RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	FASTTRACK INSURANCE/NZI 2000 (2000 Metres)
SIERRA VISTA (S Collett) – Reared at the start, losing ground.	
STUNNING (R Hannam) – Slow away (4L). When questioned into performance rider was of the opinion the mare may not have appreciated today's track conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection reported that the mare was displaying a poor post-race recovery.	
DESIGNEDTOIMPRESS (L Hemi) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1600 Metres.	
Race 2	ROGER BRITTIN MEMORIAL (2000 Metres)

MAKEITRAIN (S Collett) – Raced without the near hind plate after casting a plate in the enclosure which was unable to be replaced. Hampered leaving the barriers then forced on to the hind quarters of ATLANTA PEACH when GENERAL SHERMAN lay out away from DIAMOND DANCER. When questioned into performance rider could offer not excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

ATLANTA PEACH (L Allpress) – Unbalanced when hind quarters contacted shortly after leaving the barriers. Raced three wide without cover from near the 900 metres.

ALL KNITTED UP (S McKay) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

GENERAL SHERMAN (I Innes) - Held up rounding the final bend then having to be steadied when disappointed for a run near the 350 metres.

HE'S NO SAINT (T Yanagida) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 300 metres when DIAMOND DANCER shifted out.

Race 3 | **BLACK & WHITE GROUP 1300 (1300 Metres)**

TOGETHER (S Rusof) – Slow to begin. Held up near the 500 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight.

TORCHED (T Yanagida) – Raced three wide without cover. Jockey dropped his whip approaching the 400 metres. Inconvenienced 75 metres.

NAVAL FLEET (S Collett) – Shifted inwards approaching the 100 metres making contact with the running rail, blundering badly, dislodging rider S Collett and dislodging a portion of the running rail. Rider S Collett was examined by St John paramedics and cleared to continue with her remaining rides. Connections were advised that NAVAL FLEET must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to starting next. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed NAVAL FLEET to be 1/5 lame in the right foreleg.

SWEET ALIBHAI (R Myers) - Shifted out abruptly to avoid the fallen rider near the 75 metres, dictating GETSUYOBI and inconveniencing TORCHED.

GETSUYOBI (L Hemi) – Lost the near front plate in the barriers. Dictated 75 metres.

SINCERITY (J Parkes) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 4 | **EVERFRESH TRANSPORT 1200 (1200 Metres)**

BLUE EYED SUSIE (L Innes) - Crowded leaving the barriers

WHOWOULDKNOW (R Hannam) - Raced wide without cover.

LADY DAVONE (S Collett) - When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

SHEZATHINKA (S Rusof) - Held up rounding the turn and early in the home straight, gaining clear running approaching the 200 metres.

GARADOS (A Jones) - Disappointed for a run approaching the 200 metres having to be angled across heels to gain clear running near the 150 metres.

WAASEEM (T Yanagida) – Was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 150 metres.

Race 5 | **ROBYN MACTAGGART CUP (1400 Metres)**

FLYING MEG (L Allpress) - Jumped away awkwardly, then being further hampered when MAKABAR was taken out by SENOR MOSS.

MAKABAR (S Collett) - Hampered leaving barriers. Raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 6 | **DUNSTAN FEEDS 1500 QUALIFIER (1400 Metres)**

AL VANDAAM (S McKay) – Slow away. Held up for a distance from the 500 metres.

DEVI (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

ESTEFANIA (C O’Beirne) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

TRIPLE DIAMOND (M Cameron) - Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

Track downgraded to Slow (7) retrospective to Race 6.

Race 7 | **HB CONSTRUCTION CONGRATULATES SEAN TURNER 1400 (1400 Metres)**

THE PUKETAPU LAD (J Riddell) - Hampered at the start when SO GLORIOUS jumped away awkwardly.

SO GLORIOUS (J Waddell) - Jumped away awkwardly.

SCHIST (J Parkes) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

Race 8 | **DIVA BAR HOME OF OFFICIAL AFTER PARTY MILE (1600 Metres)**

SPECIAL LIGHT (S Rusof) - Dislodged its rider during the preliminary, who was uninjured. After being recaptured SPECIAL LIGHT was returned to the barriers, undergoing a veterinary inspection, being passed fit to race.

ESTIMATION (D Turner) - Jumped away awkwardly bumping with DODGY KHAPERS, which had also begun awkwardly. Over-raced badly in the early and middle stages. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

DODGY KHAPERS (S McKay) - Jumped away awkwardly bumping with ESTIMATION, then being further hampered by CHARTWELL, which shifted outwards.

MR JIMMY POCKET (L Allpress) - Over-raced for a distance when being restrained passing the 1200 metres. Rider lost the use of her right stirrup iron near the 250 metres and when trying to regain its use lost the left stirrup iron near the 150 metres.

MONBEAU (C Lammas) – Raced wide without cover throughout.
