GEMSTONE JEWELS (T Jonker) – Steadied near the 800 metres when crowded for room by ADRIANO which shifted in to avoid the heels of XANTHIA. Bumped at the 150 metres.

GET RYTHM (L Callaway) - When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer S Blair-Edie advised that the

gelding had appreciated the firmer nature of today's track conditions.

Race 3 FRESH CHOICE CROMWELL MAIDEN 2030m

HEAD OFFICE (R Hannam) – Slow to begin. When spoken to regarding the improved performance co-trainer P Corbett advised the gelding had been aided by a positive ride today.

LORD HERCULES (S Muniandy) – Slow to begin.

ZEDAAM (J Morris) – Raced four wide into the first bend.

OHTHOSERUSSIANS (B Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the event.

RAISE YA CARDS (C Campbell) – Wide for the majority of the race.

ADVENTURESS (R Beeharry) – Retired from the race after the saddle slipped well forward placing the rider in difficulty passing the 1200 metres.

DANTE FIRE (J Lowry) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 100 metres, continued to race in tight quarters between RAISE YA CARDS and COLOUR ME RED over the concluding stages.

C Campbell (RAISE YA CARDS) - Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) for allowing his mount to shift out passing the 100 metres crowding DANTE FIRE.

COLOUR ME RED (K Kwo) – Placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres. Crowded and had to steady passing the 25 metres when TATUM shifted in and away from BEAM ME UP SCOTTY who shifted in under pressure before being straightened.

J Bayliss (TATUM) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) for allowing his mount to shift inwards passing the 50 metres crowding COLOUR ME RED and DANTE FIRE.

MERU (T Moseley) – When spoken to regarding the performance of the favourite the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

KIWI IDA (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.			

KOXINGA (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the bend passing the 400 metres. Continued to be held up early in the run home having to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

MIGHTY SOLOMON (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained in the early stages.

TOMM JONES (G Jogoo) – Lay inwards in the run home making contact with the running rail passing the 250 metres.

FLYING SARDINE (R Mudhoo) – Wide throughout. Had to shift outwards across heels passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

Race 5 QUARTZ REEF 1220m

STROWAN (K Asano) – Was late scratched by the Stewards at 1.50 pm after dumping the rider in the preliminary and completing a circuit of the course. K Asano was uninjured in this incident.

ISHINKTAATLEDO (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

PASSITO (J Morris) – Blundered on jumping.

FIVE KINGS (R Beeharry) – Stood flat footed missing the start by 10 lengths. The connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial before returning to the races.

FEELIN THE LOVE (T Moseley) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages and raced ungenerously throughout.

KING PIN (K Kwo) – Was not afforded clear running throughout the final straight and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.

NIGHTCAP (C Campbell) – Stumbled passing the 300 metres and was retired from the event. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities. Stewards will follow up with the trainer in coming days.

Race 6 INDUSTRI ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN 1220m

E Winsloe trainer, was warned for presenting IRISH EXPRESS in the wrong notified gear.

IRISH EXPRESS (K Mudhoo) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground as a result. Stumbled passing the 1200 metres. Hampered and had to be severely restrained passing the 200 metres.

ANZAC COUP (K Chowdhoory) – Race wide throughout.

KATE THE GREAT (A Bohorun) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 700 metres getting its head up on a number of occasions with the rider advising he had some difficulty steering the mare throughout. Improved wide rounding the final bend.

TAREE (B Grylls) – Shifted in abruptly despite the efforts of the rider passing the 200 metres crowding IRISH EXPRESS.

CAMPO (C Barnes) – Rider reported she had been disappointed with the gelding's effort today. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities revealed.

J Bayliss (TOUCH THE SKY) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the JCA imposing a suspension of his licence from conclusion of racing on 5th December up to and including 14th December. (7 national days)

Race 7 S J ALLAN HOLDINGS LTD 2030m

BAL HARBOUR – Was late scratched on veterinary advice at 1.09 pm after being injured on route to the races.

RED RIVER ROCK (J Bayliss) – Slow to begin.

