| Race 1 | RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN (1400m) |
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| <p>Trainer D Crozier was warned for late declaration of riders.</p> <p>SABOTEUR (R Hannam) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>POP DIVA (D Prastiyou) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ALBARON (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BROTHER WILL (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>NERO (K Mudhoo) – Lay inwards, despite the efforts of the rider, passing the 1000 metres placing inside runners in restricted room, continued to over race for a short distance thereafter, held up for a short distance on entering the home straight. The connections were advised that a racing manners warning would be placed on the gelding's record.</p> <p>HE'S IRISH (G Saejorhor) – Placed in restricted room approaching the 1000 metres making heavy contact with WHEREABOUTS with both runners becoming badly unbalanced and losing ground, had to be heavily restrained for a distance when becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 600 metres.</p> <p>WHEREABOUTS (J Lowry) – Badly unbalanced approaching the 1000 metres. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>CELINE (BB Hong) – Hampered approaching the 1000 metres having to shift ground outwards to avoid heels, made contact with NERO passing the 600 metres shifting outwards making firm contact with VOWS YOU MADE which was unbalanced, became awkwardly placed between runners passing the 150 metres having to be restrained and steadied off heels.</p> <p>RED MAGICIAN (B Murray) – Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SHOCK PROSPECT (K Williams) – Made the bend awkwardly approaching the 900 metres getting its head up on a number of occasions.</p> <p>VOWS YOU MADE (T Comignaghi) – Unbalanced passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>WANDERIN OVER (K Kwo) – Hampered approaching the 1000 metres, straightened passing the 150 metres when shifting inwards.</p> <p>K Kwo (WANDERIN OVER) was warned for shifting ground passing the 150 metres.</p> | |
| Race 2 | COMMODORE HOTEL& TAGGART EARTHMOVING MAIDEN (1400m) |

CEE SHARP (K Chowdhury) – Slow to begin.

COSTA RAVI (S Shinde) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

STORMBOY (J Laking) – Crowded after the start, raced keenly in the early stages, gave ground quickly passing the 400 metres with the rider not persevering with the gelding over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. The trainer reported that the gelding would be retired as a racing proposition.

FAUX PAS (T Moseley) – Crowded after the start.

TO LOVE YOU (B Murray) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

DECISION KEPT (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages, raced wide without cover throughout.

ELVA (R Hannam) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

MOUNT HERCULES (BB Hong) – Raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up, made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres shifting outwards making firm contact with RAINMAN and in consequence hampered COSTA RAVI and CEE SHARP, held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres before shifting outwards near the 450 metres causing NAZARE to be checked.

BB Hong (MOUNT HERCULES) admitted a breach of careless riding when shifting ground near the 450 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 9 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 22 June up to and including 10 July.

NAZARE (J Lowry) – Placed in restricted room approaching the 450 metres and was checked when MOUNT HERCULES shifted outwards.

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| Race 3 | BLUE STAR TAXIS BENCHMARK 65 (1400m) |
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MIDNITE KAOS (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

QUAINTRELLE (L Allpress) – Slow to begin, shifted inwards and made contact with WHISKEY IN THE JAR passing the 1200 metres with both runners over racing for some distance as a result.

L Allpress was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (B Murray) – Contacted passing the 1200 metres and over raced for some distance as a result.

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| Race 4 | NORTH CANTERBURY VETERINAY CLINICS BENCHMARK 72 (1400m) |
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FRANKIE THE FOX (J Lowry) – Restrained to the rear shortly after jumping and commenced to over race for a short distance passing the 1100 metres.

TURNCOAT (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages, bumped 100 metres when weakening. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate. Stewards will follow up with trainers in coming days.

SUGGESTIVE LOOX (K Asano) – Steadied when in restricted room and contacted a heel passing the 1200 metres with the rider being unbalanced momentarily.

AUGUSTACE (S Toolooa) – Shifted inwards passing the 1200 metres when not clear of SUGGESTIVE LOOX which was checked.

S Toolooa (AUGUSTACE) admitted a breach of careless riding shifting ground near the 1200 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 22 June up to and including 4 July.

WHAT'S UP ALF (BB Hong) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BENEFICIAL (T Moseley) – Commenced to over race and had to be restrained passing the 900 metres.

QUEEN JETSUN (K Williams) – Held up for the majority of the home straight shifting ground outwards to obtain clear running passing the 100 metres making firm contact with TURNCOAT which was weakening, went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

K Williams was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

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| Race 5 | BARNEY KNUDSEN DASH (1000m) |
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INTIMIDATE (T Comignaghi) – Proved difficult to load delaying the start.

JUST A PROMISS (B Murray) – Proved very reluctant to proceed to the barriers. A warning was placed on the filly's racing manners. Began awkwardly losing ground. The connections advised it was their intention to give the filly a spell prior to racing next.

LIGHTNING JACK (K Chowdhooory) – Slow to begin.

