Race 4 KEN BROWNE LIVESTOCK 1200 (1200 Metres)

EASTERN WARRIOR (D Turner) – Trainer G Lowry advised Stewards that the filly would not be persevered with as a racing proposition from his stable.

Waikato Racing Club - 20 July 2019

Race 7 SIGNATURE HOMES 1400

NUTTEE (T Newman) – Trainer M Brosnan advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HAVE YOUR FUNCTION AT ARAWA PARK HURDLE (3000 metres)

IZYMYDAAD (B Lammas) – Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

PYTHAGORAS (J Seivwright) - Slow to begin.

GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (L Douglas) – Slow to begin. Hampered by a riderless horse near the 600 metres.

ASSIGN (A Kuru) – Misjudged the fence near the 1150 metres and fell. As a result, MANDALAY and PRESS MY BUTTONS were badly hampered dislodging their riders. Also hampered was MAGNANIMOUS MAN. ASSIGN was humanely euthanased after the gelding was found to have fractured its off-side shoulder. Rider A Kuru was uninjured.

MANDALAY (S Fannin) – Badly hampered after jumping the fence near the 1150 metres dislodging its rider. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Rider S Fannin was attended to by the on-course doctor and stood down from his remaining ride. S Fannin is to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

PRESS MY BUTTONS (M Roustoby) – Poor jump at the fence near the 1700 metres losing ground. Badly hampered after jumping the fence near the 1150 metres dislodging its rider. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Rider M Roustoby was uninjured.

MAGNANIMOUS MAN (M Cropp) – Crowded when jumping the third fence and hampered losing ground. Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1150 metres.

SUMMER WARRIOR (S Phelan) – Shifted out approaching the second to last fence hampering ABACUS.

ABACUS (E Farr) – Hampered when jumping the second to last fence.

T Moki (FLORENCE IVY) – Issued with a warning after weighing in 0.7 kg above the weight she had weighed out.

Race 2 HARCOURTS TAUMARUNUI HURDLE (3000 metres)

THE SHACKLER (J Seivwright) – Knuckled badly after jumping the second fence hampering JUST GOT HOME. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences. Rider J Seivwright was questioned regarding his riding tactics and why he had persisted to take on the leader through the middle stages with the rider advising that the gelding had a tendency to over-race when being restrained. J Seivwright further explained that THE SHACKLER would derive benefit from today's run.

JUST GOT HOME (S Phelan) – Hampered after jumping the second fence.

SENASSY (M Roustoby) – Misjudged the fence near the 1800 metres. Hit the second to last fence and fell dislodging its rider. Hampered as a result was HESALLJAZZ and SINO HEIGHTS. M Roustoby received medical attention after losing consciousness and will now be required to provide an appropriate medical clearance. SENASSY underwent a veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

RAAJ (E Farr) – Ran down the fence near the 1800 metres hampering READY EDDIE. Hit the fence near the 900 metres dislodging its rider who was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

READY EDDIE (M Cropp) – Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1800 metres. Misjudged the fence near the 1050 metres and knuckled on landing dislodging its rider who was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) – Hit the fence near the 1050 metres. Hampered after jumping the second to last fence.

SINO HEIGHTS (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Hampered after jumping the second to last fence.

Race 3 TAUMARUNUI & DISTRICTS RSA 3YO (1400 metres)

LOUBOUTIN (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (M Kareem) – Slow to begin.

MONT VENTOUX (C Dell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 KEYSTONE PLUMBING (1215 metres)

THIS LADY ROCKS (M Singh) – Slow to begin. Improved on to heels near the 75 metres when well back.

SHAM ON TOAST (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

EASY HABIT (L Satherley) – Contacted soon after leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced. Over-raced when being restrained for a distance near the 900 metres.

MANNERING (D Mansour) – Made contact leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced.

NOT USUAL DELIGHT (C Lammas) – Went amiss approaching the 650 metres and then fell. Was attended to by the on-course veterinarian and humanely euthanased after suffering a hind upper limb fracture. C Lammas was stood down from his remaining rides and is to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

FAMOUS BELLE (J Kam) – Improved on to heels near the 75 metres when well back.

