GENERAL:

D Turner admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(b) in that he permitted himself to be engaged on two runners in Race 8, being FOILING and TIME BOMB. D Turner was fined \$200.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RAYNER BUILDING 2YO 1200 (1200 Metres)
THE GAFFIN (D Hirini) – Lost ground (5L) when beginning very awkwardly.	
LORD BOUZERON (H Andrew) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages bumping KELLY'S INSPIRATION. H Andrew	

was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and was advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

KELLY'S INSPIRATION (R Hannam) - Forced wide on the home turn passing the 400 metres when **BEAUDZ WELL** (D Turner), which was improving to its inside, was dictated wide by **MORE JOY** (M Singh), which hung outwards when failing to make the corner. Came together with **LORD BOUZERON** (H Andrew) over the final stages when that runner shifted out. R Hannam viewed footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection against the winner.

BEAUDZ WELL (D Turner) – Dictated wide on home turn

MORE JOY (M Singh) - Hung outwards rounding the home turn and early part of the home straight

PLATINUM SPIRIT (J Parkes) - When questioned into the disappointing run J Parkes advised the colt was unsuited to the Heavy 11 today but in his opinion would take natural improvement with the run.

Race 2	BJW MOTORS 3YO 1200 (1200 Metres)

LOCK IT IN (D Bradley) - Jumped outwards at the start dictating **MRS RUMBLE**. Lay in under pressure in the home straight making contact with **MRS RUMBLE** near the 200 metres and again approaching the 100 metres. D Bradley was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised that he is expected to straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

PLATINUM RAPPER (J Parkes) – Restrained off heels near the 800 metres and again passing the 700 metres. When questioned into the disappointing run of **PLATINUM RAPPER**, J Parkes said the filly was unsuited to the Heavy 11 and coming back from 1600 to 1200 may not have suited.

MRS RUMBLE (C Johnson) – Dictated start, bumped and dictated inwards 200 metres and again 100 metres.

LONDON EXPRESS (H Schofer) - Began awkwardly setting back. Raced keenly in the early stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

AKERRA (L Allpress) – Ran wide entering the home straight, then lay in under pressure over the final stages. L Allpress advised the filly had been a little field shy rounding the turn so elected to angle wide into clear running in search of better footing.

Race 3	KELLY AND ASSOCIATES 1400 (1400 Metres)

JONNY RUSS (D Bradley) - Slow away. Was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention.

OUR KATY CRUZ (D Turner) – Slow away.

SANCTUM (M Singh) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

FACETIME (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover throughout. L Allpress was spoken to regarding her whip action over the final stages.

THIS LADY ROCKS (C O'Beirne) - Shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

Race 4	BONNY GLEN LANDFILL 1400 (1400 Metres)

DA JIN SHAN Late scratching at 9.33am on veterinary advice. Trainer was advised that the gelding requires a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

SHE'S POPPY (B Ansell) – Awkwardly away settling back.

DOUGIE (M Singh) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

KING COUGAR (D Hirini) - Raced keenly for a distance near the 1000 metres when leading.

COMEBACK (J Parkes) - When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had struggled in the ground under its top weight.

Race 5	J&J WALTERS 2100 (2100 Metres)

HIGH QUALITY (C Johnson) - Awkwardly away.

READY EDDIE (B Ansell) - Slow away.

HAMILTONIAN (C O'Beirne) – Slow away.

QIAN GUA (D Bradley) - Raced keenly for a distance in the middle stages.

HARD TO BE HUMBLE (M Hudson) - Lay inwards near the 800 metres contacting HIGH QUALITY then shifted in when struck with the whip near the 750 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HIGH QUALITY.

R Hannam (MY GIFT) – Was spoken to with regards the use of his whip on a runner clearly winning and was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii).

Race 6	EVANS HENDERSON WOODBRIDGE BARRISTERS & SOLICITORS 2100 (2100 Metres)

ALL IN STITCHES (H Andrew) – Slow away.

ALFIE DEE (D Hirini) - Slow away

HINEPARA (C O'Beirne) - Jumped outwards at the start contacting MAIDSTONE PARK. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare had not appreciated today's Heavy track conditions.

MAIDSTONE PARK (L Allpress) – Contacted start.

DAL KILCHOAN (T Johnson) - Awkwardly away.

SPEED CALL (C Johnson) - Raced keenly when in front in the early stages.

Race 7	RICHARDS CONSTRUCTION 1200 (1200 Metres)

MEHRTENS (B Ansell) Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary inspection after dislodging its rider en route to the start and galloping a short distance. Rider B Ansell was uninjured.

THAT'S FUNNY (R Hannam) - Tightened at the start when FULLY CHARGED began awkwardly.

FULLY CHARGED (D Hirini) – Began awkwardly.

KIRKLAND (M Hudson) – Steadied shortly after the start.

D Bradley (MISS FREELove) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he angled his mount outwards shortly after the start when not the required distance clear of KIRKLAND (M Hudson), which was steadied.

H Andrew (VELOCE) - Was advised to exercise care when allowing her mount to shift in near the 800 metres tightening MANHATTAN FLAME.

MANHATTAN FLAME (C Johnson) –Steadied near the 800 metres

LIQUID INSPIRATION (D Turner) - Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

SHADOW DANCER (L Allpress) - Inclined to lay inwards under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened near the 200 metres.

MISS FREELOVE (D Bradley) - Rider advised the mare was never comfortable in the Heavy (11).

Race 8	JAMES & SON 1550 (1550 Metres)

GO TO MAN (B Ansell) - Slow away.

OBSESSIVE (H Schofer) - Raced ungenerously for a short distance near the 1200 metres.

DEZELLA (M Singh) - Tightened near the 400 metres when DETENTORE shifted out, then held up for a short distance.

OPHELIA LEE (D Bradley) - Lay in under pressure early in the home straight.

LORD TURBO (C O'Beirne) - Shifted in when struck with the whip near the 100 metres, having to be straightened.
