RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 CR GRACE/AWASSI NZ 2200 (2200 metres)

The start of Race 1 was delayed 10 minutes due to a malfunction of the weighing scales.

LINCOLN'S COMMAND (J Waddell) - Slow away, briefly inconvenienced 2100 metres when improving to the inside of

CAPE CEILIDH which shifted inwards. Rider P Pilley was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

TRENDING (D Turner) – Briefly inconvenienced near the 2100 metres then raced keenly for a distance.

CAST IN BRONZE (R Hannam) - Held up for a distance rounding the home turn being angled back to the inside to improve near the 400 metres.

P Pilley (CAPE CEILIDH) was spoken to regarding the manner in which he used his whip in the home straight.

CAMEO (J Parkes) - When questioned into the run J Parkes was of the opinion the mare may be better suited to more rain affected going. Trainer F Auret advised stewards the mare would not be persevered with from his stable.

Race 2 CHB RAM BREEDERS/RURAL AIR WORK 1350 (1350 metres)

CULLEN BOHANNON (L Hemi) - Three wide without cover throughout.

PRINCE OBERON (M Singh) – Restrained off heels in the early stages, held up for a distance from the 600 metres.

PORT LINCOLN (T Johnson) – Held up for a distance near the 500 metres, ran up onto heels passing the 300 metres having to be angled outwards to improve.

GRATUITY (S O'Malley) - Tightened having to be restrained near the 300 metres when improving into a narrow run when FLORENCE O'REILLY lay in simultaneously as YEAH RIGHT lay out and away from IN SEGRETO which improved to its inside.

END OF STORY (R Myers) - Held up from the 600 metres then raced in restricted room in the home straight only gaining clear running over the final stages.

EUROSTAR (J Waddell) - Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 metres)

BRANTFORD (L Hemi) – Slow away, hung outwards near the 800 metres making the bend awkwardly.

SCORCH (P Pilley) - Raced three wide on the pace throughout, raced greenly under pressure in the home straight

FLORAL BELT (L Allpress) - Ran up onto heels near the 400 metres having to be angled outwards to improve near the 300 metres.

Race 4 FARMERS TRANSPORT 1200 (1200 metres)

HELL FIRE (R Hannam) - Awkwardly away then bumped settling back.

MADAM ACE (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly contacting HELL FIRE, Inconvenienced near the 800 metres, raced greenly in the home straight.

MAGGIE TEE (J Parkes) – Tightened at the start settling back, held up from the 500 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight.

THATZ DAISY (D Turner) - Hung outwards passing the 800 metres making the bend awkwardly, running wide on the track inconveniencing MADAM ACE.

SABATICA (T Johnson) - Lay inwards in the home straight having to be straightened.

BAND (C Johnson) -When questioned into performance C Johnson could offer no excuse.

Race 5

AON INSURANCE BROKERS 1200 (1200 metres)

LYANO (T Johnson) - Slow away

HUGO THE BOSS (M Singh) - Raced ungenerously for a short distance when being restrained approaching the 800 metres.

J Waddell (VEE TWELVE) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 636 (d)] in that he failed to ride his mount fully to the finish losing 5th placing and the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$250.

Race 6

PGG WRIGHTSON/LEOPARD HOTEL XMAS CUP (2200 metres)

CHEESE MAKER (S O'Malley) – Hung inwards throughout, hampered near the 800 metres, angled out across heels to improve approaching the 300 metres.

NOT ALLOWED (R MYERS) – Hampered near the 800 metres, held up for a short distance approaching the 100 metres.

D TURNER (WINDOW SHOPPING) - Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(1)(d)] in that near the 800 metres shifted outwards when not clear, dictating NOT ALLOWED which was hampered for a short distance outwards into the line of CHEESE MAKER which was also hampered and had to take evasive action. D Turner had his license to ride in races suspended from the close of racing Saturday 15th December up to and including 21st December (5 days)

Race 7

BALLANCE AGRI-NUTRIENTS MILE (1600 metres)

BEN JOVI (D Turner) - Slow away, and then retired from the race. Rider reported something amiss. A subsequent veterinary examination lameness in left hind. Connections advised a clearance is required prior to racing.

FATTORE OTTO (L Allpress) - Bucked for a distance shortly after the start inconveniencing MARTINELLI, losing significant ground. Connections were advised the gelding must trial prior to starting next.

MARTENELLI (C O'Beirne) - Inconvenienced shortly after the start.

HANDSOME BLUE (M Singh) - Restrained of heels near the 1000 metres.

NOT USUAL DREAM (J Waddell) –Held up rounding the final turn, then raced in restricted room in the final straight, shifted out under pressure inside the final 100 metres and bumped with THE SEAGULL becoming unbalanced.

Prior to the authorisation of dividend the rider of the 2nd placed NOT USUAL DREAM J Waddell viewed footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection against the winner THE SEAGULL.

Race 8

CARRFIELDS LIVESTOCK MILE (1600 metres)

EXHIBIT (C O'Beirne) – Blundered at the start unbalancing the rider, raced three wide without cover throughout.

DESANO (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse.
