GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (800 Metres)
The start of this race was delayed due to O'CEIRIN'S CALLING breaking through the front of the barriers, followed by HASLER LAD proving a little reluctant to load.	
O'CEIRIN'S CALLING (M Hudson) - Broke through the barriers prior to the start but was pulled up immediately; underwent a veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Raced wide without cover throughout.	
REGAL REWARD (M Singh) - Jumped away awkwardly forcing RED SHARP PRINCE out onto RIVA CAPRI, which was hampered losing ground.	

RED SHARP PRINCE (L Allpress) - Contacted leaving the barriers. Ducked outwards near the 550 metres. Held up approaching the 300 metres having to be restrained off heels. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had raced very greenly.

RIVA CAPRI (S Collett) - Hampered start, losing ground. Hampered near the 550 metres when RED SHARP PRINCE ducked outwards.

HASLER LAD (R Hannam) - Inconvenienced when placed in restricted room to the inside of POWER OF HOPE near the 75 metres.

S Collett (RIVA CAPRI) - Issued with a warning with regard to her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

BLUE ARROW (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover

IRISH PRAYER (S Collett) - Raced wide without cover.

NEW YORK JAZZ (T Yanagida) - Held up entering the final straight before shifting inwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

T Yanagida (NEW YORK JAZZ) - Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after angling his mount inwards near the 250 metres when not fully clear, hampering BUCKY.

BUCKY (C Johnson) - Briefly held up near the 400 metres. Hampered near the 250 metres.

CHOSEN PEAK (R Elliot) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

VROOM (D Turner) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1000 metres losing ground, continuing to race greenly through the middle stages. Was unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

THE WHITE QUEEN (R Myers) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

Race 3	STOCK CO 1200 (1200 Metres)

QUINTANA (R Beemud) - Began awkwardly then being buffeted between runners, raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages. Raced in restricted room to the inside of BREATH OF FIRE being contacted by that runner on two occasions near the 100 metres.

BUMRAH (R Myers) - Slow away. Held up approaching the 250 metres then being angled inwards across the heels of BURGLAR to obtain clear running.

SASSENACH (D Turner) - Slow away. Raced wide without cover.

SPECIAL GIRL (C Grylls) - Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly losing ground, going back onto CARAZZI which was hampered. Crowded near the 300 metres when BREATH OF FIRE (C O'Beirne) lay in. Hampered approaching the 200 metres when BREATH OF FIRE again lay in when struck with the whip shifting away from BUMRAH which was being angled inwards to obtain clear running. C O'Beirne was advised to exercise greater care.

CARAZZI (R Elliot) - Hampered near the 800 metres.

BREATH OF FIRE (C O'Beirne) - Had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4 **KEN BROWNE LIVESTOCK 1200 (1200 Metres)**

PORSHABELLE (M Kareem) - Began awkwardly, losing ground. Apprentice M Kareem was spoken to regarding his riding tactics and advised that in the Stewards' view he had erred in riding his mount forward with vigour in the early stages after a poor beginning resulting in the filly having to work hard and cover extra ground before then disputing the pace through the middle stages.

EASTERN WARRIOR (D Turner) - Restrained early after jumping from a wide barrier. D Turner reported that the filly had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

PINCANTO (E McCall) - Raced wide without cover.

Race 5 **WAIROA WANDERERS 1200 (1200 Metres)**

GET UP (R Beemud) - Began awkwardly unbalancing the rider. Commenced to weaken from the 400 metres finishing last. When questioned rider was of the opinion the gelding may prefer a more rain-affected track.

SPRING BOUQUET (L Innes) - Slow away.

CAMEAHOTFRIDAY (T Yanagida) - Raced wide without cover in the middle stages.

SHOWMEWARE (L Allpress) - Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 800 metres.

TORO ROSSO (R Myers) - Raced wide without cover.

ONE MADISON (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse but felt that the mare would now be better suited over more ground.

Race 6 **JIMMY RURAL 1400 (1400 Metres)**

Following the running of Race 5, R Elliot advised that he was feeling unwell and was stood down from his remaining rides being replaced on FLAUTINO by C Johnson.

BEAUTY STAR (D Mansour) - Slow to begin, then got its head up when being steadied shortly after the start and blundered.

OVERSTAYER (S Collett) - Checked when crowded leaving the barriers, losing ground.

VEUVE CLICQUOT (H Andrew) - Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers.

