RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CENTRAL SOUTHLAND FREIGHT HURDLE 2750m
<p>SHEEZOFF (T Moki) – T Moki was allowed to rider her mount at her riding weight which was 1 kg over the carded weight due to there being no other rider available. Hampered by fallen rider after jumping the first fence.</p>	
<p>BOYSWAY (J Seivwright) – Put in a poor leap at the first fence with the rider becoming unbalanced and being dislodged. Rider J Seivwright was cleared by the St John's paramedic to take his remaining mount. A subsequent veterinary inspection of the gelding found it to be a bleeder and as this was the second time, is now ineligible to race in New Zealand.</p>	
<p>EION (S Higgins) – Poor leap at the third fence. Rider lost whip passing the 250 metres.</p>	
<p>CASHEL (S Phelan) – Mixed its jumping throughout.</p>	
<p>DOCTOR EDEN (G Walsh) – Hampered by riderless horse over the concluding stages.</p>	

Race 2	WAIREPO HEREFORD STUD STEEPLE 4000m
<p>GO GO GONZO (G Walsh) – Mixed its jumping throughout. Hampered passing the 2000 metres when IRISH DUDE shifted in momentarily at this point. Rider dropped whip after jumping the second last fence.</p> <p>ADEQUACY (J Seivwright) – Hampered passing the 2000 metres when IRISH DUDE shifted in momentarily at this point.</p> <p>IRISH DUDE (T Moki) – Poor jump at the fence by the 1800 metres. Attempted to jump inwards at its fences on the final round. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a small laceration to the nearside stifle which did not require treatment.</p> <p>PADDY OWEN (S Higgins) – Put in a faulty leap at the 1000 metres dislodging the rider. The gelding suffered an injury to the right foreleg and was humanely euthanised as a result. Rider S Higgins was attended to by the St John’s paramedics and cleared of any injury.</p> <p>T Moki (IRISH DUDE) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) when allowing her mount to shift in passing the 2000 metres hampering inside runners.</p>	
Race 3	OTAGO FARM MACHINERY 1500m
<p>SQUIZZY (C Johnson) – Over raced through the early and middle stages due to the slow tempo of the race.</p> <p>ABBEY KAY (K Williams) – Lay out throughout the final straight and could not be ridden to full advantage.</p> <p>ALL BLACK MAGIC (T Comignaghi) – When questioned regarding performance of the favourite rider T Comignaghi advised that in her opinion the gelding had not backed up from its race last Saturday. Lost a hind racing plate during the running.</p>	
Race 4	FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS 1600m
<p>BET YA WOOD (N Supple) – Began awkwardly making firm contact with QUAINTELLE. Over raced early stages then was allowed to stride forward to lead.</p> <p>QUAINTELLE (M Gestain) – Bumped at the start.</p> <p>MORENA ROC (H Fleming) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p>J Grundy (SPIDER LILY) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip on her mount excessively prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>MERLOT (L Myers) – When spoken to regarding the performance of the favourite the rider advised the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today’s track conditions.</p>	
Race 5	LEXUS MELBOURNE CUP TOUR IN DUNEDIN 30/08 MAIDEN 1600m
<p>The start of this event was delayed due to St John’s paramedics having to attend a horse attendant who was injured prior to the horses leaving the birdcage.</p> <p>MOLLY POLLY (K Chowdhoo) – Crowded between runners as the start was affected losing ground as a result.</p> <p>WENTWORTH (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>RAISE YOU FIVE (J Lowry) – Held up rounding the final bend and on entering the home straight having to be steadied passing the 250 metres when ITEMIZE shifted outwards at this point. Then had to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres. Held up again inside the final 100 metres and went to the line untested by its rider.</p> <p>THE MARLBORO MA’AM (T Jonker) – Lay in early in the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions. Reported by its rider to have raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>POWER PUNCH (K Kwo) – Rider lost whip passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>DUNDEE FLAG (T Comignaghi) – Dictated inwards by MOLLY POLLY who shifted in under pressure passing the 125 metres. Rider K Chowdhoo was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground and straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion. Rider dropped whip inside the final 100 metres.</p>	

ITEMIZE (C Campbell) – Held up on entering the home straight having to shift ground outwards passing the 150 metres to gain clear racing room.

Race 6 | **SPEIGHTS MAIDEN 1200m**

The start of this event was delayed when BINGO BENNY had to be re-saddled prior to the start. The start was further delayed when GINGERRIFIC proved difficult to load. A barrier manners warning was placed on the gelding's record.

MR FAHRENHEIT (K Kwo) – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout without cover.

GERRY JOYCE (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with GINGERRIFIC losing ground.

BINGO BENNY (K Williams) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Ran outwards rounding the final bend and had to be straightened finishing in last placing. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.

DRAGON GLASS (B Murray) – Shifted in at the start crowding BINGO BENNY losing ground.

BELLE SOUTH (C Johnson) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

MEARA MARY (T Jonker) – Over raced for a distance passing the 1000 metres and had to be restrained.

MAKS LEGEND (J Lowry) – Over raced into the bend near the 800 metres and had to be steadied away from heels shifting out bumping with GINGERRIFIC.

ROSIE GLOW (K Chowdhoo) – Lay inwards passing the 150 metres having to be straightened.

FLICKITOVA (C Campbell) – Held up early in the run home and briefly crowded passing the 175 metres when ROSIE GLOW shifted in.

GINGERRIFIC (G Saejorhor) – Difficult to load. Bumped at the 800 metres. Ducked in passing the 200 metres when being struck with the whip and had to be straightened.

Race 7 | **FIRTH INDUSTRIES 1200m**

Stewards accepted the explanation from Trainer A Schwarz in relation to the late declaration of the rider for **REGENT STREET**.

OPIHI RANGER (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly shifting in making firm contact with inside runner losing ground. Bumped by inside runner at the 600 metres. Lay inwards throughout the home straight.

RINGBOLT (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly making firm contact with outside runner.

TACHIBANA (T Moseley) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SUN GENES (K Chowdhoo) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Crowded and hampered passing the 900 metres.

PROMISING (G Saejorhor) – Crowded and buffeted passing the 900 metres.

LADY DAVONE (K Williams) – Inconvenienced and shifted inwards briefly passing 900 metres.

T Moseley (TACHIBANA) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift inwards passing the 900 metres crowding and buffeting SUN GENES and PROMISING who were both unbalanced for a short distance. Also inconvenienced in this incident was LADY DAVONE which was shifted inwards briefly.

TEE GEE ELL (K Kwo) – Began to over race passing the 900 metres and had to be steadied when making the bend and being crowded by outside runners passing the 850 metres.

ELEGIDO (C Johnson) – Held up rounding the final bend.
