RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	IPL PLYWOOD MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE (3200 Metres)
GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (S Karnicnik) - Jumped indifferently in the early stages unbalancing the rider at the first fence, blundered on landing at the second last fence briefly unbalancing the rider.	

MR ENTHUSIASTIC (E Farr) - Jumped high at the fence near the 2100 and blundered on landing, got in close to the fence near the 1250 losing ground.

SPITHILL (I Lupton) - Jumped awkwardly at the fence near the 1600m metres.

EDDIE GILBERT (S Fannin) - Hit the second last fence.

ZEDEEDUDADEEKO (B Lammas) – When questioned into performance rider advised that the gelding which was having its first steeplechase was not entirely comfortable in today's track conditions (Heavy 11). A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

WHO CAN TELL (T Moki) – When questioned regarding improved performance Trainer K Myers advised the gelding had improved at two recent point to points.

Race 2	PASLODE MAIDEN HURDLE (2800 Metres)

MR INK (N Downs) - Got his head in the air in the early stages when being restrained.

SO KEEP EM (T Moki) - Blundered on landing at the fence near the 2100 metres, hit the second last fence blundering and unbalancing the rider.

QUAFF (E Farr) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

VILLA NINE (B Lammas) - Pulled up prior to the second last fence when out of contention.

THE COSSACK (A Kuru) - Hit the second last fence.

TITTLETATTLE (J Seivwright) - Jumped the second last fence awkwardly.

LOVETOKEEPHIM (S Fannin) - When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had been disappointing but could offer no explanation. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3	MANAWATI ITM AWAPUNI HURDLES (2900 Metres)

GALLANTE (M Gillies) - Hit the fence near the 2200 metres, hit the second last fence.

ZARTAN (M Cropp) – Hit the fence near the 1100 metres unbalancing the rider.

CLASS ABOVE (S Fannin) - Hit the fence near the 900 metres and fell bringing down EL CORBY which was unable to avoid the fallen runner. Also hampered were ALFIE DEE, THATZ DAVID, MAX and WEE BISKIT. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

EL CORBY (G Walsh) - Brought down near the 900 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a minor laceration to the left hind cannon.

Riders **S Fannin** and **G Walsh** were examined by paramedics and cleared to ride.

ALFIE DEE (A Kuru) - Hampered at the 900 metres. Scrambled over the last fence.

THATZ DAVID (S Karnicnik) -Hampered near the 900 metres.

MAX (I Lupton) - Hampered near the 900 metres.

WEE BISKIT (B Lammas) - Hampered near the 900 metres.	
Race 4	REDSTAG OPEN HANDICAP (1500 Metres)
<p>PLATINUM COMMAND (J Parkes) - Slow away.</p> <p>DEZ (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages shifting in abruptly near the 1400 metres contacting OUR BANDIT.</p> <p>OUR BANDIT (C O’Beirne) – Bumped near the 1400 metres.</p> <p>ITSALLBELT (M Hudson) - Gave ground quickly approaching the 600 metres and was not persevered with over the final stages. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>DE GAULLE (C Johnson) - Briefly held up near the 350 metres, lay in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>D BRADLEY (CAPE DU JEU) was issued with a warning under [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] with respect to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>L ALLPRESS (DEZ) Was spoken to with regards to her whip use in the home straight.</p>	
Race 5	LJ HOOKER MANAWATU STEEPLCHASE (4200 Metres)
<p>DES DE JEU (A Kuru) – Raced keenly in the early stages, misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres on the first occasion unbalancing the rider who was dislodged.</p> <p>JOKING (G Walsh) - Blundered at the fence near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>I’VE GOT THIS (S Fannin) – Pulled up prior to the second last fence when out of contention.</p> <p>KINGS KITE (S Karnicnik) – Pulled up prior to the second last fence when out of contention.</p> <p>ZEDACE (S Phelan) –Off hind bandage became loose during the running, blundered on landing at the second last fence.</p>	
Race 6	TASMAN INSULATION PINK FIT (1200 Metres)
<p>TABARD (H Durrant) – Slow away.</p> <p>RUFUS RUFFCUT (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly settling back.</p> <p>THAT’S FUNNY (R Hannam) – Momentarily dipped and went off stride near the 350 metres.</p> <p>WHATSUP (H Andrew) - Shifted in under pressure over the final stages, briefly tightening COLORADO BAY near the finish. H Andrew was advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.</p> <p>COLORADO BAY (M Singh) Tightened over the final stages.</p>	
Race 7	NELSON PINE INDUSTRIES 1600 (1600 Metres)
<p>TIRO (C Johnson) – Slow away.</p> <p>LEADING ROLE (R Hannam) - Tightened at the start when TIPPERARY MARY began awkwardly, bumping and dictating MAGIC IVAN into its line.</p>	

MAGIC IVAN (S McKay) -Bumped at start.

TOOK THE CATCH (D Bradley) – Went amiss approaching the 400 metres with the rider having some difficulty restraining the gelding. **TOOK THE CATCH** was subsequently attended to by veterinary staff and humanely euthanised after sustaining a sesamoid injury.

TIPPERARY MARY (D Hirini) – Hampered near the 400 metres when **TOOK THE CATCH** went amiss. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare had never travelled in the Heavy 11 track conditions.

THATS AMORE (C O’Beirne) Began awkwardly settling back

NITRO TED (H Schofer) – Slow away

COLORADO MISS (B Ansell) - Slow away, restrained off heels near the 900 metres.

ESTEFANIA (D Hirini) - Raced keenly when in front in the early stages.

SNOWFALL (J Parkes) - Gave ground approaching the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly had not appreciated today’s testing track conditions.

E WRIGHT (MY MAGICIAN) – Was spoken to with regards his whip use on a runner out of contention.
