## **RACE COMMENTS:**

#### Race 1 PHAR LAP RACEWAY HURDLES 3000m

Stewards permitted **S Phelan** to ride 2.5 kg over weight due to no other jumps rider being available.

**KEYBOARD WARRIOR – S Phelan** replaced N Downs due to transport difficulties.

**ADDITUP** (S Karnicnik) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages, lay inwards approaching the fence near the 100 metres having to be straightened.

**TEDDYTWINKLETOES** (J Seivwright) Poor leap at fence by the 2000 metres, poor leap at fence by the 1000 metres

**CASHEL** (S Higgins) – Placed in restricted room after jumping the second fence having to be restrained. Hampered by fallen runner after jumping the 3<sup>rd</sup> fence. Made a faulty leap by the fence near the 1000 metres.

**THE BIEBER** (L Douglas) – Put in a poor leap at the 3<sup>rd</sup> fence falling and dislodging the rider. Rider L Douglas was transported to Timaru Hospital with concussion and a suspected broken collar bone. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to have suffered a neck injury which will require a certificate of fitness prior to racing next.

**KEYBOARD WARRIOR** (S Phelan) – Retired from the event after jumping the 3<sup>rd</sup> fence and being badly hampered by the fallen runner. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Due to the fallen rider being attended to on the track the race was redirected around this fence on the second occasion.

**DOCTOR EDEN** (G Walsh) – Made heavy contact with the fence near the 200 metres when tiring and well back in the running..

**SHEEZOFF** (T Moki) Badly hampered by fallen runner passing the 2400 metres.

## Race 2 LJ HOOKER GROUP MAIDEN 1200m

**NATURAL GLOW** (R Beeharry) – Proved very difficult to load and eventually late scratched at 12.25 pm when refusing to enter the gates. The connections were advised that the filly must attend official barrier trials prior to racing next.

The start was delayed over two minutes due to the late scratching.

**SECRETARIA** (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly shifting out and hampering TRICK with both runners losing ground.

**TRICK** (T Moseley) – Hampered at the start losing ground.

GAS CRAIC (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

**BLOOMING FAST** (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards hampering POP DIVA.

**POP DIVA** (D Prastiyou) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

**BLUE** (S Shinde) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**RUBY NOIR** (K Mudhoo) – Made contact with the running rail passing the 700 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced, inclined to lay inwards over the concluding stages and had to be straightened over the last 20 metres.

**FIRE KATYUSHA** (C Campbell) – Lay inwards passing the 350 metres having to be straightened.

## Race 3 SHAWEIGH MAIDEN1200m

**HEARTOHEART** (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

WYNMOORE (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

MORRIGONE (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

**MR DELMO** (S Toolooa) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider was advised he should show better judgement in future.

WARNING BIRD (R Beeharry) Shifted outwards and away from inside runner near the 220 metres.

**BUSTER BOLT** (T Moseley) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 800 metres. Lay outwards and away from WARNING BIRD passing the 200 metres making contact with CELINE which was unbalanced momentarily. When questioned about performance rider reported that in his opinion the gelding had raced keenly in a fresh state and would take natural improvement from the race.

**CELINE** (K Mudhoo) – Unbalanced momentarily passing the 200 metres.

**SAYA DATANG** (L Allpress) – Rider reported on return to scale that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the final stages. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in its right hind leg with the connections advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

**DRAGON GLASS** (K Chowdhoory) – Trainer reported that the mare had lost the left front plate during the running.

## Race 4 EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES STEEPLES 4280m

**EION** was a late scratching at 12.14 pm due to no suitable replacement rider being available.

PADDY OWEN - S Higgins replaced N Downs (transport difficulties).

**PADDY OWEN** (S Higgins) – Made a poor leap at the fence passing the 3500 metres unbalancing the rider for a distance. Hampered from outside after jumping the second last fence.