MISS YELRACM (R Myers) - Had a tendency to over-race when being restrained in the middle stages.

KEEPIN HARMONEE (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

BLUE RATA ANNA (D Turner) - Raced wide without cover.

MISSANDEI (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses, advising that the filly still felt a little immature. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

FLAUTINO (C Johnson) - Rider was unable to offer any excuses advising that the mare had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure.

Race 7	BEN ALLEN TRANSPORT 1650 (1650 Metres)
<p>PASSING GLANCE - D Mansour replaced R Elliot. Shifted inwards leaving the barriers making contact with SHEZA BEACH BABE, losing ground. Commenced to give ground from the 800 metres, quickly becoming tailed off and finishing a distant last. Rider D Mansour reported that the mare had felt sore behind. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality with connections indicating that the mare was now likely to be retired.</p> <p>ROX (C Johnson) - Slow away.</p> <p>SHEZA BEACH BABE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin then further hampered when contacted by PASSING GLANCE. Held up near the 250 metres, having to steady and shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>ALFA ROSSO (S McKay) - Commenced to over-race shortly after the start, racing very ungenerously for a distance, continuing to race fiercely into the middle stages with the rider reporting that this had had a detrimental effect on its chances in the race.</p> <p>MAN POWER (T Yanagida) - Shifted ground outwards under pressure near the 250 metres, contacting JONNY RUSS.</p> <p>JOHNNY RUSS (C Grylls) - Contacted 250 metres.</p> <p>C Grylls (JONNY RUSS) - Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres being fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee.</p>	
Race 8	PGG WRIGHTSON LIVESTOCK 1650 (1650 Metres)
<p>AJAY LINCOLN (R Hannam) - Slow away.</p> <p>WICKED SISTER (C McLean) - Slow away. Raced wide without cover from the 1400 metres, giving ground quickly from the 700 metres and was not persevered with over the final stages.</p> <p>VALHEXA (T Yanagida) - Gave ground from the 600 metres.</p> <p>HERE'S TROUBLE (D Turner) - Raced in restricted room rounding the final turn near the 350 metres when FRANCESCA KATE (R Myers), which was improving into a tight run to its inside, lay out, resulting in HERE'S TROUBLE making contact with the hind quarters of TOUCH THE CLOUDS. R Myers was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>TOUCH THE CLOUDS (L Allpress) - Raced keenly when three wide without cover throughout with the rider advising she felt this was detrimental to its chances. Received contact to hindquarters near the 350 metres. L Allpress was reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out fully to the finish whenever circumstances permit.</p> <p>R Hannam (AJAY LINCOLN) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 9	ROSS DYER LIVESTOCK 1650 (1650 Metres)
<p>NEVER BACK DOWN (C Grylls) - Jumped away awkwardly forcing HANDYMAN outwards onto FANTASY FLIGHT, TIPPERARY MARY and SKAABOOM, which were all crowded losing ground. Contributing was some inward movement from LORD TURBO with rider C O'Beirne being advised to exercise greater care. Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>HANDYMAN (H Andrew) - Hampered start.</p> <p>FANTASY FLIGHT (S Collett) - Crowded start losing ground.</p>	

TIPPERARY MARY (L Allpress) - Checked when crowded start losing ground and settling back.	
SKAABOOM (L Innes) - Checked when crowded start losing ground.	
ZEDABEL LASS (B Ansell) - Raced keenly in the lead in the early to middle stages.	
BIG BEN (C Johnson) - Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages.	
Race 10	FARMERS TRANSPORT 1650 (1650 Metres)
VERACIOUS (T Yanagida) - Slow away.	
RED RASCAL (C O'Beirne) - Slow away settling back. Raced keenly in the middle stages when wide without cover.	
CHARTWELL (R Hannam) - Raced wide without cover.	
SUPER HOOF (D Danis) - Shifted ground outwards under pressure forcing RUFFY RAHTWO wider near the 300 metres then again shifted outwards under pressure passing the 150 metres making contact with RUFFY RAHTWO.	
RUFFY RAHTWO (L Allpress) - Forced wider 300 metres then contacted 150 metres.	
CABOCHON (S McKay) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of NUNCHUCKS, which lay out under pressure approaching the 200 metres. R Myers was advised to exercise greater care and ensure that she corrects her mount more quickly than she had on this occasion.	
NUNCHUCKS (R Myers) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight.
