Race 1	MAXWELTON PONY STUD & BLAIR-EDIE GENETICS MAIDEN 1840m
<p>BELLISSIMA BELLE (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ELIZA LONG (K Asano) – Began awkwardly losing its footing and getting back.</p> <p>ROULETTE (T Jonker) – Raced wide early. Buffeted and unbalanced at the 150 metres losing ground.</p>	

HEY MICKEY (B Murray) – Made the first bend awkwardly getting its head up. Crowded and had to steady at the 175 metres when WANDERIN OVER lay inwards at this point.

WANDERIN OVER (K Kwo) – Lay in passing the 175 metres crowding inside runner having to be straightened.

ACRE (J Fawcett) – Race wide without cover from the 1200 metres. Checked passing the 75 metres.

FINE AND DANDEE (G Saejorhor) – Held up passing the 400 metres. Shifted outwards passing the 100 metres forcing WENTWORTH outwards onto outside runners. Continued to shift outwards over the concluding stages.

ICEBREAKER (C Campbell) – Buffeted and unbalanced at the 150 metres. Crowded by inside runners and forced outwards passing the 100 metres.

NIFTY (T Comignaghi) – Shifted out crowding outside runners passing the 150 metres. Crowded and buffeted by inside runners passing the 100 metres having to steady.

WENTWORTH (D Bothamley) – Buffeted and forced outwards passing the 125 metres.

PAINTED ANGEL (J Laking) – When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer M Price reported that the gelding had been favoured today by the even tempo of the race adding that the gelding had also been favoured by being able to improve in the clear.

T Comignaghi (NIFTY) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that she angled her mount out passing the 150 metres crowding and checking ROULETTE and ICEBREAKER. The JCA imposed a suspension of her licence from 10th of June up to and including 19th June (6 Days)

G Saejorhor (FINE AND DANDEE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards crowding and buffeting outside runners passing the 125 metres continuing to shift out checking ACRE passing the 75 metres. The JCA imposed a suspension of his licence from the 10th of June up to and including 21st June (8 Days)

Trainers T & L Prendergast (BERNINI) – Fined \$50 for presenting their runner with the incorrect number.

FASCINO LASS (T Moseley) – Trainers L & R Didham issued with a warning when presenting their runner to race without notified gear namely Pre Race Ear Covers.

HEAVEN KNOWS (C Johnson) – Slow to begin.

ZAYZAY (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly. Got its head up when being restrained passing the 1000 metres. Again had to be restrained away from heels passing the 300 metres.

HAPPY HITTER (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

COLLETTE (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide throughout with the rider reporting the mare had hung throughout.

EPIC DREAMER (A Bohorun) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

OMAR (R Beeharry) – Rider dropped whip passing the 200 metres.

WHY ME (T Jonker) – Was obliged to improve very wide round the final turn.

IFFIDA (K Chowdhooory) – Lay out passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

BERNINI (C Campbell) – When questioned about the performance the rider reported that he had been obliged to race three wide with cover and in his opinion the stop start nature of the race had been detrimental to his chances.

MIROSLAVA (G Saejorhor) – Slow to begin.

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) – Raced keenly early stages and made the first bend awkwardly having to be steadied.	
PIPPY REA (T Comignaghi) – Was obliged to race wide without cover early and middle stages.	
Race 4	WAIMATE SELF STORAGE MAIDEN 1200m
JUST TICKETY BOO (T Moseley) – Fractious in the barriers. Raced keenly early stages. Made the bend by the 800 metres awkwardly.	
LAST LETTER (G Saejorhor) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
FLEUR DELACOUR (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover early and middle stages.	
STORMBOY (S Toolooa) – Had to be steadied away from heels when over racing and improving into a marginal run passing the 800 metres.	
VOWS YOU MADE (T Comignaghi) – Made the turn by the 300 metres awkwardly forcing JADORE LUMIERE and WARNING BIRD over extra ground.	
Race 5	BOB AND DIANA GOODEVE RATING 72 1840m
J Burrows (VEE TWELVE) – Issued with a warning under Rule 537(a) late declaration of rider.	
RED ROSE WARRIOR (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and got back.	
DOWRY DUTY (C Campbell) – Was obliged to race wide without cover throughout. Gave ground passing the 400 metres eventually finishing a distant last. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the mare was unsuited to today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.	
Race 6	DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS WAIMATE CUP 1840m
SHOWPIN (K Williams) – Got its head up when steadied passing the 1700 metres.	
Race 7	MARK MEYER/G & M HENNESSY RATING 65 1840m
BRIDGET TOWN (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.	
ADDITUP (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly losing some ground. Steadied off heels passing the 1300 metres as the pace of the race eased..	
SOUTHERN JAZZ (A Bohorun) – Got its head up when over racing for a short distance passing the 1300 metres resulting in the trailing MRS GEE EYE having to be steadied with ADDITUP also having to be steadied.	
MRS GEE EYE (T Moseley) – Steadied away from heels passing the 1300 metres as the pace of the race eased.	
THE STYLE (T Jonker) – Improved wide down the back straight to lead at the 800 metres. Lay out in the run home inconveniencing BILLABONG BILLY who was dictated out into the line of BABY MENAKA passing the 50 metres. T Jonker was advised to exercise care.	
BABY MENAKA (C Campbell) – Steadied away from heels briefly passing the 50 metres.	
GRANT (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance of one of the favoured runners rider advised that the gelding would appreciate tracks with more moisture.
