RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HAWKE'S BAY HUNT MAIDEN HURDLE (2500 Metres)

REVOLUTION (A Kuru) - Jumped high at the second fence. Inconvenienced just prior to jumping the final fence when ANIMATOR shifted out under pressure.

MR INK (N Downs) – Poor jump near the 1800 metres.

FLORENCE IVY (T Moki) - Hit the fence near the 1400 metres.

COOL HAND DUKE (I Lupton) - Blundered on landing at the fence near the 1200 metres.

ANIMATOR (E Farr) - Hit the second-last fence. Shifted out under pressure over the final stages.

ZARTAN (H McNeill) – Hit the second-last fence and blundered.

KING'S SECRET (J Seivwright) – Pulled up prior to the final fence when out of contention.

MEDINI (M Gillies) - Rider reported the mare may have held its breath.

Race 2 BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR/OCTOBER 5 MAIDEN HURDLE (2500 Metres)

ZED LEPPELIN (G Walsh) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered 2300 metres.

SO KEEP EM (S Fannin) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Pulled up prior to jumping the second-last fence when well beaten.

THE COSSACK (A Kuru) - Got its head in the air when being restrained after JOCHEN RINDT (E Farr) shifted in when not fully clear near the 2300 metres, which then dropped back on to ZED LEPPELIN. E Farr was advised to exercise care. Continued to race keenly in the early stages and when being restrained near the 1800 metres shifted in inconveniencing COCHISE. Hampered by a fallen runner approaching the 200 metres.

ALI BABA (M Gillies) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

TIGER CAFÉ (H McNeill) - Hit the fence near the 1200 metres unbalancing the rider who lost the use of his stirrup irons. Pulled up after the fence near the 900 metres when out of contention.

QUAFF (M Cropp) – Fell at the second-last fence, badly hampering JOCHEN RINDT, which took evasive action unbalancing the rider. A post-race veterinary examination was clear. M Cropp was examined by St John paramedics and stood down with a wrist injury.

JOCHEN RINDT (E Farr) – Badly hampered second-last fence, then hit the final fence dislodging the rider. E Farr was examined by St John paramedics and cleared to ride.

COCHISE (S Phelan) – Inconvenienced 1800 metres. Commenced to shift ground approaching the final fence and misjudged it, landing awkwardly.

TOODALOO (J Seivwright) - Hampered by a fallen runner 200 metres.

Race 3 TE WHANGAI ROMNEYS/HAWKE'S BAY HURDLE (Prestige Jumping Race) (3100 Metres)

NO CHANGE (A Kuru) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start.

RAAJ (H McNeill) - Hit the fence and blundered near the 1800 metres. Badly hampered by fallen runner near the 200 metres, dislodging the rider. H McNeill was examined by the St John paramedics and cleared to ride.

LETMEBY (J Seivwright) – Jumped the second-last fence awkwardly, unbalancing the rider.

HESALLJAZZ (T Moki) – Commenced to race keenly leaving the straight on the first occasion, improving into a marginal run to the inside of TOMMYRA, which was being steadied off heels. Hit the second-last fence and fell, hampering WILLIJONMCBRIDE and badly hampering RAAJ (H McNeill), which dislodged its rider. T Moki was examined by the St John paramedics and cleared.

WILLIJONMCBRIDE (M Gillies) – Hit the third fence. Badly hampered 200 metres and then pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

DELEGATE (S Higgins) - Misjudged the fence at the 900 metres.

THE GREAT GURU (G Walsh) - Hit the last fence.

E Farr (LAEKEEPER) – E Farr advised stewards following Race 3 that she had some swelling in her right hand and after undergoing a further examination was stood down from her remaining riding engagements, requiring a medical clearance.

Race 4

TREMAINS STARTING GATES 2100 (2100 Metres)

THE HEIRESS (L Allpress) – Slow away. Briefly held up near the 300 metres, making contact with STROLLING VAGABOND when improving into a narrow run to the inside of that runner approaching the 200 metres.

CHIC (R Elliot) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

STROLLING VAGABOND (M Singh) – Restrained off heels near the 1600 metres when racing keenly. Contacted 200 metres.

Race 5 BIRCHLEIGH POLO CLUB 2200 (2200 Metres)

SANCHEZ (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

HARE BAWL (M Singh) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early stages, shifting out when being restrained.

AVE MARIA (R Jones) - Raced three wide without cover in the early stages before being ridden forward to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres.

KIRKENES (H Schofer) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages, shifting out to avoid heels near the 1400 metres.

