Race 1	MOUNT SHOP 2100
DOUBLE HAPPY (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.	

DR VELOCIOUS (M Cameron) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 1900 metres and shifted out inconveniencing RELIABLE BELLE and TWIN SPINNER.

RELIABLE BELLE (R Elliot) – Inconvenienced near the 1900 metres.

TWIN SPINNER (K Chowdhoory) – Inconvenienced near the 1900 metres.

HVAR (A Calder) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 2 SSANGYONG 2100

SHE'S ALL CLANG (S Spratt) - Slow away.

Race 3 VETERINARY ASSOCIATES 1200

SHAM ON TOAST (A Calder) – Slow away.

BELLE OF GEORGIA (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with BLIZZING AWAY which became briefly unbalanced.

CAPTAIN REG (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TICKADIVA (R Scott) - Inconvenienced approaching the 350 metres when SIR RALPH shifted out.

SIR RALPH (C Lammas) – Lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 4 HAUNUI FARM 1400

CALL ME BOB (S Collett) – Hampered on jumping away. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had raced closer to the lead than anticipated and had failed to respond once placed under pressure in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FLY TO THE MOON (D Mansour) – Began awkwardly.

BRANSOME (T Yanagida) – Slow away. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

SO MUCH MOUR (S Spratt) – Held up until approaching the 350 metres.

INNAMINCKA (K Chowdhoory) – Inconvenienced near the 350 metres after becoming awkwardly placed on heels. Had to steady after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of FLY TO THE MOON which shifted out abruptly passing the 100 metres.

DUDEWITHATTITUDE (T Thornton) – Inconvenienced near the 300 metres when GOOD VIBES (R Smyth) shifted out. R Smyth was advised to exercise care.

Race 5 LONE STAR PUKEKOHE 1400

ANSWER BACK (T Newman) – Broke through the front of its barrier stall and was quickly restrained before undergoing a veterinary examination being cleared to start. Began awkwardly.

CLEVERCONVERSATION (T Thornton) – Slow away.

GLOBAL DIAMOND (R Elliot) – Shifted out abruptly near the 350 metres when struck with the whip.

Race 6 FORMSTRESS 1600

EASY WALKING (D Johnson) – Slow away.

FRIDAY WOOLFE (D Danis) – Slow away.

LEICA WARRIOR (T Newman) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of VIS TA VIE which shifted in slightly passing the 400 metres before shifting out to obtain clear running.

TED TALKS (M Cameron) – Commenced to give ground entering the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

BOTTI (M Hashizume) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

CHADSDALE (C Grylls) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had not been entirely suited to today's track conditions.

DELUXE EDITION (R Scott) – When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer I George advised he was confident of a good performance after an improved run at Avondale where the gelding had made up good ground.

SIENNA GRACE (D Danis) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SHAHANA (T Wenn) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1300 metres.
