<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MORE FM DASH MAIDEN (1200m)</b>
<b>BUSY</b> (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.	
<b>BLOOMING FAST</b> (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly.	
<b>UBETIAM</b> (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	

**STRATTON** (K Williams) – Over raced in the early stages, improved wide rounding the final bend.

**LIAM** (T Jonker) – Over raced in the early stages, raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

**UBETIAM** (K Asano) – Steadied momentarily passing the 300 metres to avoid the heels of **HIGHLAND LADY** (L Callaway) which shifted out at this point. L Callaway was obliged to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**MISS TILLY WINKS** (T Comignaghi) – Lay in and away from **HIGHLAND LADY** near the 180 metres resulting in **NO QUANTUM** having to be steadied.

**NO QUANTUM** (K Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 180 metres.

**MISS OAKS** (D Prastiyu) – Rider spoken to advisedly in regard to riding his mounts out to the finish when circumstances permit.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES SPRINT MAIDEN (1200m)</b>

**COSTA RAVI** (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly losing ground, raced wide throughout, lay in passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened. Rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

**KANDHU** (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

**TAP 'N' GO** (L Callaway) – Over raced and when being steadied into the first bend shifting in hampering **ROMANTIC HERO** which was also over racing having to be steadied.

**ROMANTIC HERO** (T Moseley) – Restrained off heels passing the 900 metres when over racing and crowded for room.

**WYNMOORE** (T Jonker) – Placed in restricted room and had to be restrained passing the 900 metres when **SHOCK PROSPECT** (K Williams) shifted in momentarily at this point. K Williams was advised to exercise greater care.

**GERRY JOYCE** (K Mudhoo) – Had to be restrained when attempting a marginal run to the inside of **FOLLOW THE STARS** passing the 700 metres. K Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care when attempting runs which have not fully developed.

**ALTAMENTE** (D Prastiyu) – Rider reported the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MCINTOSH CATERING HANDICAP (1200m)</b>

Co-Trainers **White/Callaway** were issued with a warning under Rule 616(4) for presenting **JUST ANOTHER DAY** without the notified blinkers.

**INDULGENT** (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

**LITTLE FLICK** (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly shifting out and making firm contact with **MISS TANIRA**.

**DON'T BE CHEEKY** (A Bohorun) – Began awkwardly, raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**JUST ANOTHER DAY** (C Johnson) – Slow to begin.

**OMAR** (K Kwo) – Crowded and steadied when racing into the first bend near the 900 metres.

**T Moseley** (**TAKE ME THERE**) was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in crowding inside runners passing the 900 metres.

**MISS RICKY BOBBY** (T Comignaghi) – Held up early in the run home, crowded and had to steady at the 250 metres when placed in restricted room and continued to be held up until gaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres.