BAK DA MASTER (R Elliot) - Shifted out under pressure early in the home straight. Connections advised the gelding had lost the near hind plate during the running.

LEADING ROLE (R Hannam) – Held up behind the weakening MIDNIGHT SHIFT rounding the turn, having to be steadied off heels near the 450 metres.

Race 6 JUST A SWAGGER HB HUNT MAIDEN CHASE (4000 Metres)

SPITHILL (I Lupton) – Ran down the first fence, then Jumped slowly throughout. Had to take evasive action to avoid a fallen runner near the 1200 metres.

IT'S A WONDER (S Phelan) - Raced keenly throughout. Inconvenienced near the 600 metres on the first occasion.

KANGAROO (T Moki) – Raced keenly throughout. Shifted in abruptly approaching the fence near the 600 metres on the first occasion, inconveniencing IT'S A WONDER. Got in close to the fence near the 1400 metres. Put in a poor jump near the 800 metres

GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (N Downs) – Hit the fence and fell near the 1200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. N Downs was examined and cleared by St John paramedics.

Race 7 AHD HAWKE'S BAY STEEPLECHASE (Prestige Jumping Race) (4800 Metres)

THE OYSTERMAN (H McNeill) - Got in close to a number of jumps in the middle stages, losing ground, and was pulled up prior to jumping fence near the 600 metres on the second occasion. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities

KIPKEINO (S Fannin) - Misjudged the fence near the 1400 metres, losing ground.

ZARDETTO (M Gillies) - Jumped high at the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion losing ground.

WISE MEN SAY (I Lupton) – Stumbled on landing at the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion unbalancing the rider.

Race 8 BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND SPRING CARNIVAL/TICKETS ON SALE NOW (1400 Metres)

KIWIANNA (T Johnson) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start after coming into contact with the plastic running rail in back parade ring.

SHEZA BEACH BABE (C Johnson) - Slow away.

BEAUTY STAR (R Elliot) – Tightened shortly after the start when VEUVE CLICQUOT dictated VALHEX inwards simultaneously as MAMARELLA shifted out.

VALHEXA (C O'Beirne) - Dictated wider 350 metres.

MARIOTA (D Hirini) – Held up approaching the 200 metres, having to be angled inwards to gain clear running near the 150 metres.

AMADI LASS (D Bradley) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

MAMARELLA (R Jones) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FAGIOLO MAJICO (H Schofer) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

R Elliot (BEAUTY STAR) – Admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he angled his mount out near the 350 metres when not sufficiently clear of VALHEXA forcing that runner over extra ground. R Elliot's licence to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 4 July, up to and including Wednesday, 17 July 2019 (6 days).

Race 9

ATLANTA PEACH (S Collett) - Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary examination after making contact with a rail on the way to the start. Slow away. Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of HAY TIGER, which lay in under pressure passing the 150 metres.

HAY TIGER (R Jones) - Slow away. Lay in under pressure passing the 150 metres.

PARVINA (H Andrew) – Began awkwardly.

FOGARTY FEGEN (M Hudson) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MIDNIGHT STORY, which shifted out slightly under pressure.

LINCOLN HILLS (C Johnson) - Restrained off heels near the 600 metres. Held up passing the 400 metres and early in the final straight and then had difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race.

MIDNIGHT STORY (T Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TELLYAWHAT (H Schofer) – Steadied passing the 350 metres when attempting a marginal run to the outside of FATHER LENIHAN (L Allpress) which had shifted out and away from LINCOLN HILLS (C Johnson) who had been taken out by ROCK ISLAND LINE (R Hannam). Also contributing was inward movement from ST ANDRE (D Bradley). After questioning all riders concerned no further action was deemed necessary apart from R Hannam being issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).

R Jones (HAY TIGER) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 10

ALMO STREET (C O'Beirne) – Slow away.

TED TALKS (T Johnson) – Slow away.

SPRING BOUQUET (R Elliot) - Slow away.

FINDING NEMO (L Alpress) - Jumped outwards at the start forcing LINCOLN STAR outwards making heavy contact with BELLE TEM and VIS TA VIE. Lay outwards near the 1200 metres contacting CHADSDALE.

BELLE TEM (H Schofer) – Bumped at the start and then clipped a heel and blundered shortly after.

CHADSDALE (H Andrew) - Raced three wide without cover. Contacted 1200 metres.

TIPPERARY MARY (D Bradley) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, tightening VIS TA VIE.

VIS TA VIE (S Collett)-Hampered start. Steadied 800 metres when placed in restricted room.
