**SO WICKED** (J Waddell) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that in the days following this race the mare underwent blood tests which did not reveal any abnormality and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

**DARCI PALMER** (O Bosson) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

**RACE COMMENTS:**

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>LEGENDS DAY – FEB 9TH – HOSPO PACKAGES LIVE NOW 1500</b>
<p><b>ABACUS</b> (S Spratt) – Stumbled badly on jumping away with rider S Spratt becoming badly unbalanced and losing the use of her left stirrup iron for a distance.</p> <p><b>PAISLEY PARK</b> (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly, then over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>CONCERT HALL</b> (S McKay) – Crowded and steadied losing ground at the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SCAGLIONI</b> (A Jones) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider A Jones was questioned regarding her riding tactics in the early stages where she allowed her mount to drift back some distance from the field. A Jones explained after beginning fairly she was reluctant to encourage the gelding as it had a tendency to over-race and as the pace of the race was only moderate, she was able to improve on to the back of the field near the 800 metres. A Jones agreed with Stewards that she had allowed her mount to lose contact with the field, with Stewards advising that she must show better judgement in future.</p> <p><b>HOT SAKI</b> (V Colgan) – Received veterinary treatment after displaying mild signs of colic post-race.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>PRINT HOUSE 1600</b>
<p><b>SEEMAX</b> (J Nason) – Stumbled on jumping away losing ground. Inclined to lay out throughout the running. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.</p> <p><b>SODA</b> (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Briefly held up rounding the final bend, then had to shift out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>PIGGY MALONE</b> (T Yanagida) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay out entering the final straight shifting wider on the track.</p>	

<b>THE BUZZ</b> (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding performance rider O Bosson advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>LODGE CITY RENTALS 1600</b>
<b>THE MITIGATOR</b> (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground.  <b>VICTORY DRIVE</b> (A Goindasamy) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.  <b>ATHENA BABY</b> (T Thornton) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1200 metres.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>THEBESTLITTLEBOOKSTORE.CO.NZ 1400</b>
<b>LITE MY CIGAR</b> (O Bosson) – Shifted in abruptly on jumping away bumping TROUBLE which became unbalanced losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout.  <b>TROUBLE</b> (L Innes) – Bumped shortly after the start losing ground.  <b>DEPENDSONSITUATION</b> (P Pilley) – Crowded and steadied shortly after jumping away.  <b>FLOMILINE</b> (R Elliot) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be firmly restrained and as a result lost ground.  <b>GRAND AWARD</b> (T Thornton) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres. Steadied when placed in restricted room when making the bend near the 800 metres.  <b>SENROR MOSS</b> (S Spratt) – Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.  <b>THE GARRISON</b> (D Danis) – D Danis dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>FOSTER MAINTAIN 1500</b>
<b>ARTISTE</b> (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly shifting in.  <b>SWINGING SKIRTS</b> (L Satherley) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.  <b>ANICETA</b> (M McNab) – Raced wide without cover throughout.  <b>HOYT AXTON</b> (D Hain) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres when NEXT UP (C Dell) shifted in. C Dell was advised to exercise care.  <b>ROC YA SOX</b> (S Spratt) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be lame in the left hind leg with a small abrasion on the pastern. Trainer J Wheeler was advised that ROC YA SOX would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>NATIONWIDE LIVESTOCK 1200</b>
<b>AUTUMN WILD</b> (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly.  <b>BELLINSKY</b> (V Colgan) – Stumbled on jumping away.  <b>JUD STRUNK</b> (E McCall) – Began awkwardly.  <b>CRYSTALLIZE</b> (A Goindasamy) – Over-raced in the early stages.	

**NOTHINGLEFTTOLOSE** (R Smyth) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**I AM GRACIE** (J Fawcett) – Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly running wide.

**SEDUTTORE** (M McNab) – Held up early in the final straight shifting out passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running.

**D Waddell** (SINGLE MOMENT) – Issued with a warning for presenting the mare to race without the notified blinkers.

**KATIE PERRIE** (B R Jones) – Began awkwardly.

**STARRYBEEL** (M McNab) – Slow away.

**BATTLE ROYAL** (T Yanagida) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**ALL KNITTED UP** (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.

**FRANKLIN** (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly and then further hampered losing ground.

**VENCEDORA** (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**EASY WALKING** (V Colgan) – Had to be steadied shortly after the start when awkwardly placed inside heels.

**KOOL CONNECTION** (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Rider advised that the saddle slipped backwards in the final straight placing him at a disadvantage.

**CHARLI ROSE** (O Bosson) – Raced three wide without cover rounding the first bend.