**A Bohorun** (**DON'T BE CHEEKY**) was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in passing the 250 metres crowding **MISS RICKY BOBBY** which had to steady.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>ONCEUPONATIME (1200m)</b>
<p><b>MISS BRAHMOS</b> (T Comignaghi) – Bounded at the start and lost ground.</p> <p><b>OPIHI RANGER</b> (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p><b>BLACK LABEL</b> (K Williams) – Over raced in the early stages and got its head up when being steadied passing the 900 metres, steadied again passing the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on heels. Stewards enquired into the performance today, with rider K Williams advising that after consultation with the trainer she had elected not to try and lead due to the fact there was plenty of speed in the race. She added that after beginning fairly the horse had over raced early and the mare had over-reacted when another runner improved quickly to her inside resulting in her having to steady at the 600 metres, with BLACK LABEL then finishing the race off fairly over the concluding stages. Stewards noted K Williams' explanation.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>PHIL EDWARDS MILE MAIDEN (1600m)</b>
<p><b>MY CASHIER</b> (J Laking) – Attempted to buck shortly after the start and then shifted in abruptly dislodging the rider who was uninjured. The connections were advised that the gelding must barrier trial to Stewards' satisfaction prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>FIGEAMEOUT</b> (T Moseley) – Very fractious in the barrier with the connections advised that the mare would be placed on a barrier manners warning. Clipped a heel of the riderless horse which shifted out across the face of the runners passing the 1300 metres. Also hampered at this point were JANGLES and WHEREABOUTS which were both taken wider on the track with the trailing ZANTE also forced wider by the riderless horse.</p> <p><b>JANGLES</b> (C Johnson) – Forced wider by the riderless horse passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>WHEREABOUTS</b> (K Mudhoo) – Forced wider by the riderless horse passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>ZANTE</b> (K Williams) – Forced wider by the riderless horse passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>LAST LETTER</b> (T Jonker) – Over raced for a distance passing the 900 metres and had to be restrained off heels.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>ASCOT SPORTSHOUSE &amp; EATERY MAIDEN (1600m)</b>
<p>The explanation for the late declaration of rider for DIVINEXCUSE provided by trainer S Woodsford was accepted by the Stewards on this occasion.</p> <p><b>DIVINEXCUSE</b> (K Williams) – Slow to begin, inconvenienced passing the 175 metres by MOLLY POLLY (K Asano) which shifted in marginally at this point. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p><b>ELVA</b> (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early stages having to shift ground outwards to avoid heels passing the 1300 metres and was then obliged to race wide without cover from this point.</p> <p><b>BEAUDEN BEE</b> (T Moseley) – Over raced into the first bend and had to be restrained off heels for some distance, continued to over race throughout the back straight having to be restrained off heels on a number of occasions due to the lack of tempo.</p> <p><b>BROTHER WILL</b> (D Prastiyu) – Had to be restrained passing the 700 metres when improving quickly onto the heels of the runner in front due to the lack of tempo at this point of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>SOUTH CANTERBURY SADDLERY (1600m)</b>
<p><b>RELIABLE GLOW</b> (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>AMOUR LA VIE</b> (R Beeharry) – Raced wide without cover throughout, lay in passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened. Rider was spoken to advisedly in regard to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>THOM BROWN</b> (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early stages due to the lack of tempo, briefly held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p><b>TEE GEE ELL</b> (K Kwo) – Over raced in the early stages due to the lack of tempo.</p> <p><b>MANHATTAN FIRE</b> (T Comignaghi) – When asked to comment on performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities other than a slow recovery rate.</p>	

**MOWENNA** – When spoken to regarding performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities other than a slow recovery rate.

Stewards will follow up with the trainers of both MANHATTAN FIRE and MOWENNA in following days.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>AGRICOM HANDICAP (1600m)</b>

**IRISH EXPRESS** (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

**ALBUT ME** (S Toolooa) – Raced wide throughout.

**THE BUMPER** (K Asano) – When asked to comment on performance, the rider reported in his opinion the gelding had not handled the puggy nature of today's track.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>RACE IMAGES (CHCH) (2200m)</b>

Trainers **K & A Tyler** were fined \$50 under Rule 616(4) for presenting KARM 'N' EASY without the notified blinkers.

**LOCALLY SAUCED** (C Johnson) – When spoken to regarding the performance of this favoured runner, the rider reported that the gelding failed to let down in the prevailing track conditions and had been disappointing.

**KARM 'N' EASY** (K Kwo) – When spoken to regarding the improved performance the rider advised that the gelding had been suited by the wetter track and extra distance.

<b>Race 10</b>	<b>END OF SEASON STAYERS (2200m)</b>

**EAGER BEAVER** (T Jonker) – Dwelt at the start losing ground (5L). Rider dropped her whip passing the 350 metres.

**SOUTHERN JAZZ** (A Bohorun) – Raced wide into the first bend.

**MIDNITE KAOS** (BB Hong) – Saddle slipped forward passing the 1300 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

**BRIDGET TOWN** – When asked about the improved performance, the connections advised that the mare had improved with each run this time in and combined with favorable track conditions on the home course had lead to a better effort today.
