RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	\$60K OAMARU CUP BONUS 1400m
<p>RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT (D Prastiyau) – Began awkwardly and was further hampered when awkwardly placed on the heels of TRUDEAU shortly after the start.</p> <p>TRUDEAU (J Lowry) – Attempted to buck shortly after the start.</p> <p>WIZE ACT (T Moseley) – Raced keenly in the early stages due to the lack of tempo, inconvenienced passing the 50 metres when SELFIE lay out and away from TRUDEAU.</p> <p>SELFIE (J Laking) – Blundered passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>ZAWHIP (BB Hong) – Lost a racing plate passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>Following the race Stewards inspected an area of the track where SELFIE blundered and after consulting riders it was unanimously agreed to continue.</p>	
Race 2	NORTH STAR BAR, RESTAURANT & ACCOMMODATION MAIDEN 1200m
<p>ARNAGE (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly losing ground, got its head up when over racing for a distance passing the 1000 metres, raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TO SIR WITH LOVE (K Kwo) – Crowded at the start and lost ground, began to over race passing the 1000 metres and clipped a heel and blundered passing the 800 metres losing momentum.</p> <p>PURE CLASS (T Moseley) – Raced greenly in the early stages.</p> <p>OPHELIA ROSE (C Campbell) – Inconvenienced just short of the finishing post when FOGGY LYTTLE shifted in at this point.</p>	
Race 3	FRED MUIR MEMORIAL 2200m
<p>SWEET TIME - S Toolooa replaced T Jonker who was unable to make the contracted weight.</p> <p>SQUIZZY (BB Hong) – Restrained to the rear on jumping, made contact with DOWRY DUTY rounding the bend near the 400 metres.</p> <p>COME FLY WITH ME (K Kwo) – Had to be steadied after improving to become awkwardly placed inside the heels of PRINCESS EL JAY near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>DOWRY DUTY (R Beeharry) – Bumped rounding the bend.</p>	
Race 4	WHITE ACRES FISHING MAIDEN 2200m
<p>HEY MICKEY (B Murray) – Blundered leaving the barriers hampering WENTWORTH, over raced entering the back straight having to be steadied off the heels of the runner in front.</p> <p>WENTWORTH (D Prastiyau) – Hampered at start.</p> <p>RAISE YOUR SIGHTS (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin, lay in early in the run home and had to be straightened with the rider then swapping the whip to the left hand.</p> <p>MACPAC (S Toolooa) – Had to be steadied away from heels shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>NIFTY (T Jonker) – Raced wide through the early stages and made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly shifting wider on the track for a short distance.</p> <p>STEELE CANYON (J Laking) – Raced wide without cover through the early stages.</p> <p>ELIZA LONG (K Asano) – Gave ground passing the 800 metres finishing in a distance last placing. Rider advised that the mare had over raced early but when the pace of the race quickened had been left flat footed and had been under pressure from the 1000 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.</p>	

D Prastiyou (WENTWORTH) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.	
Race 5	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200m
<p>WHITNEY (K Asano) was a late scratching at 2.50 pm after bolting for a full lap when the rider lost both stirrup irons which became detached from the saddle.</p> <p>COLETTE (B Murray) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>KNOWN TO FLIRT (J Laking) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>ZAYZAY (K Kwo) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>MIROSLAVA (R Beeharry) – Lay in passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened, and again passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>MIMIMAC (S Toolooa) – Lay out throughout the running. Stewards questioned the rider regarding his tactics particularly through the early and middle stages when taking on the leader STARMAKER. S Toolooa advised he had been instructed to lead however the mare had hung outwards when he had got outside the leader and therefore any attempt to give his runner respite became difficult due to the horse hanging so badly. Stewards advised Mr Toolooa that he had erred on this occasion and was expected to show better judgement in future.</p> <p>K Asano admitted a breach of the rules in that he incorrectly attached his leathers to his saddle which resulted in the leathers breaking during the preliminary. After hearing evidence the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$100 and ordered that the riding fee be forfeited.</p>	
Race 6	SPORTS CENTRAL BREW HOUSE MAIDEN 1600m
<p>DIPLOMAT (T Moseley) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after making contact with the gate leaving the birdcage and was cleared to race. Shifted in under pressure making contact with GRAND EXPRESS near the 150 metres and again making contact with that runner inside the final 50 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of BATTLE MAN.</p> <p>OUR ROYAL (B Morgenrood) – Jumped away awkwardly, hampered near the 1400 metres, held up in the run home until the 100 metres.</p> <p>MACKTAVISH (J Laking) – Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground when FINE AND DANDEE jumped inwards.</p> <p>LAST LETTER (T Jonker) – Had to be restrained off heels when over racing going into the bend near the 1400 metres and then further hampered when STOP MAKING SENSE shifted inwards when being steadied away from the heels of BATTLE MAN and as a consequence hampering OUR ROYAL who had improved to the inside of LAST LETTER.</p> <p>BATTLE MAN (B Murray) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>GRAND EXPRESS (C Johnson) – Bumped near the 150 metres and again inside the final 50 metres.</p>	
Race 7	BREWCO BRANDING 1600m
<p>SOUTHERN JAZZ (K Kwo) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, raced wide from the 600 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse.</p> <p>GOLDEN VALKYRIE (K Asano) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BET YA WOOD (R Hannam) – Slow to begin, raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>DERMOT (T Moseley) – Severely checked near the 150 metres when GOLDEN VALKYRIE was forced inwards by DREAM RICH which ducked inwards abruptly after making slight contact with RAFF.</p> <p>T Jonker (STELLACANTO) – Spoken to advisedly in regards to whip use above shoulder height.</p>
