Race 6 - Reyburn & Bryant (1200 metres)
CHIQUITITA (J Riddell) – Trainer S Ritchie advised that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare, adding that it is now his intention to remove the blinkers and freshen CHIQUITITA prior to racing next.
Race 8 - Bream Bay Painting (1600 metres)
MAGIC CONDOR (R Elliot) – Trainer S Ritchie advised that the filly has now been sent for a spell.

LOS ANGELES (T Thornton) – Co-trainer C Gibbs advised that the mare would not be persevered with as a racing proposition from their stable.

Race 1	DON GRAYLING APPRECIATION 3YO PREMIER
<p>BOTTI (M McNab) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>TUTTA LA CLASSE (J Parkes) - Slow away.</p> <p>BURGUNDY BELLE (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>SHEEZ LEICA (S Spratt) - Steadied 900 metres when awkwardly placed.</p> <p>MEDALZA (S Collett) - Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres making brief contact with ANNIE OKAY. Raced in restricted room approaching the 150 metres to the outside of BURGUNDY BELLE which lay out under pressure.</p>	
Race 2	SEEKA AONGATETE MAIDEN
<p>DR VELOCIOUS (A Collett) - Crowded leaving the barrier.</p> <p>SWAY MOON (R Smyth) - Knuckled leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>DECLARADA (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly making solid contact with HELIBERRY. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>POWALIGN (A Jones) - Crowded and checked 1300 metres. Came under pressure passing the 800 metres, then being hampered near the 650 metres when IZTAMOUR lay in.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (OUT OF THE PARK) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted OUT OF THE PARK to shift inwards passing the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of POWALIGN which was checked. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended A Goindasamy's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 29 June up to and including racing on Thursday 18 July, 8 national riding days.</p> <p>HELIBERRY (S Spratt) - Lay out rounding the final turn, continuing to lay out racing very greenly in the final straight running to the extreme outside of the track and as a result was unable to be fully ridden out by its rider. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer M Forbes advised that the mare had been suited by today's track conditions along with the step-up in distance.</p> <p>OUT OF THE PARK (A Goindasamy) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure approaching the home turn, and was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (OUT OF THE PARK) - Was fined \$250 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a charge in that he failed to ride his mount OUT OF THE PARK out to the end of the race when there was a reasonable chance of finishing in fifth placing.</p>	
Race 3	ZEST PREMIER

ANDOYAS (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DIVINE DUKE (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BACK IN A FLASH (D Danis) - Began awkwardly.

CRAFTY JESS (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly.

Race 4

SEEKA PREMIER

BATTLE TIME (C Burdan) - Shifted inwards leaving the barriers making heavy contact with JOY ANNA which became unbalanced.

JOY ANNA (D Mansour) - Contacted and unbalanced leaving the barrier. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had never felt comfortable in today's track conditions.

RESURRECT (E McCall) - Raced in restricted room leaving the barriers and was steadied.

MARS BARS (A Goindasamy) - Restrained soon after leaving the barriers.

LADYNADEL (C Grylls) - Raced wide throughout.

Race 5

DOBSONS REFRIGERATION AND ELECTRICAL PREMIER

LUPELANI (C Burdan) - Slow to begin.

COME BACK TIGER (T Newman) - Began awkwardly then crowded soon after by QUANTUM which shifted outwards shortly after leaving the barriers with COME BACK TIGER then being further crowded by POKURU WILD which was dictated in slightly by POLLY GREY which lay in and away from DUDEWITHATTITUDE which had a tendency to lay in. Lay in under pressure in the final straight with the rider advising that the gelding had had a tendency to lay in throughout the race and had not felt comfortable. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality with a small superficial wound to the left hind pastern.

TRUEMAN (C Lammas) - Rider reported that the gelding had failed to handle today's holding track conditions.

POKURU WILD (C Grylls) - Rider reported that the mare failed to handle today's track conditions.

R Smyth (GOOD VIBES) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

ORORA KIWI PACKAGING KIWIFRUIT CUP

FLYING FANTASIA (S Collett) - Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barriers losing ground.

THE KIPLING GIRL (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

C Johnson (THE KIPLING GIRL) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

D Mansour (VALANTE) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

J Riddell (BEE TEE JUNIOR) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

HIGHLAD (M Coleman) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

MEESKA MOOSKA (S Spratt) - Rider was unable to offer any excuse for poor performance. A post-race veterinary inspection found the gelding to be 2/5 lame in the left foreleg. Co-trainer G Thomas advised that MEESKA MOOSKA would now be retired.

TOMMYRA (C Burdan) - Began awkwardly.

FRANKLIN (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly.

CHARLI ROSE (D Mansour) - Began awkwardly.

MY GIFT (A Goindasamy) - Had to steady when in restricted room passing the 1700 metres to the inside of CHIEF SEQUOYAH which was taken in by JOE CARGO which lay in.

Race 8 | **ULTIMATE FORD AND MAZDA TAURANGA CLASSIC**

SENSIBLE PRINCESS (C Johnson) - Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barriers and steadied.

ROSEWOOD (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Rider reported that in her opinion the mare would be better suited over more ground.

SHELLEZ ACE (A Jones) - Began awkwardly making solid contact with SLEEPING BEAUTY.

TE TORO PEARL (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced near the 800 metres when RITANI shifted outwards to avoid heels.

A Jones (SHELLEZ ACE) - Issued with a warning for her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 9 | **BULK LINES LIMITED PREMIER**

FALKIRK LASS (D Danis) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

YAMUNA (S McKay) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

HIGH TRANQUILITY (M Coleman) - Made contact leaving the barriers with THEE AULD CRUIZER.

MOET MOLLY (A Goindasamy) - Briefly crowded passing the 350 metres.

SURE BET (T Thornton) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.
