## **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 JO MCGARTLAND MEMORIAL HURDLES 3000m

MASTER COURTSMAN (G Walsh) – Poor leap by the fence near the 1200 metres.

**WENTWORTH** (I Fraser-Hayes) - Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence and fell. Rider I Fraser-Hayes was uninjured. WENTWORTH lay on the track for a period when winded before regaining its feet. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormality.

**SHEEZOFF** (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Misjudged the fence near the 1400 metres dislodging its rider who was uninjured. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormality.

The start of this race was delayed approximately four and half minutes due to some runners proving difficult to load.

**SOUNDS PROMISING** (C Campbell) – Slow away.

**ROTHACKER** (T Moseley) - Hampered at the 150 metres.

**BLUE** (S Shinde) – Lay inwards early in the home straight. Lay outwards when struck with the whip passing the 150 metres hampering ROTHACKER, HEAT SEEKER and HEARTOHEART. **S Shinde** was warned for the manner in which he shifted ground.

**HEAT SEEKER** (J Laking) – Restrained early to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

**WARNING BIRD** (R Beeharry) – Wide without cover throughout.

**DEEBEEWITHTHESTARS** (K Kwo) – Slow away.

KANDHU (C Johnson) – Layout throughout the final straight and was straightened passing the 100 metres.

**HEARTOHEART** (T Jonker) – Got its head up when restrained passing the 700 metres. Placed in restricted room and had to be steadied passing the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

**SMART GARDEN** (K Mudhoo) - Proved reluctant to load delaying the start then jumped away awkwardly and raced ungenerously in the early stages, losing considerable ground. Trainer Mr L Stewart was advised that the mare would now be required to trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing again.

### Race 3 MORE FM SRPINT MAIDEN 1200m

**STRATTON** (C Johnson) - Held up in the early stages of the home straight shifting ground inwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

**COSTA RAVI** (S Shinde) - Keen early stages.

MR FAHRENHEIT (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

**SHOCK PROSPECT** (K Williams) - Made contact with the running rail passing the 600 metres and raced greenly thereafter.

**WYNMOORE** (T Jonker) Got its head up when being restrained passing the 1000 metres making the bend awkwardly. Bumped passing the 300 metres

**BUSTER BOLT** (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

### Race 4 EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES &ONCEUPONATIME CHASE 4280m

The start was delayed when EION had to be re-saddled.

**DOCTOR HOOK** (S Fannin) – Underwent a post race veterinary inspection, which revealed no obvious abnormalities, after appearing a little indifferent in its action after the race.

GO GO GONZO (G Walsh) -Got in close to the second fence.

**EION** (J Seivwright) – Hampered on landing after jumping the fence near the 1600 metres having to be steadied losing ground.

MR INK (I Fraser-Hayes) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Put in a poor leap by the fence at the 2200 metres. Put in a poor a jump at the fence near the 1000 metres and fell. Rider I Fraser-Hayes was uninjured. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

## Race 5 TIMARU TOWN & COUNTRY CLUB DASH 1200m

**DARCI MAC** (J Laking) – Held up on entering the home straight having to shift ground outwards approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

**SABER** (T Jonker) – Raced wide without cover early before improving forward to lead near the 600 metres.

**ON POINT** (T Moseley) – Restrained early from a wide barrier to obtain cover.

**WINDSOR** (K Williams) – Steadied near the 100 metres when awkwardly placed on heels and over the concluding stages when awkwardly placed between runners.

**HAPPY HITTER** (C Campbell) – Crowded shortly after the start. Was not afforded clear running throughout the straight and went to the line without being tested by the rider.

VICE MARSHALL (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide throughout.

**OMAR** (R Beeharry) – Contacted when leaving the barriers when CELTIC CROSS jumped outwards.

**GREY GHOST** (K Kwo) – Hampered shortly after the start.

### Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200m

**PROMISING** (G Saejorhor) – Slow through the early stages and tailed the field throughout. When spoken to about the performance the rider reported that he could offer no tangible excuse other than the mare is better suited to more rain effected going. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

KNOWN TO FLIRT (J Laking) Steadied passing the 1200 metes when awkwardly placed inside heels.

MISS TANIRA (K Asano) - Lay inwards passing the 1200 metres having to be straightened.

**STARMAKER** (T Jonker) – When questioned about the tactics employed rider stated that she was instructed to lead. Adding that the mare races better when leading by itself as when restrained has a tendency not to breath properly. Stewards noted her explanation.