MAXAWAY (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

WHERE'S THE GOLD (T Jonker) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

EL GLADIADOR (C Campbell) – Inclined to lay inwards throughout the home straight having to be straightened passing the 200 metres. When spoken to regarding the performance of this favoured runner the rider reported that the gelding was less than happy on today's prevailing track conditions.

CHUCK A LUCK (L Allpress) – Lay in over the final 150 metres having to be straightened and could not be fully ridden to the line.

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| Race 6 | SONIA & GARRY THOMPSON OPEN SPRINT (1200m) |
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Trainer **A Cowan** (SIGNIFY) was warned for presenting his runner without notified gear.

SABER (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering **ISHINKTAATLEDO** which got back as a result.

DARCI MAC (R Hannam) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

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| Race 7 | OPTIMISE FERTILISERS & EQUI-LISE BENCHMARK 72 (2000m) |
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Trainers **K & A Tyler** (TILLY DUNNAGE) were warned for presenting runner without notified gear (blinkers).

ALBUT ME (S Toolooa) – Shifted inwards on jumping hampering SMILING ASSASSIN and SATIN GURU.

SMILING ASSASSIN (L Allpress) – Hampered on jumping and raced wide and keenly in the early stages.

SATIN GURU (D Prastiyoun) – Hampered on jumping.

TILLY DUNNAGE (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover passing the 1000 metres.

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| FIRE LILY (J Lowry) – Rider reminded of his obligations to ride out fully to the end of the race. | |
| Race 8 | GREENWOOD AMBERLEY CUP (1600m) |
| <p>NOMEN LUDI (T Moseley) – Fractious in the barriers. Held up on entering the home straight becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 300 metres having to steady momentarily.</p> <p>LIL MISS SWISS (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SHAKTI (K Chowdhooory) – Began awkwardly getting back.</p> <p>ELFEE (L Allpress) – Hampered between runners shortly after the start getting back.</p> <p>WHO DARES WINS (J Laking) – Shifted in on jumping hampering LIL MISS SWISS which got back. When questioned about performance the rider reported in his opinion the weight and holding nature of today's track had played a part in the performance.</p> <p>SCAPOLO (K Asano) – Raced keenly for a short distance passing the 900 metres.</p> | |
| Race 9 | SMITHS HIRE BENCHMARK 65 (1400m) |
| <p>D Bothamley (JUST ANOTHER DAY) was fined \$100 for failing to make the contracted weight and was replaced by J Laking. Stewards informed D Bothamley that he would not be allowed to take rides under 58.5 kg in the coming weeks.</p> <p>OUR BOY BAZ (BB Hong) – Got its head up on jumping and was restrained to the rear.</p> <p>MALAWI (R Beeharry) – Jumped outwards hampering VISCONTI resulting in STRAD being buffeted between runners.</p> <p>STRAD (J Lowry) – Buffeted on jumping.</p> <p>RED MAJOR (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages, placed in restricted room between runners and had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres, held up early in the home straight.</p> <p>GIFTED (T Jonker) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>ALL BLACK MAGIC (T Comignaghi) – Placed in restricted room and had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>MILK IT (B Morgenrood) – Lay inwards and had to be straightened passing the 80 metres hampering JULIETTE which was momentarily steadied.</p> <p>JULIETTE (B Murray) – Hampered passing the 80 metres.</p> <p>MERLOT (C Campbell) – The rider was advised to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.</p> <p>B Morgenrood (MILK IT) was warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> | |
| Race 10 | RACE A ZACINTO COLT @ GORACING.CO.NZ BENCHMARK 65 (2000m) |
| <p>COUNTESS RUBY (R Hannam) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ODYSSEUS (D Bothamley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SHAZ THE BANK (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, raced keenly for a distance passing the 1500 metres.</p> <p>NATHAN DETROIT (B Morgenrood) – Slow to begin.</p> | |

AHYUM (T Comignaghi) – Bumped with PABLEAU on jumping, held up on entering the home straight until gaining clear running passing the 300 metres, inconvenienced when IT’S PANDEMONIUM shifted outwards.

PABLEAU (K Kwo) – Bumped with AHYUM on jumping.

KANUMISS (L Allpress) – Raced four wide without cover.

REDESDALE (J Laking) – Gave ground passing the 1000 metres finishing in a distant last position. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up with trainer K Hampton in coming days.

IT’S PANDEMONIUM (G Saejorhor) – Lay outwards passing the 300 metres inconveniencing AHYUM.

RAWMATERIAL (B Murray) – Shifted inwards passing the 1850 metres hampering inside runners, raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres when weakening.

B Murray (RAWMATERIAL) was warned for the manner in which he shifted ground passing the 1850 metres.

KING OF THE DANCE (K Chowdhoory) – Lay inwards under pressure passing the 300 metres.

K Asano (MONDORANI) was warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

C Campbell (SLAMMER) was warned for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.
