GRAND AWARD (C Grylls) – Trainer F Ritchie advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it has now been sent for a spell.

Race 1	STEVE LUNJEVICH CONTRACTING HURDLE 3100
<p>SHE SAID YES (B Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Misjudged the second fence. Hampered after jumping the third to last fence.</p> <p>TITTLTATTLE (J Seivwright) – Stumbled on landing after jumping the first fence.</p> <p>KING OBERON (M Gillies) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>IN A MINUTE (E Farr) – Ran down the third to last fence hampering SHE SAID YES. Lost the right front plate during the running.</p> <p>FLORENCE IVY (T Moki) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>SHOCKOOL (G Walsh) – Hit the second to last fence. Rider dropped his whip after jumping the second to last fence.</p> <p>AL HARAM (S Phelan) – Hit the final fence losing ground.</p>	
Race 2	ERNIE MARTINOVICH MEMORIAL HURDLE
<p>THE ROLLING STONE (M Gillies) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MAGIC CANNON (G Walsh) – Put in a poor jump at the second fence.</p> <p>PYTHAGORAS (A Kuru) – Misjudged the second fence landing awkwardly. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres. Hit the final fence.</p> <p>CABALLO NOIR (J Seivwright) – Hit the fence near the 100 metres on the first occasion. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.</p> <p>SENASSY (M Roustoby) – Misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres. Misjudged the final fence landing awkwardly.</p> <p>SONTANA (S Fannin) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.</p> <p>DANCINGINTHESTORM (C Studd) – Misjudged the third to last fence. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.</p> <p>MEDINI (E Farr) – Hit the third to last fence. Hit the final fence and fell dislodging its rider, hampering SUMMER WARRIOR. E Farr was attended to by the on course doctor and was stood down from her remaining rides. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>SUMMER WARRIOR (S Phelan) – Hit the second to last fence. Hampered after jumping the final fence.</p>	
Race 3	VICTOR & FRANK MATIJASEVICH OPEN HURDLE
<p>BORNINASANDPIT (M Gillies) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>RAISAFUASHO (A Kuru) – Slow away. Hit the second to last fence.</p>	

SINO HEIGHTS (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Jumped indifferently throughout.	
EL CORBY (G Walsh) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.	
Race 4	YELAVICH TRANSPORT LTD 2200
STARBRO (F Lazet) – Slow away.	
COG KNISH (L Myers) – Slow away, and then hampered shortly after losing ground. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.	
INVIGORATE (M Northcott) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages when being restrained. Raced in restricted room having to be steadied near the 900 metres.	
GALAXY CLASS (D Bussey) – Lost contact with the body of the field passing the 700 metres finishing a distant last. Connections were advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next, with trainer G Bedford advising that GALAXY CLASS would now be retired.	
D Bussey (GALAXY CLASS) – Issued with a warning for his whip use on a runner out of contention.	
Race 5	MLAADI LAURICH (YOUNG LAURICH'S) 2200
GAGARIN (M Gillies) – Slow away.	
TOORAK TOWER (S Phelan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
HEAVENLY GOLD (A Kuru) – Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start. Shifted out under pressure making contact with TOORAK TOWER passing the 200 metres.	
CRASH BANDICOOT (T Johnson) – Raced keenly through the early stages.	
MAGNANIMOUS MAN (G Walsh) – Steadied when in restricted room passing the 1000 metres.	
G Walsh (MAGNANIMOUS MAN) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of a race when circumstances permit.	
Race 6	JADRAN BASKETBALL TEAM STEEPLECHASE
GEORGETHEFIFTH (S Higgins) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence.	
POROTENE MAGNUM (B Lammas) – Pulled up passing the 600 metres on the first occasion when the saddle slipped forward placing the rider in difficulties.	
SPITHILL (H McNeill) – Inclined to run down its fences throughout.	
EPAE ROAD (N Downs) – Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence. Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.	
S Phelan (BAY ROCKER) – Issued with a warning for the manner in which he used the whip, raising his arm above shoulder height.	
Race 7	FRANK & ANNIE MATIJASEVICH MEMORIAL OPEN STEEPLECHASE
HIGHLY LIKELY (J Seivwright) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start. Slow to begin. Pulled up after jumping the sixth fence with the rider reporting that the gelding had felt sore behind. Underwent a	

post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be lame in the left hind leg. The connections were advised that HIGHLY LIKELY would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

NAPOLEON (S Fannin) – Knuckled on landing after jumping the first fence.

MAGIC WONDER (M Gillies) – Hit the fence near the 600 metres losing ground.

LACUSTRE (A Kuru) – Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres when placed in restricted room close to the outside fence.

The connections of the second placed LACUSTRE viewed Stewards footage of the concluding stages, before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 8	DAVE, FRED & MICHAEL LAURICH 1600
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AMASECOYA (A Kuru) – Began awkwardly.

KING OF COOL (G Walsh) – Hampered on jumping away.

ZEDCREST (S Fannin) – Crowded and steadied on jumping away.

VALMUR (M Gillies) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ALFRED GEORGE (M Roustoby) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1400 metres. Steadied after improving on to heels approaching the 900 metres.

RELIABLE FRIEND (S Higgins) – Rider dropped his whip approaching the 200 metres.

I Fraser-Hayes (DR VELOCIOUS) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

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MR BIG (I Fraser-Hayes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.