**MIROSLAVA** (R Beeharry) – Got its head up when restrained in the early stages. Lay outwards passing the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

WHITNEY (D Prastiyou) – Slow away.

**BOYSLIGHTUP** (B Murray) – Wide without cover throughout.

**DEVINE LOVE** (C Campbell) - Raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained passing the 1000 metres. Steadied passing the 600 metres when racing keenly on heels.

## Race 7 JON SNOW 1600 1600m

**GALWAY GARRY** (K Kwo) – Had a tendency to over race in the early and middle stages.

#### Race 8 HARDGRAVE DECORATING MILE MAIDEN 1600m

The start of this race delayed due to a girth replacement required on RAISE YOU FIVE.

**BATTLE MAN** (B Murray) – Inclined to lay inwards in the final straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

**RAISE YOU FIVE** (J Laking) – Held up early stages of the home straight then continued to have difficulty finding clear running throughout the straight and went to the line without being fully tested.

**GRAND EXPRESS** (C Johnson) - Was inclined to race greenly and lay outwards over the concluding stages.

ITEMIZE (C Campbell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**BROTHER WILL** (S Toolooa) - Not afforded clear running in the early stages of the home straight. Shifted ground inwards passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

MOLLY POLLY (G Saejorhor) - Slow away.

**CEE SHARP** (T Jonker) – Slow away. Commenced to over race near the 1400 metres continuing to do so through the middle stages.

**ELVA** (D Prastiyou) – Held up and steadied passing the 500 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

**DIPLOMAT** (T Moseley) – Steadied for a distance near the 1400 metres to shift to a position closer to the running rail. Then having a tendency to over race through the middle stages.

## Race 9 POWER FARMING TIMARU LTD HANDICAP 1600m

**RED MAJOR** (L Callaway) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**SMOKEM UP** (C Campbell) – Held up passing the 500 metres until entering the home straight. Rider dismounted prior to returning to the birdcage reporting that the gelding appeared to be lame in the front leg. A post race veterinary inspection revealed Grade 2 lame right front and Grade 2 lame right hind. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing next.

**MELBOURNE BORN** (K Williams) – Blundered at the start unbalancing the rider momentarily.

KARM 'N' EASY (G Saejorhor) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

**SHAZ THE BANK** (K Mudhoo) - Held up early in the home straight shifting ground outwards approaching the 250 metres to obtain clear running. Rider dropped his whip passing the 150 metres.

**FEEL THE BREEZE** (C Johnson) – Raced keenly when in the lead through the early and middle stages.

**MOWENNA** (K Asano) – Lay outwards in the straight inconveniencing FEEL THE BREEZE near the 300 metres and SMOKEM UP passing the 200 metres.

**K Asano** was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

**STIRLING LADY** (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover.

## Race 10 SKYLINE & JFK HOMES STAYERS 2100m

**STEELE CANYON** (B Murray) – Restrained early after jumping from the outside barrier to shift to a position closer to the running rail. Was inclined to lay inwards passing the 100 metres having to be straightened.

**BAHHGOOFY** (G Saejorhor) – Jumped away awkwardly. Angled outwards to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels of STEELE CANYON near 180 metres. Lost his footing and fell after the

finishing post the rider. Rider G Saejorhor was attended to by the ambulance person and found to have suffered from a minor knee injury. A medical certificate is required to be produced to the Stewards prior to riding next.

**OUR ROYAL** (S Toolooa) – Made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly shifting outwards.

**DUNDEE FLAG** (T Comignaghi) – Lost its footing and blundered going into the first turn passing the 1800 metres. Raced wide without cover.

**K Mudhoo** (JILDI JILDI) admitted a breach of careless riding after permitting his mount JILDI to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of PEGGY STEWART which was checked near the 2000 metres. After hearing evidence the Judicial Committee suspended K Mudhoo's licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 12<sup>th</sup> July up to and including 25<sup>th</sup> July.

BARZELLAR (T Moseley) – Made the bend near 1600 metres awkwardly losing ground.

MACPAC (T Jonker) – Slow away.

**PEGGY STEWART** (B Hong) - Checked near the 2000 metres.

**JINGO** (D Prastiyou) – Made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly shifting outwards making contact with DUNDEE FLAG. Placed in restricted room over the concluding stages and had to be steadied in the shadows of the post when JILDI JILDI shifted inwards.
