RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PIAKO MITSUBISHI MAIDEN HURDLE
PYTHAGORAS (A Kuru) – Began awkwardly losing ground. CRUISEO (B Lammas) – Misjudged the first fence then knuckled on landing. Collapsed and died from natural causes (suspected heart failure) on its way back to the unsaddling area. SHOCKOOL (G Walsh) – Stumbled on landing after jumping the first fence. GOBSTOPPER (E Farr) – Misjudged the fourth fence landing awkwardly. Misjudged the final fence.	

SUMMER WARRIOR (S Phelan) – Hit the fourth to last fence landing awkwardly.

STARBRO (S Fannin) – Commenced to give ground passing the 800 metres and was pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

PADDINGTON (S Higgins) – Commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres and was pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

CABALLO NOIR (J Seivwright) – Misjudged the final two fences landing awkwardly.

Race 2	PIAKO RURAL SERVICES OPEN HURDLE
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BORNINASANDPIT (M Gillies) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HESALLJAZZ (S Higgins) – Slow to begin. Stumbled on landing after jumping the sixth fence.

RAISAFUASHO (H McNeill) – Slow to begin.

SINO HEIGHTS (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Put in a poor jump at the sixth fence landing awkwardly.

WILIJONMCBRIDE (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the third to last fence.

The connections of CLAPATHUNDA wished to view the video footage alleging interference over the concluding stages but elected not to proceed.

Race 3	FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS 2200
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POROTENE MAGNUM (F Lazet) – Slow to begin.

C Isdale (IN A MINUTE) – Was issued with a warning over his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

D Bussey (SEEMAX) – Was reminded of his obligations when riding his mounts out to the finish when circumstances permit.

TOP CHOICE (J Grundy) – Was not persevered with after becoming tailed off near the 400 metres. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4	STANISHSIGNS & GRAPHICS 2200
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SHACKELTONS EDGE (C Grylls) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

INVIGORATE (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly.

FELICITY ANNE (S McKay) – Had to steady when placed in restricted room to the inside of A SIZZLING GIRL which was taken in by BURDOCVELVETPRINCE which after commencing to over-race when being restrained had become awkwardly placed inside the heels of NESLEY, then being inclined to shift away from that runner near the 1900 metres. T Thornton was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

INVIGORATE (R Elliot) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied for a distance passing the 2000 metres making the bend awkwardly.

<p>COME DANCE WITH ME (S Spratt) – Had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of NESLEY which when improving forward shifted in when being steadied with COME DANCE WITH ME dropping back on to TWIN SPINNER which had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 1900 metres.</p> <p>TWIN SPINNER (J Riddell) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 1900 metres. Lost the left front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 5	THE SPRAY RIG MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE
<p>LUCKY FRANK (B Lammas) – Slow away. Put in a poor jump at the fifth fence.</p> <p>EPAE ROAD (N Downs) – Ran down the first two fences. Hampered by the riderless horse approaching the 1400 metres on the second occasion. Hampered prior to jumping the fence near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>BAY ROCKER (S Phelan) – Lost its footing and fell shortly after jumping the fourth fence. Both horse and rider were uninjured. Hampered were EPAE ROAD, ISTIMAGIC and WILLARE.</p> <p>ISTIMAGIC (M Roustoby) – Hampered by the riderless horse approaching the 1400 metres on the second occasion. Hampered prior to jumping the fence near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>SONTANA (S Fannin) – Received heavy contact from the riderless horse approaching the fence near the 1300 metres and fell. Both horse and rider were uninjured. Hampered as a result were ISTIMAGIC and EPAE ROAD.</p> <p>GEORGETHEFIFTH (E Farr) – Lay out rounding the bend into the final straight, and continued to shift out under pressure for the remainder of the race. Landed awkwardly after jumping the final fence. Lost the left hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 6	KNOTTINGLY FARM OPEN STEEPLECHASE
<p>After BAY ROCKER lost its footing on the flat after jumping the fence near the 600 metres in race 5, a meeting was convened with riders with several reporting issues with the footing on that section of the track leading into and leaving that fence. As a result due to safety concerns it was decided that the fence in question would be bypassed for this race.</p> <p>MAGIC WONDER (M Gillies) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>THENAMESBOND (J Seivwright) – Misjudged the third fence landing awkwardly with the rider losing the use of the left stirrup iron for a distance. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres and came under pressure shortly after, then being retired from the race after failing to respond and did not jump the final two fences.</p> <p>YIPSON (T Moki) – Lost its footing behind approaching the sixth fence.</p> <p>JUST GOT HOME (E Farr) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the second to last fence.</p> <p>ZAMORA (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the final fence.</p>	
Race 7	STALLION SERVICES SCHEME 1200
<p>CONCLUSION (A Collett) – Began awkwardly and crowded shortly after.</p> <p>TWO THIRTY (E Leighton) – Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 800 metres.</p>	
Race 8	TRAVEL ADVOCATES MAIDEN
<p>HIGH PRIORITY (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p>	

CLEVERCONVERSATION (T Thornton) – Slow to begin.

PLUSHENKO (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

ALFRED GEORGE (A Calder) – Began awkwardly.

BULLNOSE (B R Jones) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres having to be firmly restrained off heels.

Race 9

BULLSEYE DIRECT 1600

LEICA WARRIOR (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly and shifted in crowding RED JOHN, DR HANK, VAN DIAMOND and GLENDALOUGH.

RED JOHN (A Jones) – Crowded shortly after the start.

DR HANK (T Thornton) – Crowded shortly after the start.

VAN DIAMOND (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start.

GLENDALOUGH (M Coleman) – Crowded shortly after the start. When questioned into the performance rider was unable to offer any excuse for the mare's performance.

INVERNESS (T Newman) – Slow to begin.

DAM RELIABLE (D Mansour) – Slow to begin.

DARE TO COMPARE (A Goindasamy) – Lay out near the 1400 metres making contact with WAGNER forcing that runner wider. Steadied when in restricted room passing the 1200 metres.

Race 10

PIAKO RURAL SERVICES MAIDEN

KAJINO (J Kamaruddin) – Crowded shortly after the start.

IT'S NOW OR NEVER (S McKay) – Crowded shortly after the start.

MAESTRO BLU (A Goindasamy) – Crowded shortly after the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

BANKS ROAD (T Thornton) – Crowded shortly after the start.

TAHUROA HEIGHT (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly and shifted out.

ZAMAX (J Riddell) – Shifted out under pressure over the final 200 metres inconveniencing MAESTRO BLUE near the 50 metres.