Following race four Stewards and Jockeys inspected the area where NOT USUAL DELIGHT went amiss and found the track to be in satisfactory condition.

Race 5 BOB & COLLEEN DONALDSON MEMORIAL (1215 metres)

IRISH MIST (E McCall) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HARTLEY (D Danis) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

CRITICS CHOICE (C Dell) – Slow to begin.

JUSTACANTA (E Leighton) – Slow to begin.

FORTUNE PATCH (T Yanagida) – Crowded for a distance passing the 1100 metres.

SMOKIN' OAK (S Collett) – Crowded approaching the 1100 metres having to be steadied, then commenced to overrace through the middle stages.

IRISH FLAME (A Goindasamy) – Crowded approaching the 1100 metres having to be steadied. Became awkwardly placed on heels for a distance approaching the 600 metres.

SAIGNON (T Thornton) – Crowded approaching the 1100 metres having to be steadied.

M Kareem (SPOTLIGHT DREAM) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted SPOTLIGHT DREAM to shift in passing the 1100 metres crowding FORTUNE PATCH onto SAIGNON, IRISH FLAME and SMOKIN' OAK which all had to steady, losing ground. After hearing all submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Kareem's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 3 August up to and including racing on 23 August, 9 national riding days.

Race 6 WAIKATO/BOP BUSY BEES (1560 metres)

DELUXE EDITION (R Scott) – Slow to begin.

CHERRY LANE (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

RIPPIN (L Satherley) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of TIPICAL (V Colgan) which shifted in near the 1450 metres with RIPPIN then raced ungenerously for a distance. V Colgan was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

BRANSOME (T Yanagida) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Inconvenienced near 50 metres by CHERRY LANE which shifted out under pressure.

TIPICAL (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

PAISLEY PARK (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

A Goindasamy (THE POORMANZABEEL) – Reminded of obligation with regard to whip use.

The connections of the 2nd placed **BRANSOME** viewed Steward's footage alleging interference by the 1st placed **CHERRY LANE** inside the final 100 metres before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 7 RSA TAUMARUNUI GOLD CUP (2200 metres)

OBSESSIVE (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages.

PACORUS (D Danis) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after having to be steadied.

VERRY FLASH (R Scott) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

ROGER THAT (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

KAHARAU (V Colgan) – Was not persevered with from near the 400 metres. V Colgan was unable to offer any excuse for the performance. KAHARAU underwent a veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

M Coleman (OBSESSIVE) - Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 GOLDEN KIWI (2200 metres)

ROCKING GOOD TIME (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly. Held up entering the final straight then denied clear running when attempting to improve into a marginal run approaching the 250 metres being further held up before shifting out approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

BABOONSKI (C Dell) – Began awkwardly.

THE COSSACK (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously approaching the 1600 metres when being restrained.

RED JOHN (A Calder) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 550 metres when runners on either side shifted ground.

M Kareem (PURSUED) – Was questioned regarding his riding tactics, in particular why he had asked his horse to improve to lead from near the 800 metres and sustain a run. Apprentice M Kareem explained that his instructions had been to put pressure on from near the 600 metres as the gelding had lacked a sprint with M Kareem agreeing with Stewards that he had erred in his judgement.

K Chowdhoory (TWIN SPINNER) – Was questioned regarding his riding tactics, in particular why he had asked his horse to improve to lead from near the 800 metres and sustain a run. Apprentice K Chowdhoory explained that after being pressured by PURSUED from near the 800 metres he had felt obligated to improve with that horse as his gelding raced better when in front with K Chowdhoory agreeing with Stewards that on this occasion he had erred in his judgement.

Race 9 PIRIAKA SYNDICATE (1400 metres)

BENAUD (T Thornton) – Late scratched at 4.24 pm after it was found to have moved both hind plates which were unable to be re-plated.

NUTTEE (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

TOUCH OF SILVER (D Danis) – Slow to begin.

YAMUNA (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

FROZEN (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding performance M Coleman advised that the filly had not been comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.
