RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 RANGIORA NEW WORLD MAIDEN (1100m)

CLOONEY (J Lowry) which was very fractious in its barrier underwent a pre race veterinary inspection and was declared a late scratching at 2.42 pm. The connections were advised that a vet clearance is required prior to racing next.

PARIS AWAITS (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

REMEDY (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MAH GIRL (R Beeharry) – Shifted out at the start making firm contact with VOUCH.

VOUCH (R Hannam) – Contacted at the start.

GRAND EXPRESS (C Johnson) – Fractious in the barriers, raced wide throughout, lay out rounding the bend near the 600 metres making the bend awkwardly and having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

ABRAHAMS (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages with the saddle shifting backwards shortly after jumping.

SHARP 'N' SILVER (T Mosley) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 2 GAVELHOUSE.COM MAIDEN (1100m)

MISS THUNDERBIRD (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly unbalancing the rider and further hampered between runners getting back as a result, raced fiercely thereafter having to be restrained for a distance.

FROSTED (C Johnson) – Firmly contacted after jumping.

CHORISTER (K Mudhoo) – Shifted in and made firm contact with FROSTED after jumping.

SPUR ROAD (R Beeharry) – Awkwardly placed between heels after jumping getting back as a result, raced keenly in the early stages.

MISS DOLCE VITA (T Moseley) – Buffeted between runners after jumping. Rider reported the mare to be indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DECISION KEPT (L Allpress) – Made the bend near the 650 metres awkwardly having to be straightened.

RAFF (K Kwo) – Raced greenly in the home straight shifting in abruptly across heels approaching the 200 metres.

Race 3 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO RATING 65 (1200m)

MAGIC NOTE (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

XPRESSMYMIND (K Asano) – Slow to begin, steadled for a distance passing the 500 metres and held up in the early stages of the run home.

TRUDEAU (BB Hong) – Shifted out abruptly at the start, held up for a distance passing the 175 metres obtaining clear running passing the 100 metres.

OUR FOREMAN (K Kwo) – Buffeted and unbalanced shortly after the start when STELLA DAZE shifted out after jumping.

MORWEKA (B Murray) – Buffeted and unbalanced shortly after the start when STELLA DAZE shifted out after jumping, steadied for a distance passing the 500 metres.

WHY ME (B Morgenrood) – Made contact with FASCINO LASS when attempting a marginal run passing the 350 metres.

B Morgenrood (WHY ME) was warned for failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish. [Rule 636(1)(b)]

SMOKE HOUSE BAY (L Allpress) – Held up when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 250 metres.

ATTIMO (T Jonker) – Underwent a post race veterinary inspection after being galloped on during the running which revealed superficial abrasions to the left hind leg, with no veterinary attention required.

Following this race the track was upgraded to Good (3).

Race 4 SKELTON BROTHERS OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)

ENZO'S LAD (K Chowdhoory) – When being restrained on jumping shifted in crowding MONTOYA STAR with both runners getting back as a result.

MR TYPHON (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly.

BALLYBAY (B Murray) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

HE KIN FLY (T Moseley) – Raced wide throughout.

M Kareem (MONTOYA STAR) admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

S Jamie (VOLCANO) was reminded of her obligations in regard to whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 5 SWIMSENSE SWIMATHON MAIDEN (1600m)

PRODUCER (T Jonker) – Slow to begin, raced wide from the 900 metres.

SHE'S GALLANT (R Mudhoo) – Bounded at the start and got back.

MR INSANITY (R Hannam) – Slow to begin.

STRATTON (C Johnson) – Raced wide in the early stages, held up turning for home.

PER FORM (J Morris) – Over raced in the early stages, raced in restricted room for some distance passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of CINNAMON KISS (G Saejorhor) which shifted in.

G Saejorhor (CINNAMON KISS) was issued with a warning for shifting ground passing the 1200 metres.

CINNAMON KISS (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide throughout.

REALM (C Campbell) – Awkwardly placed on heels when FREIGHT TRAIN JANE (B Murray) shifted in passing the 900 metres. B Murray was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

TE MOKOPUNA (T Moseley) – Held up early in the run home.

