RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NUFARM 1200 (1200 Metres)
BUBBLE GUM (D Turner) - Slow to begin.	
SECOND SLIP (L Allpress) - Knuckled jumping out of the barrier.	

WORLD TOUR (C Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Briefly inconvenienced 450 metres.

ALTO POTENZA (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

VEDETTE ROUGE (M Singh) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres, hampering **HASLER LAD** and **PLATINUM BORDEAUX**.

HASLER LAD (R Hannam) – Hampered 800 metres.

PLATINUM BORDEAUX (C O’Beirne) – Hampered 800 metres.

LEIGHTON WARRIOR (J Parkes) – Tightened, having to be steadied when **EASYRIDER** lay inwards under pressure near the 450 metres, briefly inconveniencing **WORLD TOUR**. When questioned rider could offer no excuse other than he had received an interrupted run. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

EASYRIDER (R Elliot) – When questioned rider advised the gelding had not travelled comfortably. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

C Burdan (FRIDAY) - Was spoken to in the presence of the riding master after allowing her mount to shift inwards over the final stages and was advised she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

Race 2 | **RELIANCE 1200 (1200 Metres)**

BLUE ARROW (S Collett) - Began awkwardly, tightening **THEWAYYOUAEME**, which settled back. Hung rounding the turn becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **FASHION BELT** near the 350 metres. Continued to lay out in the home straight, proving reluctant to improve into a narrow run to the inside of **SHEEZANICEGIRL** over the final stages. S Collett advised the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

THEWAYYOUAEME (R Hannam) – Tightened at start, settling back.

BECKIDBOO (H Schofer) - Slow away.

OUR KATY CRUZ (D Turner) - Slow away.

HOUDINI (R Elliot) – When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

K Buttmore (**SHEEZANICEGIRL**) – Issued with a Minor Infringement Notice under Rule 537(a) for the late declaration of rider for **SHEEZANICEGIRL** and was fined \$50. K Buttmore was also advised she is expected to be contactable prior to 7.30am on race morning.

Race 3 | **PIONEER 1200 (1200 Metres)**

PENELOPE CRUISE (J Parkes) - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight. Lay in under pressure over the final stages.

RUFUS RUFFCUT (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

JUSTA SMALL RANSOM (D Hirini) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

C O’Beirne (**PLATINUM VOLOS**) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing her mount to shift inwards near the 800 metres, briefly tightening **TARABEEBEE** and inconveniencing **YES BOY**.

TARABEEBEE (H Schofer) - Briefly tightened 800 metres.

YES BOY (S Collett) - Inconvenienced 800 metres.

CLASSY LANE (S McKay) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

ARMAGUARD (C Burdan) – Shifted out and away from YES BOY which improved quickly to its inside passing the 100 metres, contacting PLATINUM VOLOS.

PLATINUM VOLOS (C O’Beirne) – Contacted 100 metres.

Race 4 | **TASMAN TOYOTA 1400 (1400 Metres)**

JAW GEE (R Elliot) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

KEEPIN HARMONEE (M Singh) – Raced keenly in the early stages, getting its head in the air when being restrained near the 800 metres.

FLORAL ART (R Hannam) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Tightened near the 350 metres when MEILA REI (D Turner) lay inwards when struck with the whip, briefly inconveniencing IRISH TRIX, which had to angle outwards across the heels of FLORAL ART to gain clear running. D Turner was advised to exercise greater care.

RIO STAR (S Collett) - Held up in the home straight until near the 150 metres.

MR JIMMY POCKET (A Collett) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the home straight.

Race 5 | **DONAGHY’S 2200 (2200 Metres)**

OUT TO IMPRESS (S McKay) - Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with JOHNNY MAC. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Hung outwards near the 1600 metres. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

VACATION (D Turner) - Slow away.

JOHNNY MAC (T Johnson) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after. Briefly tightened approaching the 400 metres. T Johnson was spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention.

COCONUT (B Ansell) - Slow to begin.

TYCOON ZED (C O’Beirne) - Slow to begin.

THE ROLLING STONE (M Cropp) – Inconvenienced when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring OUT TO IMPRESS near the 800 metres.

Race 6 | **DUKE OF GLOUCESTER CUP – 2200 - HARVEY/ANN WILSON (2200 Metres)**

BAD BOY BROWN (J-L Lupton) - Slow to begin

HAMILTONIAN (M Northcott) - Slow to begin.

SARDEEN (K Singh) – Raced very wide throughout. Inconvenienced 200 metres.

LOVETOKEEPHIM (J Fillmore) - Hampered 200 metres.

BARB DWYER (J McIlroy) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MONDORANI (L Myers) – Held up until shifting in to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

B Harrison (LOOK OUT) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount to shift out near the 200 metres inconveniencing SARDEEN and hampering LOVETokeepHIM.

B Harrison (LOOK OUT) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.

Race 7 | **MARINE SERVICES WANGANUI 1650 (1650 Metres)**

SISTER MONICA (H Schofer) - Tightened near the 1400 metres when MAKOURA LODGE improved to its outside, simultaneously as SMOOTH COGNAC (J Baillie) rolled inwards. Stewards took into account outward movement from YEAH RIGHT and NICOLINI, which was racing keenly, when assessing the incident.

MAKOURA LODGE (D Turner) - Tightened 1400 metres.

TUBTHUMPING (J Parkes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards under pressure early in the home straight.

XMAS WONDER (H Andrew) - Was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned rider was of the opinion the mare had held its breath. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

J Baillie (SMOOTH COGNAC) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 | **IPLIX 1650 (1650 Metres)**

HEAVENLY ECHO (H Schofer) – Steadied near the 1450 metres when placed in restricted room.

HEIRLOOM (H Andrew) - Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned into performance rider advised the filly may appreciate improved track conditions.

HESAGOODBOY (C Burdan) - Lay out rounding the bend near the 1300 metres.

BRIAN BORU (J Parkes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

BLUE RATA ANNA (S Collett) Raced wide without cover throughout.

SENIOR PINYATA (A Collett) – Was not persevered with in the home straight when well out of contention. Rider could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have pain over the hind quarters. A veterinary clearance is required prior to starting next.

Race 9 | **NORWOOD'S TARANAKI 1650 (1650 Metres)**

STRAIGHT JACKET (C O'Beirne) - Had to be removed from the barrier after being loaded in the incorrect gate.

TOP OFTHE STRAIGHT (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

GOBUYIT (B Ansell) - Lay out in the early stages.

HE'S RIC (T Johnson) - Hung rounding the final turn and continued to lay out in the home straight.

FANTASY FLIGHT (R Elliot) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

BRAHMARAHMA (M Singh) – Had difficulty finding clear running early in the home straight.

D Turner (CHARLIE HORSE) – Dropped his whip near the 500 metres.

R Elliot (THAT'S AMORE) was charged under the Minor Infringement Schedule with a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) after being unable to make the contracted weight for THATS AMORE and was fined \$300. R Elliott was replaced by B Ansell.

THATS AMORE –Raced wide without cover throughout.

MISTER GERONIMO (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres.

VERACIOUS (C O'Beirne) – Slow away.

ROCKONEVE (J Parkes) – Slow away.

PRINCEVILLE (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly.

RUFFY RAHTWO (H Andrew) - Raced three wide throughout. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.
