RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 GEAR WELDING SERVICES 1200

BINGWA (G Swann) – Slow away.

SHEEZANICEGIRL (T Yanagida) – Shifted in abruptly shortly after the start and crowded and hampered MASTER OAKLEIGH which lost ground. Also inconvenienced was POINSETTIA. When questioned regarding performance apprentice T Yanagida could offer no excuse.

MASTER OAKLEIGH (A Goindasamy) – Hampered start losing ground.

POINSETTIA (S Rusof) – Crowded start becoming briefly unbalanced.

LUCKY STRIKE (S McKay) – Steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SHEEZANICEGIRL (T Yanagida) which shifted in when not fully clear near the 1000 metres. Rider T Yanagida was advised to exercise care.

COURT CHA (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SAM'S SONG (L Satherley) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight, then raced greenly when placed under pressure.

Race 2 FERTCO LIMITED 1200

FASTELLIE (L Satherley) – Raced in restricted room having to be steadied for a distance shortly after the start.

BELLE SOUTH (A Calder) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

S Rusof (SPEED CALL) – Questioned into his perceived lack of vigour over the concluding stages. S Rusof explained that the gelding had raced greenly throughout, and had commenced to hang inwards over the concluding stages placing him at a disadvantage. The Stewards accepted Mr Rusof's explanation, however advised him that when circumstances permit he must ride his mount out fully to the finish of a race.

THE REFLEX (J Waddell) – When questioned regarding performance rider J Waddell could offer no excuse.

Race 3 YOUNG READ WOUDBERG CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 2100

RODMAR (B Grylls) – Began very awkwardly losing ground (3L) with its rider losing the use of her left stirrup iron until passing the 2000 metres. Then raced ungenerously for a distance making the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion.

MOTIVATION (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly hampering TUNZAGUTZ.

TUNZAGUTZ (S Collett) – Hampered shortly after the start.

EXPRESS CALL (R Elliot) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

PALLADINO (J Riddell) - Slow away.

MOIRAS TOWN (B R Jones) – Slow away.

REGAL ASSASSIN (S Sprat) – Commenced to over-race for a distance when being steadied passing the 1200 metres.

IT'S DOABLE (B Grylls) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

TEARANITA (L Satherley) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 400 metres.

TINTERO (R Elliot) – Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 350 metres.

Race 5 DON GRIFFITHS LIMITED DRILLING CONTRACTOR 1400

CRAGGY RANGE (C Lammas) – Declared a late scratching at 5:15pm after rearing in the birdcage and dislodging its rider who was injured.

CAVALLO ECCELLENTE (J Waddell) – Was late scratched at the barriers at 5:18pm after the rider advised that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises in its preliminary and was unwilling to ride the gelding.

DISPATCHED (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with QUINTOS for a distance.

VERSES (T Yanagida) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres. Had to shift out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running forcing QIJI CRYSTAL wider.

MR SCALLYWAG (D Hain) – Began awkwardly and inconvenienced shortly after.

QUINTOS (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Hampered losing ground passing the 800 metres.

QIJI CRYSTAL (S Rusof) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres then shifted out passing the 800 metres when racing fiercely hampering QUINTOS which lost ground as a result. Continued to over-race through the middle stages. Forced wider passing the 200 metres.

Race 6 REAL CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1400

The start of this race was put back until 6:32 pm after an attendant was injured in the birdcage, with race 7 now to be run at 7:03 pm and race 8 at 7:32 pm.

HOT IN HIGH HEELS (M Cameron) – Crowded and steadied on jumping away.

CLASSIC TOUCH (A Calder) – Began awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

THE REAL BEEL (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

VEINE D'OR (S Spratt) – Held up entering the final straight for a distance.

ENDEAN EXPRESS (S McKay) – Held up for a short distance rounding the bend into the final straight.

STAND TALL (S Rusof) – Inconvenienced when placed in restricted room approaching the 350 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider S Rusof could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.

PASABAHCE (R Elliot) – Improved on to heels approaching the 200 metres, and was held up until the 50 metres.

Race 7 THE SHOW MUST GO ON 1600

ADIS (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MING'S EMPEROR (D Danis) – Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 300 metres.

BALLET CHOUX (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 8 KIWI BUS BUILDERS 1600

CLEMENTINA (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room passing the 350 metres.

MELARITA (S Collett) – Slow away.

FIERY DRAGON (J Riddell) – Slow away. Had to shift out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

LONDON BANKER (O Bosson) – Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 900 metres after making the bend awkwardly. Held up rounding the final bend, then had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 50 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

GO STARSKY (L Satherley) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.