**ADEQUACY** (S Karnickik) – Made the first bend awkwardly having to be restrained, collided with DELACROIX after jumping the fence passing the 2000 metres with both riders becoming unbalanced, had a tendency to jump inwards at its fences and when jumping the second last fence inconvenienced IRISH DUDE, jumped inwards again at the last fence making contact with IRISH DUDE with rider S Karnicnik becoming badly unbalanced for a distance.

**GO GO GONZO** ()G Walsh) – Made a poor leap at the fence near the 2400 metres and again at the fence by the 600 metres.

**DELACROIX** (S Phelan ) – Collided with ADEQUACY after jumping the fence passing the 2000 metres with both riders becoming unbalanced.

**IRISH DUDE** (T Moki) – Made a poor leap at the fence by the 1200 metres. Hampered when contacted from outside runner after jumping the second last fence.

**REGALO REAAL** (J Seivwright) – Mixed its jumping throughout and was pulled up near the 600 metres.

### Race 5 ONCEUPONATIME SPRINT 1200m

MISS BRAHMOS (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

**HAPPY HITTER** (C Johnson) – Placed in restricted room passing the 900 metres, over raced passing the 600 metres and held up until having to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

VICE MARSHALL (K Chowdhoory) Lay inwards near the 300 metres and had to be straightened.

**ZAYZAY** (K Kwo) – Over raced making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

**THOM BROWN** (B Murray) Became awkwardly placed inside heels near the 300 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

Following this race **A Bohorun** (OPIO ROSE) became unwell and was attended to by St John Paramedics and stood down for the remainder of his riding engagements. A Bohorun was advised that a medical clearance must be provided to NZ Thoroughbred Racing prior to riding next.

# Race 6 CATERING SOUTH CANTERBURY DASH 1200m

PRAWN STAR – K Chowdhoory was replaced by S Toolooa due to a misunderstanding.

**DON'T BE CHEEKY – K Chowdhoory** replaced A Bohorun (unwell).

**AMOUR LA VIE** (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Held up passing the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

MELBOURNE BORN (K Williams) – Blundered on jumping getting back.

PARK RANGER (K Mudhoo) - Raced keenly in the early stages, raced three wide throughout.

ST REGIS (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**DON'T BE CHEEKY** ( K Chowdhoory) – Held up throughout the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

**SUGGESTIVE LOOX** (K Asano) – When questioned regarding the improved performance, trainer A Carston advised that the mare had been favoured by a positive ride, being closer to the pace, and added that the mare was also aided by the claim today.

## Race 7 MORE FM MILE 1600m

JILDI JILDI - C Campbell replaced A Bohorun (unwell).

**THE STYLE** (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

MONZA CIRCUITO (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

**RICH HABIT** (S Toolooa) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**TUILANA** (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When spoken to regarding the improved performance, trainer N Coulbeck advised that the mare was back on a favoured track with distance and conditions to suit.

**OUR TEDDY BOY** (K Chowdhoory ) – Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

NESTA (J Laking) - Held up early stages of home straight.

**JILDI JILDI** (C Campbell) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres having to steady and shift ground outwards to find clear running.

## Race 8 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600m

**RELIABLE GLOW** (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

**METASEQUOIA** (R Beeharry) – Restrained to the rear on jumping. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities. Stewards questioned R Beeharry in the presence of his employer B Tapper in regards to his lack of urgency when losing ground on the field passing the 800 metres .Mr Beeharry stated he had had been uncomfortable with the kick back at this stage having to put his head down after receiving a clod to the face adding also the mare was uncomfortable and reluctant to trail up behind runners. Stewards reprimanded R Beeharry advising better judgement must be shown in future and instructed him not to leave his rides open to query.

MISS TANIRA (C Campbell ) Steadied passing the 1300 metres.

**SAINTED PEARL** (J Laking) – Over raced and steadied passing the 1300 metres.

**ELANA ROSE** (S Shinde) – Over raced in the early stages and had to be heavily restrained when awkwardly placed inside heels passing the 1300 metres Continued to be steadied for some distance when racing ungenerously.. Rider warned for using the whip with his hand above shoulder height.

**GLOSS** (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages.
