes) – Contacted and tightened at start settling back.

CAPELLANI (R Elliot) – Contacted and tightened at start settling back.

CABALLERO (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly.

JAYPERNO (L Hemi) – Tightened at start and settled back.

WAISAKE (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover until near the 1100 metres.

COURT MISTRESS (A Goindasamy) – Improved forward near the 1100 metres then was obliged to race without cover for the remainder.

BLACK ANASTA (W Pinn) – Held up rounding the turn. Made contact with COOL BELT when attempting a narrow run to the inside of that runner near the 200 metres.

Race 2 WESTERN FIRST NATIONAL MDN 1600M

INCOGNITO (D Danis) – Began awkwardly.

MR LIKEABLE (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly settling back.

MR JIMMY POCKET (L Hemi) – Slow away.

NEON LIGHT (D Prastiyou) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Hung outwards rounding the turn and ran off, was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. Trainer J Bell was advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

VIVA LILLI (R Elliot) – Held up approaching the 400 metres before being angled outwards across heels near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

JIN CHI PHANTOM (M Cameron) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of HI I'M NIKKITA (L Satherley) which shifted in passing the 1100 metres. L Satherley was advised to exercise care. Lay out under pressure in the home straight placing its rider in some difficulty. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action during the running and in his opinion may be feeling the firmness of the track. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination was found to be mildly lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised that the gelding would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

ACRE (A Jones) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of MR LIKEABLE which shifted in passing the 50 metres. W Pinn was advised to exercise care.

Race 3

GIRLS GO RACING 1000 R65 1000M

ARABICA (D Danis) – Began awkwardly settling back. Checked near the 700 metres after improving onto heels when racing keenly and then heavily contacted near the 600 metres becoming unbalanced with apprentice D Danis losing the use of his right stirrup iron when the saddle shifted forward being unable to ride the mare out fully for the remainder of the race.

HIGH DISTINCTION (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover.

FASCINO LASS (W Pinn) – Improved on to the heels of DREAMS OF PLATINUM when over racing having to be restrained near the 700 metres and when doing so went back on to ARABICA which was checked. ARABICA then improved into a marginal run approaching the 600 metres to the outside of FACINO LASS making heavy contact with the hind quarters of that runner and as a result both FASCINO LASS and ARABICA become unbalanced and lost ground.

Race 4 ANTON MORA & SON PAINTER MDN 1100M

PAINLESS (L Hemi) – Tightened at the start. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

HINGIS (H Parkes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MIRACULOUS (D Hirini) – Raced wide throughout.

RED FOREST (T Johnson) – Lay out making the bend near the 400 metres running wide.

EXCUSE MY HOTNESS (W Pinn) – Steadied shortly after the start when LADY BLUE (L Satherley) shifted in. L Satherley was advised to exercise care.

PIRIWAI (C Johnson) – Held up near the 500 metres until gaining clear running approaching the 250 metres.

CRAGGY RANGE (S McKay) – Hung out rounding the final turn making contact with JENNA entering the home straight.

Race 5 REVITAL FERTILISERS 1400M R65

DESANO (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Briefly unbalanced passing the 200 metres.

EYE'S WIDE OPEN (W Pinn) – Slow to begin.

POWNCE (T Johnson) – Shifted out approaching the 200 metres forcing STRAIGHT SETS out on to DESANO which was briefly unbalanced.

Race 6 ECOLAB MAIDEN 3YO 1400M

SAVY YONG BLONK (S Collett) – Began very awkwardly settling back. Held up from near the 600 metres until near the 100 metres.

FLYING MEG (L Satherley) – Inconvenienced at the start.

MONKEY SHOULDER (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

NOD (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

IF WE MEET AGAIN (D Danis) – Held up for a short distance approaching the 500 metres.

Race 7 STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN MDN 1400M

AUSTRIA (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

SPANCILHILL (W Pinn) – Slow to begin.

OPERATOR (S McKay) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay in under pressure approaching the 200 metres having to be straightened.

BALANTO (L Hemi) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 300 metres when NIRVANA lay inwards.

Race 8LANDMARK HOMES MDN 1400MLUMINOUS (M Cameron) – Slow to begin.

THUTMOSIS (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

DEZELLA (T Johnson) – Raced ungenerously for a distance in the middle stages.

MIDNIGHT POETRY (L Hemi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

HEINEKEN HANK (T Allan) – Held up for a short distance near the 350 metres.

GOCARA (S Collett) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had raced greenly the lefthanded way of going and in her opinion would appreciate some easing in the ground.

OFF THE GRID (L Allpress) – When questioned regarding performance rider could not offer any excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

R Elliot (SPRING BLOSSOM) – Was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 9 CHRISTMAS @ THE RACES DEC 6TH R65 1800M

ALVINS DREAM (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.

OFF WITH HER HEAD (Z Moki) – Slow away.

SHOCKWAVE (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off heels near the 1600 metres and when doing so briefly inconvenienced EPAE ROAD (W Pinn). Then continued to over race shifting out abruptly near the 900 metres contacting TUNZAGUTZ.

EPAE ROAD (W Pinn) – Briefly inconvenienced near the 1600 metres.

TUNZAGUTZ (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted near the 900 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in her opinion the mare would benefit from some easing in the ground.

STAR QUALITY (C O'Beirne) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

PERCY'S GEM (L Hemi) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ROC YA SOX (L Allpress) – Held up for a short distance approaching the 100 metres.
