Race 1	DAVE HOSKIN CARRIERS MDN 1340m			

WONDER NO MORE (S McKay) – Slow away

TOOK THE CATCH (L Hemi) – Slow away

THUTMOSIS (D Turner) – Raced keenly when three-wide without cover.

PUNTA MITA (L Allpress) – Raced greenly throughout becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **MONKEY TOWN** near the 1,000 metres and when being restrained shifted outwards hampering **NIGHTTRONIC.**

NIGHTTRONIC (C O'Beirne) - Hampered 1,000 metres.

RIO STAR (W Pinn) – Restrained off heels near the 600 metres. Held up for a short distance entering the home straight then had to be angled outwards to improve near the 250 metres.

VELOCE (D Hirini) – Raced wide throughout. Was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned D Hirini advised that she considered something may be amiss with the mare. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

CHARTWELL (T Johnson) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

CHAT TO KILL (R Hannam) - When questioned into the run R Hannam reported the gelding was disappointing but was of the opinion may be better suited to a longer distance.

Race 2 AME ELECTRICAL 1340m

WHATSUP (L Allpress) - Awkwardly away settling back. When questioned into the performance, L Allpress advised the gelding had no excuse but should take natural improvement from the run.

LINCOLN'S GAL (R Hannam) - Slow away.

SOPHIA MAGIA - (D Turner) – Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres. Disappointed for a marginal run approaching the 200 metres having to be restrained when **REBEL ROSE** shifted out and **JAKKALBOMB** lay in. Rider C O'Beirne was shown footage and advised to exercise greater care.

BRUEGEL (S O'Malley) – Tightened passing the 200 metres when **JAKKALBOMB** lay inwards when racing greenly simultaneously as **REBEL ROSE** (C O'Beirne) which had shifted in under pressure was straightened and shifted outwards.

JAKKALBOMB (R Myers) - Lay in and away from **SINARAHMA** when that runner improved to its outside early in the home straight having to be straightened. When questioned R Myers reported her mount raced greenly throughout.

TIPPERARY MARY (T Allan) – Had to be restrained off heels approaching the 800 metres. Had to be angled outwards across heels passing the 200 metres to improve.

WHENHARRYMETSADDLE (S McKay) - When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate a longer distance.

Race 3 GAS & HEATING 1200m

PIRIWAI (M Singh) - Tightened at the start when **ARABICA** began awkwardly. Restrained off heels near the 600 metres and again near the 450 metres.

ALL IN MANA (T Allan) – Slow away

BRIMM (J Parkes) - Made the bend awkwardly when in restricted room near the 900 metres.

DEJA ROO (L Hemi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MARGOT (W Pinn) – Restrained off heels passing the 600 metres and when doing so went back onto **PIRIWAI** which had to be restrained.

ARABICA (L Allpress) – When questioned L Allpress advised her riding instructions were to lead adding the mare felt short in its action approaching the home turn so she did not persevere in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the mare to be exhibiting Grade 2 lameness in the right fore limb. A veterinary clearance being required. Trainer A Sharrock advised **ARABICA** will be retired.

Race 4

PALAMOUNTAINS NEW MUSCLE RECOVERY 2040m

SHARED SECRETS (D Turner) - Slow away

HANK MOODY (T Johnson) - Raced three-wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

CHIC (H Durrant) - Held up rounding the turn.

T Allan (LINCOLN BAY) - Was issued with a warning with respect to the manner in which he used his whip in the home straight.

DETENTORE (J Parkes) - When questioned into the run of **DETENTORE** which, after leading throughout, failed to run on to any extent in the home straight J Parkes advised that in his opinion the gelding did not see out the distance at this stage of its preparation. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 5

WANGANUI MOTORS AND THE DYKE FAMILY 1600m

OUR BANDIT (L Allpress) – Slow away

PETITE EN JEU (D Turner) - Tightened shortly after the start.

ALL BLACK MAGIC (M Singh) – Raced ungenerously for a distance when in restricted room passing the 1,400 metres.

SHADOW KING (W Pinn) – Restrained off heels near the 1,400 metres. Held up having to be restrained when attempting a run which didn't eventuate to the inside of **LAAFFAIRE** passing the 200 metres.

L HEMI (Lady Kartel) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) after angling her mount in passing the 1,400 metres when not clear of **HINERANGI** dictating that runner inwards and tightening **ALL BLACK MAGIC.**

HINERANGI (J Parkes) - Tightened near the 1,100 metres when **LAAFFAIRE** (R Hannam) shifted inwards when not the required distance clear. Jockey R Hannam was advised to exercise greater care.

PETITE EN JEU (D Turner) - Lost the near hind plate during the running.

Race 6

LOADERS WANGANUI 1340m

THE BANDITO (H Durrant) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards in the home straight.

ROCKONEVE (L Hemi) – Slow away. Held up from the 400 metres after a run near the running rail did not eventuate prior to being angled outwards to gain clear running inside the final 100 metres.

CHOICE ATTITUDE (C O'Beirne) - Jumped outwards at the start dictating WINDSOR, HUNDYAMONTH, AILEEN GRACE, THE BANDITO and TELLYAWHAT wider on the track then continued to hang outwards in the early stages.

TELLYAWHAT (J Parkes) - When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate a more rain affected surface. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

HUNDYAMONTH (M Singh) - When questioned into the improved performance of the winner **HUNDYAMONTH** co-trainer JJ Rayner advised in her opinion the gelding appreciated the weight relief today.

Race 7

CAMBRIDGE THOROUGHBRED LODGE WANGANUI CUP 2040m

ROCK ON (R Hannam) – Very slow away. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.

RINGO (L Hemi) – Raced three-wide without cover in the early stages.

HIGHLAD (W Pinn) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Restrained off heels passing the 1,400 metres and when doing so shifted outwards inconveniencing **RINGO** and going back onto **HEAVENS KEEP** which was restrained.

HEAVENS KEEP (M Singh) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

HUNTA PENCE (D Hirini) - D Hirini was given a warning under Rule 638 (4) in that she eased her mount abruptly on entering the back straight when in front, placing **HIGHLAD** which was trailing in some difficulty when that runner had to be eased off the heels of **HUNTA PENCE.** Also affected was **HEAVENS KEEP** which had to be steadied. Stewards took into account **HIGHLAD'S** tendency to over-race when assessing the interference.

Race 8 WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 1600m

KIT KAT (D Turner) – Slow away

SAINTED PEARL (L Hemi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LARIMA (T Johnson) – When questioned into his ride, T Johnson advised that his instructions were to go forward and after being wide into the first corner elected to lead but after viewing footage agreed with Stewards that he may have erred in his judgement by not giving his mount some respite in the middle stages when able to do so.

TROUP ROAD (T Allan) - Lost off-side hind plate during the running.

REAL BEACH (H Durrant) – Held up approaching the 450 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight.

PERCY'S GEM (M Singh) – Held up rounding the turn.

ITALIAN LOVER (L Allpress) - When questioned into the performance rider advised that after racing wide and keenly in the early stages the mare had little left in the finish.
