After hearing submissions, the Committee dismissed this request on the grounds that there had been no material change in track conditions since the scratching deadline. G Vile then scratched his remaining three runners and admitted a breach of Rule 534 (1) G Vile was fined the sum of \$350.

<p>CLASSCLOWN (D Turner) - Restrained off heels near the 1,100 metres.</p> <p>THE REVENANT (R Elliot) - Disappointed finishing well back. When questioned R Elliot advised the gelding was unsuited to the very testing conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.</p> <p>T JOHNSON (MASTER BLACK JACK) – Was observed to relax his ride over the final stages. When questioned T Johnson advised he was feeling the effects of the flu and was unable to ride his mount out over the final stages. T Johnson was stood down for his remaining rides and will require a medical certificate prior to riding next.</p>

<p>TALLYHO TWINKLETOE (T Moki) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	
Race 3	B CONNORS FAMILY CLAN MDN 3YO 1600m
<p>HALFASIXPENCE (M Hudson) – Awkwardly away and settled back.</p> <p>EISENHOWER (S McKay) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 1,400 metres.</p> <p>LAVA ROCK (R Elliot) - When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding did not appreciate today's Heavy 11 track conditions. Trainer L Latta advised LAVA ROCK would now be sent for a spell.</p> <p>JAKKIFROMTHENAKI (S Collett) – When questioned into the performance rider advised the filly was unsuited to today's heavy track.</p>	
Race 4	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE F&M 1340m
<p>FULL SWING (D Hirini) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after making contact with the rail in the enclosure and was cleared to start. Finished well back. Trainer advised the mare would now be sent for a spell.</p> <p>STYLE BY DESIGN (S McKay) - Began awkwardly settling back. Lay in under pressure over the final stages.</p> <p>ALLURE (M Singh) – Tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p>LADY RUDOLPH (S Collett) - When questioned into the performance rider advised the mare had not handled today's Heavy11 track conditions.</p> <p>SAVANAH BELLE (L Allpress) - When questioned into the performance rider advised the filly was unsuited to today's Heavy11 track conditions.</p>	
Race 5	GUDELL CLAN 1200m
<p>SAPPHIRE SKY (H Andrew) - Began awkwardly settling back.</p> <p>BROTHER ONE (S Macnab) - Restrained from an inside draw before being angled outwards across heels in search of better footing wide on the track.</p> <p>H Andrew was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) with regards her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	

Race 6	THE WHANGAEHU O'LEARYS MDN 1200m
<p>MAGIC INCANTO - T Johnson was initially replaced by D Turner who subsequently advised that he would be unable to make the weight, as there were no suitable senior replacements connections were given permission for Apprentice H Andrew to take the mount.</p> <p>QUEEN OF FIRE (J Baillie) - Tightened at the start settling back.</p> <p>DOLCE AMORE (C Burdan) - Raced keenly in the early stages then inconvenienced near the 1,000 metres.</p> <p>M SINGH (GREAT NORTH ROAD) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) after allowing his mount to shift inwards near the 1,000 metres when not entirely clear of DOLCE AMORE which was inconvenienced.</p> <p>HE'S DONE A RUNNER (J Parkes) - When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding had been unsuited to today's Heavy11 track conditions.</p> <p>J Baillie (QUEEN OF FIRE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.</p>	
Race 7	MOORE-MCKINNON CLAN MDN 2040m
<p>WHO BOY (D Hirini) – Began awkwardly then raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>COG KNISH (H Andrew) – Rider dropped her whip near the 350 metres.</p> <p>PASSING GLANCE (R Elliot) – Was not persevered with in the home straight when well out of contention. Rider advised the mare had ben unsuited by today's Heavy 11 track conditions.</p> <p>KION (S McKay) – When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding had not appreciated today's Heavy 11 track conditions.</p>