HIGHER AUTHORITY (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

ABOLI (S Muniandy) – Raced fiercely for a distance passing the 1700 metres and had to be restrained off heels when STELLACANTO improved forward to the lead.

VINO TINTO (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout. Gave ground from the 500 metres.

STELLACANTO (A Bohorun) - Raced keenly when in the lead in the early stages.

TONY TWO CHIPS (C Campbell) – Held up early in the run home. Buffeted, unbalanced and forced outwards onto WAGNER passing the 300 metres.

J Bayliss (RED RIVER ROCK) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he directed his mount outwards passing the 300 metres buffeting and unbalancing TONY TWO CHIPS who was forced outwards onto WAGNER. The JCA imposed a suspension of his licence from 15th December up to and including 22nd December (7 national days)

Race 8 NO LIMITS INTERIORS 2030m

KAHARUA (T Moseley) – Shifted out abruptly shortly after the start making contact with TANIWHA who was forced out and made contact with COME FLY WITH ME. Raced keenly early stages. Had to be restrained 1800 metres.

L Callaway (COME FLY WITH ME) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) when only marginally clear of KAHARUA who had to be restrained passing 1800 metres.

TANIWHA (J Morris) – Buffeted by inside runner shortly after the start.

TAXIHOME (K Mudhoo) – Raced keen early. Crowded and checked at the 1900 metres.

T Moseley (KAHARUA) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards passing the 1900 metres crowding and checking TAXIHOME. The JCA imposed a suspension of his licence from the end of racing on Friday 7th December up to and including Friday 14th December (5 national days).

LOCHAN ORA (R Mudhoo) – Raced keen early.

R Mudhoo (LOCHAN ORA) - Rider warned for the manner in which he used the whip prior to the 100 metres.

NESTA (R Hannam) – Got its head up when over racing in the early stages. Raced wide early. Crowded 300 metres when WHO DARES WINS which was laying in, shifted in before being straightened.

MOTORBOAT MIKE (K Kwo) – Raced wide from 1200 metres.

PRINCESS BROOK (C Barnes) – Made the first bend awkwardly. When spoken to regarding the performance the rider advised the mare appeared to be holding its breath. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

ELFEE (K Chowdhoory) – When spoken to regarding the performance of the favourite rider advised the mare did not let down when placed under pressure believing she may have been feeling the firmer nature of today's track.

Race 9 DUNSTAN HORSE FEEDS 1400m

HEE'S OUR SECRET (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

KEEP ON COMING ((R Hannam) – Slow to begin.

THOUGHT THAT (K Mudhoo) – Awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres having to steady.

THE CZAR (R Mudhoo) – Crowded and checked 700 metres.

L Callaway (HE'S MI BROTHER) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he crowded and checked THE CZAR passing the 700 metres. The JCA imposed a suspension of his licence from conclusion of racing today up to and including Thursday 13th December (7 national days).

XCUSES XCUSES (J Bayliss) – Raced greenly in the run home and shifted in passing the 100 metres having to be straightened.

Race 10 CENTREPOINT LIQUOR SUPPLIES 1400m

ZAKYNTHOS (B Grylls) – Buffeted between runners shortly after the start and lost ground. Inconvenienced 1100 metres by fallen rider.

CARSON RIVER (K Chowdhoory) – Clipped a heel and blundered passing the 1100 metres with the rider losing the use of his off side iron. When trying to retrieve his iron the rider became unbalanced and fell from his mount. Inconvenienced at this point were both BELLE HOPE and ZAKYNTHOS. Mr Chowdhoory was attended to by St John ambulance staff and was found to have suffered superficial cuts and bruising. An enquiry into how CARSON RIVER clipped a heel was opened and adjourned.

BELLE HOPE (J Morris) – Inconvenienced 1100 metres.

SENTIENT (K Kwo) – Raced keenly in the early stages with the rider reporting that the gelding had hung throughout.

HOOFBEAT (R Beeharry) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.

CABERNET (J Lowry) – Raced wide for the majority of the event with the rider reporting that the bit had run through the gelding's mouth. He also advised he would be suggesting gear alterations prior to the next start.

QUEEN JETSUN (C Campbell) – Held up briefly near the 50 metres.