LUNAR LADY (K Chowdhoory) – Held up for a short distance passing the 300 metres.

FREIGHT TRAIN JANE (B Murray) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres when LUNAR LADY shifted outwards.

K Chowdhoory (LUNAR LADY) was issued with a warning for shifting ground passing the 250 metres.

Race 6

RAY SHARPE MEMORIAL MAIDEN (1600m)

BANNOCK (C Johnson) – Slow to begin

CEE SHARP (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin, raced in restricted room rounding the home turn making contact with MUSEE D'ORSAY.

TACKTHEFLAG (R Hannam) – Slow to begin.

BROTHER WILL (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

NAUGHTY NANA (K Asano) – Got its head up shortly after the start and got back.

ALTAMENTE (J Lowry) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

ART OF GOLD (S Muniandy) – Made firm contact with DREAMTESTA passing the 1200 metres. S Muniandy was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

SENTITO (L Allpress) – Contacted UPSCALE at the 160 metres when both runners shifted ground.

UPSCALE (B Murray) – Contacted SENTITO passing the 160 metres when both runners shifted ground.

The connections of 2nd placed SENTITO viewed the films before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 7

JENNIAN HOMES CANTERBURY NORTH RATING 72 (1800m)

FORGED (R Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages, held up passing the 350 metres when attempting a marginal run between runners, further held up passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on heels. Rider dropped his whip passing the 50 metres.

IVAN KANE (L Allpress) – Over raced in the early stages.

SHEZATOUCHA (G Jogoo) – Got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

SOUTHERN SAV (B Morgenrood) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages, gave ground from the 700 metres.

FEROCIOUS (K Mudhoo) – Awkwardly placed on heels of the tiring runner passing the 600 metres and shifted outwards.

PICKUP (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout.

ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN (C Johnson) – Raced in restricted room through the middle stages of the run home, came together with SHANZINO passing the 150 metres.

SHANZINO (K Chowdhoory) – Made contact with ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN passing the 150 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels and having to steady as a result.

YAMATO NADESHIKO (T Jonker) – Shifted ground inwards passing the 120 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 8

DUNSTAN FEEDS 1500 CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER RATING 72 (1400m)

SHOWPIN (J Morris) – Very slow to begin.

PAT IN BRACKETS (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

THE REAL DEAL (BB Hong) – Got its head up on a number of occasions through the early stages, raced wide for the majority of the race.

RESPIN (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

MILK IT (G Saejorhor) - Raced wide throughout.

PINUP COUP (K Chowdhoory) – Lay inwards passing the 300 metres placing MADAM SWISS in restricted room which in turn made contact with SHE'S A RIPPER which had to steady.

MADAM SWISS (K Asano) – Raced in restricted room near 300 metres. Made contact with SHE'A RIPPER 200 metres laying inwards despite riders efforts.

SHE'S A RIPPER (B Murray) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 200 metres.

DIORISSIMO (C Campbell) – Was not afforded clear running throughout the final straight.

Race 9 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1600m)

QUAINTRELLE (C Campbell) – Slow to begin, lay inwards early in the home straight under pressure, raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

GLOSS (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly.

LADY BYRON (R Hannam) – Blundered badly on jumping getting back as a result.

BILBAO (J Lowry) – Raced wide without cover, buffeted on entering the home straight.

HIGHLY XCITED (T Moseley) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres when making the bend awkwardly, had to be restrained for some distance rounding the final bend. The rider reported that the stop start nature of today's race did not suit the gelding.

LETSBRINGITON (S Muniandy) – Buffeted on entering the home straight between BILBAO and IWO JIMA.

THOM BROWN (C Johnson) – Held up early in the run home.

PAMIR (R Mudhoo) – Held up throughout the home straight shifting ground outwards passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

IWO JIMA (K Mudhoo) – Buffered on entering the home straight, lay inwards passing the 350 metres with the rider swapping whip hands.

BB Hong (JOBY) was reminded of his obligations in regard to whip use on a runner out of contention.
