RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WAIPA HOME OF CHAMPIONS 1150
BELLE OF GEORGIA (M McNab) - Dislodged jockey M McNab, who was uninjured, during its preliminary taking some time to be recaptured. BELLE OF GEORGIA underwent under a veterinary examination and was cleared fit to start. Hung outwards racing wide on the track throughout.	
TARINGAMOTU (D Mansour) – Steadied shortly after jumping away when in restricted room.	
BELLE SOUTH (S McKay) – Steadied shortly after jumping away when in restricted room.	

WICKED WOMAN (R Smyth) – Steadied shortly after jumping away when in restricted room.

PORSHABELLE (T Thornton) – Received veterinary attention after the filly was found to have traces of blood inside its nostrils which were from a small laceration.

NU ROUGE (S Spratt) – Crowded and checked 800 metres.

RAZ – (C Grylls) – Hampered 800 metres.

LEAF (J Riddell) - Hampered 800 metres.

E McCall admitted a breach of careless riding in that she allowed SLEEPY GEEG to shift in when not sufficiently clear of NU ROUGE which was crowded and checked going back onto RAZ which had to steady and also LEAF which also had to be firmly restrained. After viewing films and hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended E McCall's licence to ride at race meetings from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 23 June up to and including Saturday 29th June inclusive, 4 National riding days.

Race 2 | **VILAGRAD WINERY 1150**

HEAVY NOVA (S McKay) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ROCK STAR ROSIE (S Collet) – Slow away.

PICTURE THIS (M McNab) – Slow away.

HOT AUGUST NIGHT (R Scott) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

Race 3 | **FAIRVIEW MOTORS 1400**

TUMBRIL (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly losing ground before being ridden urgently to recover.

CASTLEPOINT (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ROC IN STYLE (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

AMASECOYA (S Collett) - Became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 600 metres losing ground.

Race 4 | **GARRARD'S HORSE & HOUND 2000**

CASTLEBACK (R Elliot) -Slow away.

A SIZZLING GIRL (D Mansour) - Shifted out after jumping away making contact with KING OF COOL which was crowded and steadied losing ground.

KING OF COOL (J Riddell) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MR SKALLYWAG (M Cameron) - Made the crossing awkwardly forcing THE FLYING FLYNN and GOCARA and CRAIGFIEVAR wider on the track.

GOCARA (T Thornton) - Forced wide 1500 metres.

FLYINGFLYNN (S Spratt) - Forced wide 1500 metres.

GINGEE (J Fawcett) – Knuckled and fell passing the 800 metres. Video footage of the incident proved inconclusive with evidence taken from riders including J Fawcett, stating that GINGEE was free of interference when the incident occurred. Hampered as a result were PADDINGTON and CAPE CEILIDH. Following the fall GINGEE received veterinary attention and was found to have abrasions of the left nostrils. Rider J Fawcett sustained a suspected right arm injury.

PADDINGTON (E McCall) - Hampered 800 metres.

CAPE CEILIDH (N Alam) - Hampered 800 metres.

Following this race a delegation of Jockeys and Officials undertook an inspection of the area where the incident occurred and was found to be inconsistent. After speaking with riders, Trainers and Club Officials it could not be determined that the state of the track had not caused or contributed to the fall. After further discussions it was decided that the meeting could not continue with the race meeting being abandoned at 1.40pm.
