RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Westbrook.co.nz 2000
<p>RIPINHET (R Elliot) – Crowded approaching the 1900 metres having to steady losing ground between CURIOUS GEORGE which was taken out slightly by LAKE SUPERIOR, and SHOCKOOL which was forced in slightly by CHIEF SEQUOYAH which was taken in by MORE JOOLS which became awkwardly placed inside the heels of PIGGY MALONE (T Yanagida) which shifted in abruptly. T Yanagida was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that he must exercise greater care. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>CHIEF SEQUOYAH (S Collett) – Became awkwardly placed on heels when making the bend passing the 1700 metres.</p> <p>LIZ’S GIFT (C Dell) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>CABOCHON (V Colgan) - Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward approaching the 1200 metres.</p> <p>DANELYN (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>DISRAELI (D Danis) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>MORE JOOLS (L Innes) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>S Collett (CHIEF SEQUOYAH) – Issued with a warning for using her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>O’SUGAR (S Spratt) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no abnormalities other than a superficial laceration to the right hind medial pastern.</p> <p>NOCTURNAL (J Bayliss) – When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer L Anderson advised that the mare had benefited from the step up in distance and the removal of the tongue tie.</p>	
Race 2	Westbrook ‘Crackling Rose’ 2017 1400
<p>SUGAR BOMB (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Briefly steadied passing the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MAN OF THE WOODS (J Waddell) which shifted out under pressure. J Waddell was advised that he must exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>MOIRAS TOWN (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>CLEMENTINA (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly then shifted in contacting MOIRAS TOWN with both runners becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>THIS IS ME (G Cooksley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BEASTMODE (V Colgan) – Became awkwardly placed inside heels passing the 900 metres when racing ungenerously.</p> <p>GO STARKY (S Spratt) – Briefly hampered 250 metres when crowded by STILTON (L Satherley) which raced greenly when placed under pressure. L Satherley was advised that she must exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>THE BUZZ (S McKay) – Inconvenienced over the final 100 metres by TWO MADISON (T Yanagida) which shifted out under pressure. T Yanagida was reprimanded and advised that he must exercise greater care.</p>	

SENIOR MOSS (R Elliot) – Steadied over the concluding stages when racing in restricted room between MASSACHUSETTS (A Calder) which shifted out and PETRABELLA which shifted in slightly. A Calder was advised that he must exercise greater care.

Race 3	Avondale Sunday Markets 1200
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FLYING FLAME (S Spratt) – Underwent a veterinary examination after being fractious in the barriers and was cleared fit to race.

VEDO ROSSO (E McCall) – Slow to begin (4L).

BONFIRE (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to over-race in the early stages before improving on to heels approaching the 1000 metres then shifted out making contact with SHE’S FOXY which became unbalanced. BONFIRE continued to over-race shifting out when making the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres forcing SHE’S FOXY and BLUSHING HEIGHTS out over extra ground. When questioned regarding the performance Rider J Waddell advised that the gelding had proved difficult in the early and middle stages when racing ungenerously and will improve with the experience.

QUEEN SWEEP (A Jones) – Slow to begin. Had to be restrained after improving on to heels near the 900 metres.

SHE’S FOXY (C Lammas) – Contacted and unbalanced approaching the 1000 metres. Forced over extra ground passing the 800 metres.

PRISE DE FER (O Bosson) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

BLUSHING HEIGHTS (J Bayliss) – Forced over extra ground passing the 800 metres.

CHOCTOC (L Innes) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres to the outside of FLYING FLAME which shifted out to obtain clear running and the inside of PRISE DE FER which shifted in slightly.

STARMAN (V Colgan) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril and after going an endoscopic examination was not deemed to have bled.

Race 4	AJC On Facebook 1200
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CAILIN (C Lammas) – Slow to begin. Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.

SHEZATHINKA (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

WAY ABOVE (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MIKE’S MISTAKE (A Calder) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Race 5	Supporters Club 1200
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SCAGLIONI (K McCulloch) – Slow to begin.

AIR CENTRE (C Dell) – Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room soon after the start.

BAS DE SOIE (J Waddell) – Knuckled on jumping away.

A Goindasamy (CRYSTALLIZE) – Issued with a warning after permitting CRYSTALLIZE to shift in passing the 1000 metres when insufficiently clear of WILD CHILD which was hampered.

TOKYO LIL (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

PINOT GREY (O Bosson) – Slow to begin (3L). Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages. Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 375 metres making brief contact with VASILIKI which was dictated wider.

VASALIKI (D Danis) - Dictated wider 375 metres.

WILD CHILD (M Cameron) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages and then hampered near the 1000 metres. Continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages. Lay in across the hind quarters of STAND TALL which was shifting out slightly near the 300 metres. When questioned regarding the performance M Cameron advised that after over-racing in the early to middle stages the mare had then failed to respond in the final straight as a consequence. WILD CHILD underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

Race 6	Vineyards West Auckland 1600
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WISHES (C Dell) – Slow to begin.

THEE MADAME (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Commenced to give ground quickly passing the 400 metres and then lay in, and when being corrected by its rider shifted out making contact with SASERELLO which was hampered becoming unbalanced making contact with SCUTAR. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer J Prangley advised the owners would be giving consideration to the mares racing future.

SASARELLO (R Elliot) – Hampered 375 metres becoming unbalanced.

OXYMORON (A Goindasamy) – Raced in restricted room 300 metres.

ALADINA (L Innes) – Rider L Innes was reminded that he must ride his mounts out to the end of a race when circumstances permit him to do so. When questioned regarding the performance L Innes advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of the improved track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

Race 7	West Brook Cellar Door 1600
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TAKE IT OUT (D Danis) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.

DON BLANCO (C Lammas) – Sprung the off fore plate during the running.

Race 8	AJC Members 2000
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HERE TO STAY (A Goindasamy) – Briefly hampered when forced in passing the 1900 metres.

L Innes – Issued with a warning after permitting SACRED SIREN to shift in passing the 1900 metres forcing HERE TO STAY inwards.

HAVOC (S Collett) – Raced fiercely in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance.

CANCELLARA (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Crowded 300 metres and briefly hampered.

B Grylls (AZAREEL) – Issued with a warning after permitting AZAREEL to shift out passing the 300 metres briefly hampering CANCELLARA.

MATAURI (M Cameron) – Commenced to give ground appreciably passing the 800 metres and was retired from the race. A veterinary examination found the mare to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia with connections being advised that an appropriate veterinary examination would be required prior to racing next.

SACRED SIREN (L Innes) – Steadied passing the 175 metres when crowded.

T Yanagida – Issued with a warning after allowing HE’S NO SAINT to shift in under pressure passing the 175 metres crowding SACRED SIREN which was crowded.

Race 9

Trials @ Avondale 4 December 1600

CARDELLI (P Pilley) – Late scratching at 5.34pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in its barrier stall. Co-trainer D Rogerson was advised that CARDELLI would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

DAWON (L Satherley) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

VILLA NINE (B Grylls) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

NESLEY (T Thornton) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

SIERRA VISTA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly and had to be steadied shortly after when placed in restricted room. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

MAESTRO BLU (M Cameron) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.
